## PM launches pan India rollout of COVID-19 vaccination drive

# Indian response to corona is one of self-confidence and self-reliance: PM

## Pays tribute to frontline Corona Warriors

New Delhi, Jan. 16 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched the pan India rollout of COVID-19 vaccination drive via video conferencing today. This is the world's largest vaccination program covering the entire length and breadth of the country. A total of 3006 session sites across all States and UTs were virtually connected during the launch.

The Prime Minister started his speech by paying compliments to the scientists who were associated with the development of the



vaccines. He said, usually it takes years to prepare a vaccine but here, in such a short time, not one but two made-in-India vaccine were launched. The Prime Minister cautioned the people to be careful about not missing taking two doses. He said that there will be a gap of one month between the doses. He asked people to keep their guards up even after taking the vaccine as only two weeks after taking the second dose, human body will develop necessary immunity against Corona. The Prime Minister put the unprecedented scale of

the vaccination drive in perspective by informing that, in the first round itself, 3 crore people, which is more than population of at least 100 countries of the world, are being vaccinated. He said that this needs to be taken up to 30 crores in the second round when elderly and people with serious comorbidities will be vaccinated. He said that there are only three countries- India, USA and China, who have the population of more than 30 crore.

New Delhi, Jan. 16 (PIB) The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi interacted with startups and addressed 'Prarambh: Startup India International Summit' today via video conferencing. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister said that the start-ups are changing the demographic characteristics of today's business. He pointed out that 44 per cent recognized startups have

women Directors and number of women working in these start up is very high. Similarly, 45 per cent startups are in tier 2 and tier 3 cities, working as the brand ambassadors of the local products. Every State is supporting and incubating startups as per local possibilities and 80 percent of districts of the country are now part of the Startup India mission. Youth from all types of

background are able to realize their potential in this ecosystem. Result, the Prime Minister said, is before us as attitude has changed from 'Why don't you do a job? Why a start-up?' to 'Job is alright, but why not create your own start-up!'. In 2014 only 4 Indian startups were the 'unicorn club' now, more than 30 startups have crossed the 1 billion mark, the Prime Minister added.

## First phase of COVID-19 vaccination begins in Isles

# 226 Health Care Workers vaccinated on the inaugural day; drive conducted smoothly

## Second dose will be administered after 28 days

Port Blair, Jan. 16

Along with the rest of the country, the first phase of COVID-19 vaccination in A&N Islands was launched today soon after the inaugural address of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. The launch function at Port Blair was attended by Dr. V Candavelou, Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), Shri R.N. Sharma, Secretary (Health)/MD UTHM, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, DC, South Andaman District, Dr. Omkar Singh, Director,



Health Services, Dr. A.K. Mondal Director, ANIIMS and other officials of A&N Administration and DHS/ANIIMS were present during the launch.

The vaccination is being undertaken for the Health Care Workers of South Andaman District in two places viz. School of Nursing, GB pant Hospital, Port Blair and AYUSH Hospital, Port Blair. Both sites were made live with the PMO and Ministry of Health, GoI for two way communications. The vaccination session started at both places

of vaccination.

A total of 226 beneficiaries were vaccinated on the inaugural day. 116 beneficiaries were administered vaccine at School of Nursing while 110 beneficiaries received their vaccination at AYUSH Hospital, Port Blair. The vaccination drive went very smoothly and no adverse effect were noticed in any of the beneficiaries who took the vaccine.

The vaccination will be continued for next few days till completion of the first phase. The second dose will be administered after 28 days of giving the first dose, a press release from Directorate of Health Services said.

# Surprise field inspection conducted at Little Andaman; hefty fine imposed against defaulters

Port Blair, Jan. 16

A surprise field inspection was conducted by Tehsildar, Little Andaman alongwith the Patwari, Surveyor and Choudhary to identify the site being utilized for illegal extraction of earth/white Moorum at Ramakrishnapur village, Little Andaman. During the inspection, a JCB excavator was found on the spot which was used for illegal extraction of White Moorum from the Govt. Revenue Land and subsequently, the same was seized and kept within the premises of Police Out Post, Ramakrishnapur, Little Andaman. A hefty amount as penalty/fine has been imposed as per Mines & Minerals Rules 2012 against the defaulters towards illegal extraction of White Moorum.

Meanwhile, people have been urged to refrain from such illegal activities, failing which, strict action as per



law may be taken against the violators which includes fine & land encumbrance.
