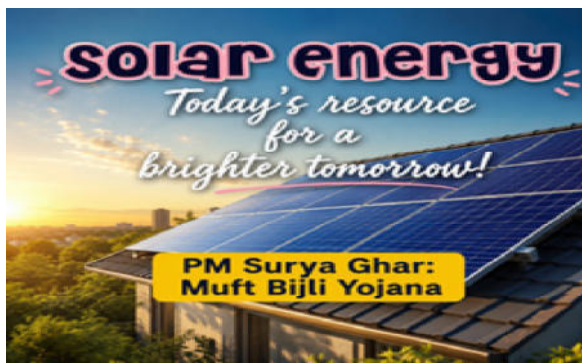

Cabinet approves enhancement of EPFO wage ceiling from Rs.15,000 to Rs.25,000 per month

Over 51 lakh additional employees expected to come under mandatory EPFO coverage

New Delhi, Sept. 16 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has approved the proposal of the Ministry of Labour & Employment to enhance the wage ceiling for mandatory coverage under the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) from Rs.15,000 to Rs.25,000 per month. The decision is expected to bring more than 51 lakh additional employees within the ambit of mandatory EPFO coverage, significantly widening social security protection for workers.

The EPFO wage ceiling remained unchanged throughout the decade from 2004 to 2014, before being substantially enhanced to Rs.15,000 in September 2014. The present decision carries forward this approach by further raising the ceiling to Rs.25,000 to reflect the sustained wage growth, rising incomes and a continued expansion of formal employment over the intervening years.



At present, a fresh above Rs.15,000 per employee joining month is not employment at a wage automatically covered

under the EPF framework and may remain outside mandatory provident fund, pension and associated insurance protection. Raising the ceiling to Rs.25,000 will bring a substantial segment of employees in the Rs.15,000- Rs.25,000 wage band within the statutory social security framework.

The approval will expand access to provident fund savings, pension protection under the Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS) and insurance protection under the Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme (EDLI), in accordance with the applicable scheme provisions. It will also enable the statutory contribution and pensionable-wage framework to better reflect prevailing wage levels.

Since the wage ceiling was last revised in September 2014, India has witnessed sustained wage growth, rising incomes and continued expansion of formal employment. In several States and occupations,

WPL 2027 to begin on January 14, player auction set for October 28 in Kochi

New Delhi, Sept 15

The fifth edition of the Women's Premier League (WPL 2027) will be played from January 14 to February 7, the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) announced on Wednesday, September 16. Ahead of the WPL 2027, the player auction will take place on October 28, 2026, at the Grand Hyatt in Kochi. Franchises must finalise retentions by September 28, 2026.

The compact window keeps the league in the January-February slot used in recent seasons and ends just before the inaugural ICC Women's Champions Trophy, which India will host from February 14-28, 2027 in Mumbai and Vadodara.



In its official statement on Wednesday, the BCCI said the five existing franchises - Royal Challengers Bengaluru, Mumbai Indians, Delhi Capitals, Gujarat Giants and UP Warriorz - will first decide which players to retain from their current squads. After the September 28 deadline, teams will complete their combinations at the auction in Kochi. The salary cap for this

cycle is Rs 15 crore. Squads can have up to 18 players, including a maximum of six overseas players.

RCB are the defending champions after beating Delhi Capitals in the 2026 final. Mumbai Indians and RCB are the only sides with two titles each. While the tournament schedule and auction location are locked in, the BCCI has yet to formally announce the

match venues for the 2027 season.

According to reports, Mumbai's Brabourne Stadium will host WPL 2027 games. The second city is expected to be either Vadodara's Kotambi Stadium or the new stadium in Varanasi, subject to a BCCI inspection and readiness by January 2027.

Teams now have just under two weeks to lock in retentions. Attention then shifts to Kochi, where the 28 October auction will fill remaining slots with a mix of released players, overseas talent and emerging Indian names.

A full match schedule and confirmed venues are expected later.

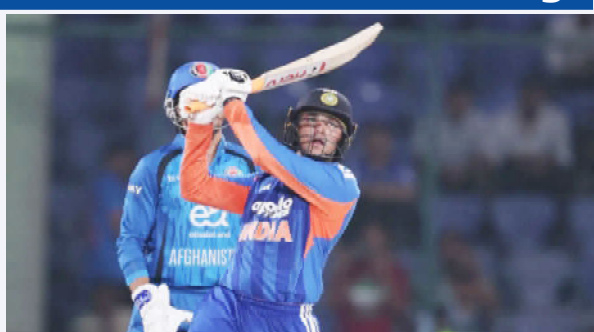

Abhishek second among T20I batters; Robinson climbs to No. 3 in Test bowling

Dubai, Sept 15

Abhishek Sharma has moved up to No. 2 in the ICC men's T20I batting rankings after his 82 in India's series opener against Afghanistan. Abhishek climbed one place, going past Pakistan's Sahibzada Farhan. He is now 51 rating points behind teammate Ishan Kishan, who remains the No. 1-ranked T20I batter. Sanju Samson also made gains after scoring 57 in India's seven-wicket win in the second T20I. Samson moved up four places to No. 30 as India took an unassailable 2-0 lead in the series.

There were significant gains for India's bowlers too. Varun Chakravarthy moved up two places to No. 5, while Jasprit Bumrah jumped seven spots to No. 10. Arshdeep Singh was the biggest mover among the Indian bowlers, climbing 11 places to No. 14, while Axar Patel rose six spots to No. 27. Afghanistan allrounder



Azmatullah Omarzai also made progress in the T20I allrounders' rankings, jumping two positions up to No. 5. Mohammad Nabi went up one spot to No. 8.

In the Test rankings, England fast bowler Ollie Robinson reached a career-high No. 3 among bowlers after taking 21 wickets in the three-Test series against Pakistan. Josh Tongue, who took 19 wickets in the series, moved two places to a career-best No. 11.

Robinson also climbed seven places to No. 13 among Test allrounders after his half-century in the third Test in

Birmingham.

Among Test batters, Pakistan captain Babar Azam rose two places to No. 13, Shan Masood climbed four to No. 37, and England wicketkeeper Jamie Smith moved three spots to No. 20. Elsewhere, Nathan Ellis climbed 20 places to No. 20 in the ODI bowling rankings after taking five wickets in Australia's 59-run win over Zimbabwe in Harare. Matthew Renshaw's 109 in the same game lifted him from outside the top 100 to No. 68 among ODI batters, while Cooper Connolly moved nine places to No. 77 after scoring 51.

Messi in Argentina squad for farewell friendly

Benin, Sept 16

Argentina have named Lionel Messi in their squad for a friendly against Benin in October in a match which is set to be the forward's farewell to international football.

Messi announced his retirement from Argentina duty in August in the wake of his country's defeat by Spain in the 2026 World Cup final and after saying he was considering his future in football following the death of his father, Jorge.

The 39-year-old, who captained Argentina when they won the 2022 World Cup, said the decision to stop playing for La Albiceleste hurt him "deeply" but that he had "given it my all" and had "nothing left to give".

Messi, an eight-time Ballon d'Or winner who currently plays for Inter Miami, is Argentina's all-time leading scorer and most-capped player, having scored 125 goals in 207 appearances.

minimum wages have also moved closer to the existing threshold. The enhancement to Rs.25,000 therefore updates the EPFO framework in line with rising wage levels and extends the benefits of formal social security to a wider segment of the workforce.

EPFO today operates one of the world's largest social security systems, administering the Employees' Provident Fund (EPF), Employees' Pension Scheme (EPS) and Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme (EDLI). The latest EPFO data show around 7.98 crore contributing members across about 7.68 lakh contributing establishments, while the EPS provides pension benefits to around 82 lakh pensioners. EDLI provides insurance protection linked to EPF membership.

India's workforce is at the heart of its growth story. As wages rise, incomes improve and formal employment expands, the Government's continued emphasis on employment generation and formalisation is creating new opportunities for workers. The enhancement of the EPFO wage ceiling ensures that the social security framework also keeps pace with this progress and that a larger number of workers in formal employment receive statutory social security protection.

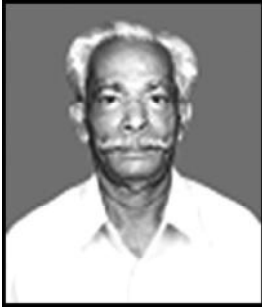
