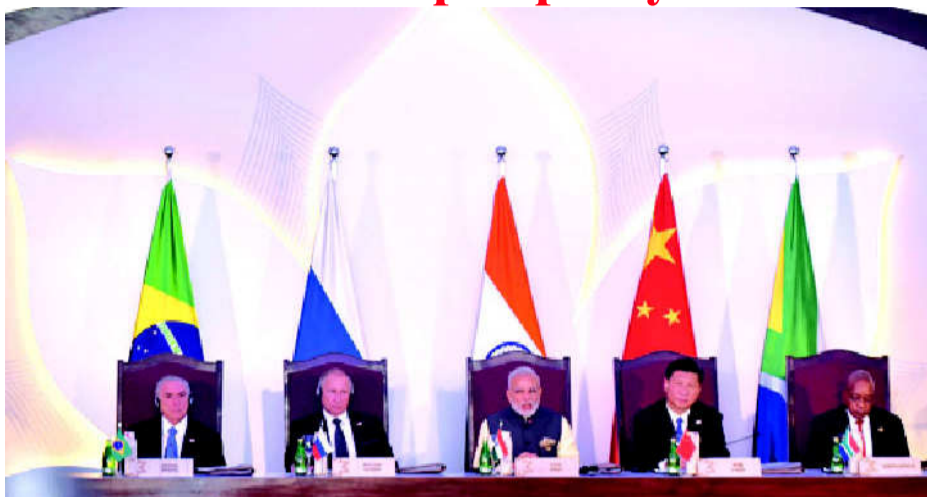

Terrorism casts shadow on development & economic prosperity: PM



Panaji, Oct 16
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said terrorism casts a shadow on development and economic prosperity. Chairing BRICS Leaders Plenary Meeting in Goa this afternoon, Shri Modi said its reach is now global and it has grown more lethal and adept at using technology. He stressed that selective approach to terrorism would be counter productive, saying that

there must be no distinction based on artificial and self serving grounds. Shri Modi said terrorist funding, weapons supply, training and political support must be cut off. He called for deepening security cooperation between National Security Advisors. Shri Modi said early adoption of draft Comprehensive International Terrorism will be an expression of resolve

to fight the menace. He stated that security and counter terrorism cooperation are essential to safeguard lives of citizens. He said the footprint of intra-BRICS engagement has expanded to include large areas of economic activity. The Prime Minister said he is looking forward to BRICS Credit Rating Agency, speeding up Agriculture Research Centre, Railway Research Network, and Sports Council.

Earlier, speaking at the restricted session meeting of BRICS Leaders, Shri Modi said the most serious threat to economic prosperity is terrorism and

Port Blair, Oct. 16
During the Deepawali Festival season, the wholesale/retail fireworks licencees usually set up their shops / stalls in congested markets / residential areas of Port Blair (Municipal limits) and there is ample probability of any mishap under these situations despite taking all precautionary measures by the vendors as well as the

Administration. In order to ward off any such apprehension of mishap / danger on account of any fire incident on this festive occasion, a meeting was called in the conference hall of the Deputy Commissioner's Office on Oct. 7 which was attended by various stakeholders and it was decided that crackers will be sold in a

centralized place i.e. ITF Ground as done in previous years. Accordingly, the cracker retail sale in Port Blair Municipal limit area will be allowed only at ITF Ground, Port Blair during Oct. 25 to 26 between 9 am & 9 pm and on Oct. 27 to 30 between 9 am & 10 pm, a communication from the Assistant Commissioner (HQ) said.

Police recover huge quantities of illicit liquor & handia

Port Blair, Oct. 16
In order to ensure zero tolerance against illegal sale and manufacturing of illicit liquor, regular raids are being organized by the A&N Police. During the last week (from Oct. 9 to 15) the Police Teams of various Police Stations of these Islands have booked a total of 38 excise cases and 39 persons involved were arrested. A total of 177 bottles of 750 ml and one

bottle of 375 ml IMFL, 98.5 liters illicit liquor, and 81 Kgs of Handia were recovered during the police raids. Govt to set up five dedicated centres for divyang athletes Andy Murray beats Roberto Bautista; wins third Shanghai Masters title

Vadodara, Oct 16
The central government will set up five national-level sophisticated sports centres for differently-abled sports persons, with an objective of catering to their special needs like training and diet. Union Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Shri Thawar Chand Gehlot said in Vadodara that the government has started work on establishing these five centres and land has been acquired for three such centres. He said, these centres will come up in central, west, north, south and east India. Shri Gehlot was in town for overseeing the

arrangements for distribution of tri-cycles, wheel chairs, hearing aids and other such implements to more than 14,000 divyang people at a function to be held on October 22 in presence of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. The Minister said government wants to adopt the best practices and parameters in force at recently concluded Rio 2016 Paralympics.

Shanghai, Oct 16
Andy Murray powered his way to a third Shanghai Masters title by beating Spanish 15th seed Roberto Bautista Agut 7-6(1) 6-1 in Sunday's final to close in on Novak Djokovic at the top of the world rankings. Bautista Agut beat world number one Djokovic in the semi-final on Saturday but was brought back down to earth by three-times grand slam champion Murray, who converted all his four break points to wrap up the match in one hour 36 minutes. Bautista Agut forced a tight opening set into a tiebreak, but the 29-year-old Briton raised his level to then win seven points in a row. World number two Murray took control of proceedings in the second set as an aggressive Bautista Agut, who hit 25 unforced errors during the match, failed to maintain his intensity.

Murray, who won the China Open in Beijing a week ago, edged closer to Djokovic in the world rankings and is now 915 points behind the Serb, with a chance of finishing the year as world number one.

Indian boxer Neeraj Goyat outpunched Australia's Ben Kite to retain the WBC welterweight Asia title in New Delhi yesterday. The 24-year-old prevailed 120-110, 119-109, 115-113 in an unanimous decision for the gruelling 12-round contest against his 26-year-old rival. Goyat, who came into the contest with 7 wins in 11 fights, is now expected to break into the WBC world rankings, which will be a step towards getting him a shot at the world title.

Chinese Taipei Open: Sourabh Verma wins men's singles title

Taipei, Oct 16
Indian shuttler Sourabh Verma today clinched the men's singles title at the Chinese Taipei Open badminton, defeating Malaysia's Daren Liew in the summit clash of the Grand Prix tournament in Taipei City. Sourabh, aged 23, who hails from Madhya Pradesh, was

on a comeback trail after spending almost a year on the sidelines due to elbow and knee injuries last year. Sourabh rallied to grab the first two games 12-10 and 12-10 and emerged victorious after his opponent Liew retired at 3-3 owing to a problematic shoulder.

Japan Grand Prix: Marc Marquez wins 3rd MotoGP title as Valentino Rossi, Jorge Lorenzo crash out

Tokyo, Oct 16
Marc Marquez secured his third world MotoGP world championship by winning the Japan Grand Prix on Sunday where his closest rivals, Yamaha duo Valentino Rossi and Jorge Lorenzo, both crashed out. The 23-year-old Honda rider became the youngest man to win three premier-class world championship titles, and did so at Honda's home circuit, where he had never won before. Marquez finished the 24-lap race in 42 minutes, 34.610 seconds, 2.992 seconds ahead of Ducati's Andrea Dovizioso and 4.104 seconds ahead of Maverick Vinales of Suzuki. "Obviously, amazing... Amazing feeling," Marquez said immediately after his victory with

a big smile, his face red with excitement. It was difficult to concentrate" after Rossi and Lorenzo crashed out, he said. "Really happy. Really happy with my team."

Marquez took the first corner, but was quickly overtaken by Lorenzo, who commanded the lead in the early phase of the Japan Grand Prix. Marquez and Rossi swapped second place several times in the second lap with the Honda rider keeping the upper hand. New Delhi, Oct 16
Sale of packaged water and soft drinks at more than their Maximum Retail Price - including at airports, multiplexes and hotels - will attract stringent penal actions like fines and jail term. Consumer Affairs Minister Shri Ram Vilas Paswan yesterday said packaged drinking water is sold at 10-

20 per cent higher rates at these places, while in some cases, MRP is not even written on the water bottle and "soft drinks like Coca Cola are sold in loose at an increased rate".

Thousands flee as typhoon lashes Philippines

Manila, Oct 16
In Philippines, Typhoon Sarika smashed into the main island of Luzon today, ripping off roofs, toppling power lines and forcing more than 12,000 people to flee to safer places. The disaster agency said, 290 commercial flights, including 63 to international destinations, were cancelled due to bad weather. The Philippine islands are often the first major landmass to be hit by storms that generate over the Pacific Ocean.
