Launch of online license & registration system for food business operators today

The Government of India has enacted Food Safety and Standards Act, (FSS Act, 2006) to regulate and monitor the manufacture, process, pack, transport, store, distribute, sell and import of any food or food ingredient, so as to ensure availability of safe and wholesome food for human consumption and also to laying down science based standards.

FSS Regulations Gazette Notified on 5th August, 2011, mandates that every Food Business Operator (FBO) must obtain License/Registration Certificate.

Food Safety & Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has

created a Centralized Online System for FBO - License/Registration for use across the country, with the assistance of National Institute for Smart Government (NISG), Hyderabad.

The online license and registration system will be inaugurated by the Secretary (Health), A&N Administration, Smt. Madrid: French football legend Zinedine Zidane, current coach of Real Madrid's reserve team, has become the centre of attention in Spain amid rumour that he may succeed Rafael Benitez as coach of the first team, if the latter fails to lead the team back onto the right track. Zidane is now focused on the upcoming match against Talavera de la Reina in Segunda

Division B next Saturday. But at the same time he does not rule out a surprising elevation to the first team when they face Rayo Vallecano in La Liga's 16th round next Sunday, which might speed up the process of Benitez's departure, which will provide the Frenchman with the opportunity he has always longed for, reports Efe.

Saina Nehwal shines in a subdued season for Indian badminton

New Delhi, Dec 17
Saina Nehwal continued to break new grounds in a year that saw her reach the pinnacle of world badminton but it turned out to be a subdued season, marred by injuries and poor form, for the rest of the Indian shuttlers. Saina and K Srikanth continued their good run, winning two titles each, while PV Sindhu, Parupalli Kashyap and Ajay Jayaram battled through injuries to claim a title but overall the Indian shuttlers could not reach the heights that they achieved in a watershed 2014. Continuing her rich vein of form, Saina clinched the Syed Modi Grand Prix Gold and then broke the jinx of never winning the Indian Open Super Series with a splendid performance which

catapulted her to the World No. 1 position. The Olympic bronze medalist also produced stellar performances at three of the most prestigious events in world badminton calendar, reaching the finals of the All England and World Championship and the China Super Series Premier. However, the girl from Hyderabad suffered an ankle injury at Fuzhou in November which forced her to skip the Hong Kong Open and also posed a serious question mark on her performance at the season-ending BWF Super Series Finals but Saina stunned the world with a superlative win over World No. 1 Carolina Marin in the second match before fitness issues saw her fail to qualify for the semifinals.

Srikanth drops a place to be ninth

New Delhi, Dec 17
Kidambi Srikanth dropped a place to be at ninth spot, while Saina Nehwal remained static at second position in the world badminton rankings released on Thursday. Owing to a poor outing at the World Super series Finals in Dubai last week, where he lost all the group stage matches, Srikanth lost a place in the men's singles rankings. Parupalli Kashyap also slipped a spot to be at 15th, while H.S. Prannoy maintained his 20th spot. Ajay Jayaram moved up a place to be 22nd in the ranking table, which continued to be headed by China's Chen Long. Like Saina, P.V. Sindhu also remained static in women's singles, staying at No. 12. In women's doubles, Jwala Gutta and Ashwini Ponnappa maintained their No.13 position.

E-Platform to provide access to the Farmers across the Markets for their Produce

In order to ensure free flow of Agricultural produce from one market area to another, save producers from multiple levies of mandi charges and to ensure agro commodities for consumer at reasonable prices, the Government has drawn a time bound programme for developing National Agriculture Market. The National e-platform developed for this proposes will cover 250 Agri mandis by September 2016 and by March 2018 total 585 mandis will have the system to ensure the farmers' access of for their produce across the markets. Briefing about the initiative of the Central Government to the Members of the Parliamentary Consultative Committee, Shri Radha Mohan Singh, Union Agriculture & Farmers Welfare Minister, said that the Government is actively working to usher in reforms of the Agri marketing system in the interests of farmers and consumers both.
