Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin in A&N Islands marks the construction of 600th house

Moves one step closer towards realizing dream of 'Housing for All' by March 2021

Port Blair, March 16 The implementation of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin) takes a momentous pace towards realizing the Hon'ble Prime Minister's dream of 'Housing for All by 2022' as it reaches the mark of construction of its 600th house in A&N Islands. The Department of Rural Development, A&N Administration has been implementing the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin, the flagship scheme of the Government of India across the Islands since the inception of the scheme from 1st April, 2016. Under the Yojana, pucca house is provided to the beneficiaries with basic amenities inclusive of a hygienic cooking space to the houseless with financial assistance of Rs.1.2 lakh along with 90 person days of unskilled labour wage amounting to Rs.24,030/- through convergence with Mahatma Gandhi Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS). Additionally, an incentive of Rs.12,000 for construction of toilets through convergence with Swachh Bharat Mission - Gramin (SBM-G) is also provided to the beneficiaries.

Of the target of 1337 beneficiaries, the Department has constructed 600 houses. 739 beneficiaries who have been provided installments are in various stages of construction of their houses.

A large number of them are expected to complete the house by 31st March, 2021. At present, the UT has released installments to approximately 86% of its targets. The beneficiaries have expressed their gratitude towards the Department for converting them from tenants/ homeless to home owners. Shri S. Sarsu, Shri Andasamy and Shri Raman of Wandoor GPs said that PMAY-G has provided cooking space inside the house. This has changed the practice of cooking outside. Now our houses have 'zero maintenance' too which was not in case of mud/dilapidated house as maintenance expenditure used to be too big almost every year. Shri Sunderam Tirkey and Shri Dinabandhu Das of Guptapara Gram Panchayats stated that PMAY-G scheme has made significant impact on their lives- both in terms of physical facilities provided and subject well-being. It has been noticed that there has been a huge boost in the feeling of Social Status, Self-worth, Confidence Level, Feeling of Ownership, Feeling of Safety & Security, Self-perceived Improvement in Health, Overall Quality of Life, and Satisfaction after construction of new houses of the beneficiaries. 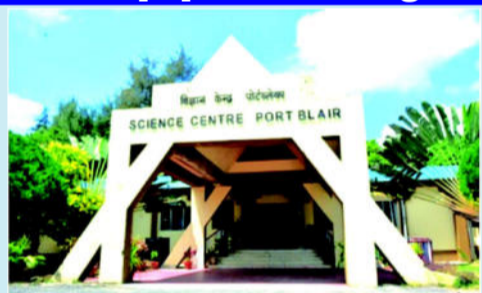

attempted various innovative ways of communicating science to enthuse, entertain and to bring the developments of Science and Technology to the doorstep of common man for prosperity, awareness and for improving the quality of life.



The Science Centre has three galleries on various themes namely Andaman and Nicobar Gallery, Fun Science Gallery and Modern Science and Bio-Technology Gallery. These galleries consist of mostly participatory exhibits. There are about 100 exhibits displayed in the galleries. Beside this, there are innovative outdoor parks namely Science Park surrounding the main building of Science Centre fitted with a number of garden exhibits on basic science, Prehistoric Evolutionary Park, an Amphibious Air Craft.

The Centre is also provided with 3D Theatre for screening 3D films on regular basis for the tourist as well as school students. In order to add evening hours attraction, a light & sound programme titled Jurassic Park has been established in the adjacent land area of Science Centre with assistance of National Council of Science Museum. The programme is of 30 minutes duration & operated in the evening hours. Besides these programmes, Science Centre also conducts educational programme such as Science Magic Show, Fun Science Show, Bubble Show on regular basis to entertain the visitors.

Sky Shows are also organized on regular basis in the evening hours for astronomical studies of the celestial bodies through powerful telescopes. The programme titled 'Sky Observation' gained lot of popularity amongst the rural folk. These programmes are specially designed to acquaint the people with the planets, satellites and other celestial bodies to appreciate the wonders of universe. In order to reach out to the rural population, the Science Centre has a Mobile Science Exhibition Bus fitted with 24 interactive exhibits which make it convenient for organizing science programmes in the rural areas.

The activities of the Science Centre is yielding a long-term benefit by infusing among the people a scientific temper, which in turn is helping to eradicate many social evils born out of science-illiteracy. This also supplements the formal science education in schools through a large number of science based educational programmes, both in-house and outreach.

attending many numbers of written exams and interviews. Unfortunately, it all resulted in vain. This initiated him to decide on searching for another means to setup his career. He decided to setup a self-employment venture. At this juncture, he was advised by a PMEGP beneficiary to approach the KVIB officials for registering him for the scheme. He rushed to the Office of the Industries Department functioning at Bakultala to enquire on the formalities and other procedures. He was guided to talk to the financing bank and obtain their consent. The Branch Manager, SBI, Rangat noticed in this middle-class youth, a spirit to overcome his trepidation of not succeeding to get a Govt. Job.

Ranojit was further inspired to learn about the benefits offered under PMEGP scheme and submitted a project for purchase and ply of a tourist vehicle. After recommendation of the DLTF, the loan proposal was forwarded to the financing bank for lending financial assistance. While sanctioning a loan of Rs. 8,35,000 for his project, the Branch Manager recommended him to boost his aptitude with a prolific EDP training from SBI- RSETI, Port Blair.

A systematic and informative training helped him realize his potentialities and his limitations, and enabled him to correct them. The training made him further realize how important hospitality towards maintaining proper customer relationship is. He improved his entrepreneurial skills which has let him keep his self-confidence all-time high and he was all set to start his own venture.
