President presents National Geo-science Awards

New Delhi, May 16
President Shri Ram Nath Kovind today said authorities must be mindful of the human side of mining. Addressing the gathering after presenting National Geo-sciences Awards for 2017 in New Delhi, Shri Kovind said, local communities must benefit from the exploration, extraction and development of mineral resources. He said, many of the mineral resources in India are found in regions that have been home of tribal communities since generations. Shri Kovind said it is important that these



communities are part of prosperity that the mining economy creates. The President said application of geoscience is extremely diverse which will lead to expansion of economic activities. He said, environment impact of mining must be minimized. He said, India must mine more but mine better in a sustainable manner. Shri Kovind said, India's per capita consumption of

many resources and commodities is still very low by global standards and there is room to grow. He said, high-quality research initiatives are required for sustainable and ecological friendly resource generation. The President also stressed on meaningful investment in technological innovation in the mining sector. He said, the Government pushed for reforms in the sector in the last four years. Shri Kovind said, the reforms, including amendments to existing laws and establishing a more equitable system of royalties, have started *(Contd. on last page)*

Security operations to stop in J-K during Ramzan: MHA

New Delhi, May 16
The Centre has asked security forces not to launch operations against terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir during the holy month of Ramzan. The Ministry of Home Affairs has said that the decision has been taken to help the "peace-loving Muslims observe Ramzan in a peaceful environment". Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Ms Mehbooba Mufti, too, has been informed of the decision by Union Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh. However, the Centre has said that the security forces "reserve the right to retaliate if attacked or if essential to protect the lives of innocent people". Known as Ramzan or Ramadan, the Muslim holy month



commenced from May 16, 2018, in India. Welcoming the decision by the Centre, Ms Mufti said, "I wholeheartedly welcome the Ramadan ceasefire and would like to thank PM and Home Minister for their personal intervention. My gratitude also to the leaders and parties who participated in the All Party Meeting and helped build consensus towards this announcement." Just a few days ago, Ms Mehbooba Mufti had demanded a unilateral ceasefire by the security forces during Ramzan and Amarnath yatra in the state. But the Centre was initially not too keen on offering an olive branch to the terror groups pointing out that the situation in the state was not conducive for a ceasefire and such an exercise undertaken in 2000 had not given the desired results.

Cabinet approves setting up of new AIIMS at Deoghar, Jharkhand

New Delhi, May 16
Cabinet today approved setting up of a new AIIMS at Deoghar in Jharkhand. Union Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad said in New Delhi that a provision of funds worth 1103 crore rupees has been

approved for the project. He said, AIIMS will be set up under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana, PMSSY. The AIIMS at Deoghar will consist of a hospital with a capacity of 750 beds, trauma centre

facilities and a medical college with an-in take of 100 MBBS students per year. It will also have an Ayush department with 30 beds for providing treatment facilities in the traditional system of medicine.

SCI strengthens Coastal network, launches Chennai-Port Blair service

Port Blair, May 16
In its endeavour to provide coastal services to the Indian Trade in all locations of India, the Shipping Corporation of India (SCI) is now embarking on a new service called Chennai Port Blair Service (CPBS) to run between Chennai and Port Blair. The CPBS has made her inaugural voyage from Chennai to Port Blair on 14th May 2018 and will provide a sailing every 10 days, an SCI release here said.

The release said that the service will also connect cargo from Gujarat to Port Blair via Chennai. The launch of this service will

not only benefit shippers from Tamil Nadu, but also from Gujarat and shippers can now use SCI containers for shipments from Kandla/Mundra to Port Blair which will benefit the trade. Capt. Anoop Sharma C&MD, SCI encouraged his coastal team to start more coastal services with additional port calls in line with the Government's vision of improvement of the coastal connectivity. SCI has been providing coastal services to the trade between ports on the west coast of India to Kochi, Tuticorin, Katupalli, Krishnapatnam and Haldia, the release added.

CCEA approves initial corpus of Rs 5000 cr for MIF with NABARD under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana

New Delhi, May 16
Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, CCEA has approved an initial corpus of 5000 crore rupees for Micro Irrigation Fund (MIF) with NABARD under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee

Yojana. The allocation of 2000 crore rupees will be utilised during 2018-19 and 3000 crore will be utilised during 2019-20. NABARD will extend the loan to state governments during this period. Borrowings from

NABARD shall be paid back in 7 years including the grace period of two years. The lending rate under MIF has been proposed at 3 percent lower than the cost of raising the fund by NABARD.

The National Dengue Day was observed today throughout the Islands. As such an inaugural function was held in the Auditorium of GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair in coordination with UT Health Mission and Directorate of Health Services on the theme 'The Dengue Control Everyone's Concern'. Dr. Monica Priyadharshini,

Secretary Health cum Mission Director (UTHM) was the chief guest on the occasion. Dr.SP Burma, Director-Health Services, A&N Administration was the guest of honour. The chief guest threw light on signs and symptoms of dengue and early warning signs of its complication. She emphasizes that the whole community needs to be vigilant about the

breeding of mosquitoes in and around the house and the need to control multiplication of mosquitoes. She appealed to all departments such as Municipal Council, Transport Department, APWD, ALHW, Automobile Workshop to cooperative with Health Department in controlling and preventing mosquito born diseases, a communication here said.

Successful surgery restores vision of Nicobari girl suffering from congenital cataract

Our eyes are windows to the world. Without them, life would seem too unappealing. Not just vision but clear vision is what we all desire to have during our life span. DT brings you the story of one such child, who was diagnosed with congenital cataract, which has now been rectified. Meet 10 year old Nicobari girl, Mary Grace from Nancowry, Champin village, who is now able to see the world around her as she speaks to the DT Reporter during her review checkup at GB Pant Hospital today. The eldest among four siblings, Mary never went to school due to her vision problem and she was home schooled by her aunt Emma, whom she adorably calls



'Mother'. An elated Mary said she can now see with both her eyes and play without any problem. "I am very happy as I can see my toys and feel them for real. I like playing with balls and toy cars", she said. She is eagerly waiting to return to her hometown and play with her friends. Emma said her happiness knew no bound as the child is now able to see well. Her parents are also elated to have learnt of her eye sight recovery. Emma said, "Watching her falter every now and then while playing made me realize the child was having vision problem as her eyes had become white around the pupil". India beat China 3-1, remain unbeaten in women's Asian Champions Trophy

Donghae City, May 16
Continuing its fine show at the Asian Champions Trophy Indian women's hockey team stunned higher-ranked China 3-1 to register their second consecutive win in the tournament on Wednesday. Vandana Katariya (4th, 11th minutes) scored a brace while Gurjit Kaur struck the other goal from a penalty corner to ensure India's comfortable win over eighth-ranked China. China's lone goal came from the stick of Wen Dan in the 15th minute. By virtue of this win, Indian team is sitting pretty atop the standings with two victories from as many games.



India, ranked 10th in the world, will next play Malaysia on Thursday. The Malaysians beat Japan 3-2 in another encounter. India had earlier defeated Japan 4-1 in their tournament-

opener. The tournament also marks the comeback of Sjoerd Marjine as the chief coach of the women's side after being at the helm of the men's team for little over seven months.

Smriti Mandhana and Harmanpreet Kaur will lead the two teams in the one-off Women's T20 Challenge on May 22 ahead of the IPL Qualifier 1 in Mumbai. The women's game has seen a wave of popularity in the country following the national team's run to the final of World Cup last year. With an eye on growing this wave, the BCCI is hosting the T20 Challenge to provide the women's game a platform alongside its most popular tournament. It is also a way to test waters for a women's IPL in near future. Rajeev Shukla, Chairman, IPL, said, "Even as IPL continues to roll like a well-oiled machine, over the last couple of weeks, efforts were made to put in place a similar structure for women cricketers. "We were in talks with several Boards and I am pleased with the outcome. New Zealand skipper Suzie Bates, attacking batter Sophie Devine, who



holds the record for fastest half-century in women's T20s, Australia's all-rounder Ellyse Perry, wicket-keeper bat Alyssa Healy, Megan Schutt and Beth Mooney have confirmed their participation. "Danni Wyatt and Daniel Hazell will add the English flavour. This special game will be played at Mumbai's iconic Wankhede Stadium and will be telecast live in India and across the world." Diana Edulji, member of Committee of Administrators (CoA) and former India captain, said, "We are excited to announce the first-of-its-kind exhibition match involving our women cricketers. BCCI has been pulling out all stops to promote and nurture women's cricket and this is a small yet significant step towards a prospective league involving women's stars in the future. The IPL is the biggest and most popular league in the world and it has been a long-time endeavour to have a women's league that can match the exuberance of IPL. Mithali Raj, Jhulan Goswami, Harmanpreet Kaur, Smriti Mandhana and Veda Krishnamurthy among others rubbing shoulders with foreign stars will be a unique experience and something that we have not witnessed here in India." The T20 match will begin at 14:00 IST and will be followed by the IPL 2018 Qualifier 1 at 19:00 IST.

Nepal teen spinner Sandeep Lamichhane added to ICC World XI

Dubai, May 16
Nepal's teenage spinner Sandeep Lamichhane continued his rapid rise in international cricket as he was named in the ICC World XI squad to take on the West Indies in a charity T20 International on May 31. However, Bangladesh's Shakib Al Hasan has withdrawn from the game due to personal reasons, the ICC stated today without specifying the exact cause of his pullout. The 17-year-old Lamichhane, who is mentored by former Australian captain Michael

Clarke, is currently playing in the Indian Premier League for the Delhi Daredevils. The charity match will be played at the iconic Lord's in London to raise funds for Caribbean stadia ravaged by hurricanes last year. Lamichhane will join a star-studded line-up, which also comprises Eoin Morgan (captain), Shahid Afridi, Tamim Iqbal, Dinesh Karthik, Rashid Khan, Mitchell McClenaghan, Shoaib Malik, Hardik Pandya, Thisara Perera and Luke Ronchi against the ICC World T20 champion side. The West

Indian squad includes the likes of Samuel Badree, Carlos Brathwaite, Chris Gayle, Evin Lewis, Marlon Samuels and Andre Russell among others. Lamichhane was spotted by then Nepal coach Pubudu Dassanayake in 2014 and first represented Nepal in the 2016 U-19 World Cup in which he took 16 wickets. In the historic MCC versus Nepal match at Lord's in July the same year, Lamichhane had figures of one for 25 as the visitors successfully defended 217 for eight, bowling out the hosts for 176 in 47.2 overs.

Indian paddlers' CWG showing has even forced China to take notice: Chief coach

New Delhi, May 16
The Indian women's team's historic performance at the Commonwealth Games has even attracted the attention of table-tennis powerhouse China, says chief national coach Massimo Costantini. The Indian women's team historic performance at the Commonwealth Games has even attracted the attention of table-tennis powerhouse China, says chief national coach Massimo Costantini. "We are getting a lot of respect from everyone. When we were playing China in the World Championships (earlier this May), they were very concerned about playing us. Some of the coaches like China's coach even asked for

the video of the match in which India beat Singapore (to win the CWG gold)," India's Italian coach told PTI. India witnessed its best performance in table-tennis at the CWG, bagging a record haul of eight medals including historic gold in the women's team and singles event in Gold Coast Games last month. It was largely made possible by Manika Batra, who ended up winning four medals, the most by an Indian in Gold Coast. Costantini, who also served as the chief coach of the national team from early 2009 till the end of the 2010 Commonwealth Games, played a vital role in the squad's CWG success. A month later, he guided the men's team to finish 13th in the

Championship Division of the World Team Championships at Halmstad in Sweden. However, the Manika-led women's team was not able to take the winning momentum of the CWG forward and finished a dismal 17th, beating just one of its opponents. Asked about the reason behind the drastic drop in performance of the women, the former USA coach said he saw it coming. "I didn't expect much from the women because I knew they won't be able to recover after such a great performance (at the CWG). There was a physiological drop. I could see Manika (Batra) was not sharp, she wasn't responding well, she wasn't ready."

Soccer fever grips Russia a month ahead of World Cup

Moscow, May 16
With exactly one month remaining until the first ball is kicked in Russia's 2018 FIFA World Cup, Moscow has begun to team with soccer-themed events. The Luzhniki Stadium, the venue which will stage the opening match on June 14 and the final on July 15, hosted a "Russia Loves Soccer" event over the weekend. On Monday, the local organising committee chairman Arkady Dvorkovich said that preparations are in their final stages and they just need to add the finishing touches before being ready to welcome the world to Russia. Landscaping



and additional security systems are all that is left to add at some of the newly-built stadiums. Schools in the 11 host cities also marked the one-month point by holding "soccer lessons" and inviting soccer personalities to play a match and to speak about the tournament. Moscow International School

no. 1498 welcomed LOC chairman Dvorkovich and retired Russian soccer player Alexei Smertin. Smertin, who is now the Russian Football Union's anti-discrimination inspector, took part in a soccer match held between some of the school's students.

here at GB Pant when she turned six, it was delayed as her grandfather, whose health was frail wanted to take the child to the hospital by himself, said Emma. Realizing the severity of Mary's vision problem, Emma decided to bring her to GB Pant in February 24, 2018 and consulted Dr. Anita Shah, Deputy Director-Ophthalmology, G. B. Pant Hospital. Speaking to the DT Reporter, Dr. Anita said, Mary was brought to the Hospital on February 24 this year and she could not see in both the eyes. She had only light perception and was diagnosed with congenital cataract as her mother may have had some problem while conceiving. Following Mary's admission to the Hospital on April 7, checkup related to congenital cataract was carried out and she was tested positive for Cytomegalovirus IGG&IGM, Serum and Herpes Simplex Virus- 1 IGG, Serum. Initially Dr. Shah was very apprehensive whether the child would get her vision or not. Mary was operated upon in both the eyes by Dr. Anita Shah on April 9, 2018 with the administration of anesthesia by an anesthetist from ANIIMS. The surgery was done in one sitting within half an hour and it was a success, as the very next day Mary was able to see, when the bandage was opened, disclosed Dr. Shah. "I am very happy that the child is finally able to see properly and it was by God's grace she got her vision back", said Dr. Shah and Emma's decision to bring the child to the Hospital and to care for her with so much love and dedication deserves a special mention. Dr. Shah further added that vision has many gradings and with time Mary's vision grading will also be tested. She expressed hope that children suffering from similar problem like Mary may now be inspired to come forward and make best use of the free treatment available in the Hospital. Dr. Anita Shah also urged patients to come forward, take advice and avail the free health facilities for any kind of ailment. The delay and reluctant nature in seeking medical advice and treatment may lead to unsuccessful treatment sometimes; she said adding that in the case of Mary, the delay in treatment could have been avoided and she would have been able to see long back. Congenital cataract requires urgent attention; early treatment is the factor that most determines the final visual outcome. Visual development and maturation can be severely affected by the presence of lens opacities during the first ten years of life. The earlier these opacities occur and the denser they are, the less likely it is that the child will develop good vision.

NOTIFICATION

No. F. No. 34-725/2018-Rev; In exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (1) and clauses (b), (c), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (o), (p), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of sub-section (2) of section 109 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (30 of 2013) read with the Notification vide No. SO 1997(E), dated 23.06.2017 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, I. Admiral (Retd.) D.K. Joshi, Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby make the following rules for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, namely:-

**CHAPTER - I
General**

1. Short title, applicability and commencement.— (i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (Compensation, Rehabilitation and Resettlement and Development Plan) Rules, 2018.

ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.— In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

(a) "Aadhaar number" means a 12-digit unique identification number generated and issued to an individual by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) after de-duplication of demographic and biometric information pertaining to that individual;

(b) "Act" means the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (30 of 2013);

(c) "consent-based Aadhaar authentication service" means electronic authentication carried out by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), or agencies appointed by it, after matching the biometric information of an individual at his request or with his consent, with the information maintained by UIDAI in its own central servers, and includes a "Yes/No" response, or a response containing the demographic information and photograph of that individual;

(d) "section" means section of the Act;

(e) words and expressions used but not defined in these rules and defined in the Act, shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.

**CHAPTER II
Request for Land Acquisition**

3. Request for acquisition of land.— (1) After completion of Social Impact Assessment, wherever applicable and receipt of the recommendations of the Expert Group, if it appears to the appropriate Government (the Lt. Governor, A & N Islands herein) that land in any area is required or likely to be required for any public purpose, the Requiring Body or its authorised representative, for whom land is to be acquired shall file the request to the concerned Collector in FORM-I along with the following documents, namely:-

- detailed project report;
- sanction letter of project;
- three copies of Record of Rights and revenue maps of the affected areas;
- information about the classification of land that is, irrigated multi-cropped, single cropped, wasteland, etc;
- any other information required by the Collector.

(2) A copy of the request filed with the Collector under sub-rule (1) shall be submitted to the Commissioner.

(3) Where the Requiring Body is the Government, the request shall be filed by the Secretary of the concerned Department and in case of Public Sector Undertaking, by Secretary of the Department dealing with such undertaking.

4. Action by Collector on receiving request.— (1) (a) The Collector, on receiving the request under sub-rule (1) of rule 3, shall constitute a committee of officers consisting of officers from Revenue Department, Agriculture Department, Forest Department, Water Resources Department, Building Department or any other Department as the Collector deems necessary to make a field visit along with the representatives of the Requiring Body to make a preliminary enquiry regarding -

- availability of waste or arid land;
- correctness of the particulars furnished in the request under sub-rule (1) of rule 3;
- bare minimum land required for the project;
- whether the request is consistent with the provisions of the Act, and submit a report to the Collector.

(b) The report of the committee referred to in clause (a) shall include the following, namely:—

- that the proposed acquisition of land serves public purpose;
- that the extent of land proposed for acquisition is the absolute bare-minimum needed for the project;
- that the acquisition of land at an alternate place has been considered and found not feasible;
- that there is no unutilised land which has been previously acquired in the area;
- that the land, if any, acquired earlier and remained unutilised, may be used for such public purpose;
- the recommendations of the committee.

(2) (a) If the Collector, on the basis of the report of the committee referred to in sub-rule (1), other information available with him and instructions issued by the Central Government in this regard, is satisfied that the request is consistent with the provisions of the Act, he shall make a preliminary estimate of the cost of the acquisition as defined in clause (i) of section 3.

(b) The administrative cost under item (A) of sub-clause (vi) of clause (i) of section 3 shall be at the rate of five per cent of the cost of compensation as provided in sub-clause (i) of clause (i) of section 3 subject to a maximum of five crore rupees.

(c) The Collector shall inform the Requiring Body to deposit the estimated cost of acquisition or part thereof as specified by the Collector in the designated account of the office of the Collector before the publication of declaration under sub-section (2) of section 19 within such period as may be specified by him and the Requiring Body shall deposit the same within the said period.

(3) The Requiring Body shall deposit the balance cost of acquisition after final estimation is prepared by the Collector and in cases where excess amount is awarded by the Authority or Court, the same shall be deposited as and when so required.

**CHAPTER III
Preliminary Notification for Land Acquisition and Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme**

5. Publication of preliminary notification.— (1) The preliminary notification referred to in section 11 shall be published in FORM II.

(2) A copy of the preliminary notification mentioned in section 11 shall be affixed at conspicuous places in the affected areas and shall also be informed to the public by beat of drum.

(3) After publication of the preliminary notification under section 11, the Collector shall ensure completion of the exercise of updating land records as specified here under: -

- delete the names of deceased persons;
- enter the names of the legal heirs of the deceased persons;
- enter the registered transactions of the rights in land such as sale, gift, partition, etc.;
- make all entries of the mortgages in the land records;
- delete the entries of mortgages in case the lending agency issues letter towards full payment of loans taken through registered reconveyance of mortgaged property deeds;
- make necessary entries in respect of all prevalent forest laws;
- make necessary entries in case of the Government land;
- make necessary entries in respect of assets on the land like buildings, trees, wells, etc.;
- make necessary entries of share-croppers in the land;
- make necessary entries of crops grown or sown and the area of such crops; and
- any other relevant entries.

6. Hearing of objections.— (1) The Collector shall issue a notice for inviting objections in FORM III and after hearing all objections and making enquiry as provided under sub-section (2) of section 15 shall submit a report along with his recommendations on the objections to the appropriate Government for decision.

(2) The report of the Collector shall include the following:-

- assessment as to whether the proposed acquisition serves public purpose;
- whether the extent of land proposed for acquisition is the absolute bare-minimum extent needed for the project;
- whether land acquisition at an alternate place has been considered and found not feasible;
- there is no unutilised land which has been previously acquired in the area;
- the land, if any, acquired earlier and remained unutilised, is used for such public purpose and recommendations in respect thereof;
- recommendations on the objections;
- record of proceedings;
- approximate cost of land acquisition in cases where Social Impact Assessment has been exempted.

7. Preparation of Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme and public hearing.— (1) Upon publication of the preliminary notification under sub-section (1) of section 11, the Administrator shall conduct a survey and undertake a census of the affected families within a period of two months from the date of publication of such preliminary notification.

(2) For the purpose of the survey to be conducted and the census of the affected families to be undertaken by the Administrator, he shall take into account -

- the Social Impact Assessment report;
- the records of the Panchayat, Municipality or Municipal Corporation, as the case may be, and other Government records.

(3) The Administrator shall get the data verified by door to door visit of the affected families and by site visits in case of infrastructure projects in the affected area.

(4) The draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme prepared by the Administrator shall, in addition to the particulars mentioned in the sub-section (2) of section 16, contain the following, namely:-

- list of affected families with Aadhaar number of its members, if available;
- list of displaced families with Aadhaar number of its members, if available;
- list of infrastructure in the affected area;
- list of land holdings in the affected area;
- list of trees, buildings, other immovable property or assets attached to the land or building which are to be acquired;
- list of trades or businesses in the affected area;
- list of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, the handicapped or physically challenged persons in the affected area;

Provided that in case a person does not have an Aadhaar number, efforts may be made to get him so enrolled, provided he gives his consent for such enrolment and the claims of the affected families may be facilitated by carrying out consent-based Aadhaar authentication service.

(5) The Administrator shall give wide publicity to the draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme in the affected area through publication in the following manner, namely:-

- in the Official Gazette;
- in two daily newspapers being circulated in the locality of such area of which one shall be in the regional language;
Provided that in a place where such media is not available, then this clause shall not apply;
- in the local language in the Panchayat, Municipality or Municipal Corporation, as the case may be, and in the offices of the District Collector, the Sub-Divisional Magistrate and the Tehsil, Taluk, Sub-division or Block, as the case may be;
- uploaded on the website of the appropriate Government.

(6) The Administrator or an officer authorised by him shall conduct a public hearing in the affected areas by issuing advance notice of three weeks on the date, time and venue mentioned in the said notice in accordance with the provisions of rule 8 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (Social Impact Assessment and Consent) Rules, 2014, dated the 8th August, 2014.

8. Publication of the approved Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme.— The Commissioner shall publish the approved Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme by affixing it in conspicuous places in the affected area.

9. Development Plan for Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes families.— The Development Plan, in cases of a project involving land acquisition on behalf of a Requiring Body which involves involuntary displacement of the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes families, referred to in section 41 shall be prepared in FORM IV.

**CHAPTER IV
Declaration and Award**

10. Publication of declaration for acquisition.— The declaration referred to in sub-section (1) of section 19 shall be published by affixing a copy thereof in local language at conspicuous places in the affected areas in FORM V.

11. Land acquisition award.— The land acquisition award referred to in section 23 shall be made in FORM VI and FORM VII.

12. Fishing rights of affected families.— The fishing rights referred to in column (3) against serial number 9 of the Second Schedule to the Act, shall be allowed by the Fisheries Department in consultation with the Irrigation Department, Revenue Department or any other concerned Department of the Government.

13. Recovery of excess amount.— In the case of any default or refusal to pay the excess amount as referred to in sub-section (3) of section 33, the same shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act, 1890 (1 of 1890) and such recovery proceedings shall be initiated within a period of three years from the date on which the excess amount is found to have been paid.

14. Recovery of rehabilitation and resettlement benefit.— Any rehabilitation and resettlement benefit availed of by making a false claim or through fraudulent means shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act, 1890 (1 of 1890).

15. Limits of extent of land under sub-section (3) of section 2.— The limits of extent of land referred to in clause (a) of sub-section (3) of section 2 shall be twenty hectares in urban areas and forty hectares in rural areas.

**CHAPTER V
Administrator, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Committee and National Monitoring Committee**

16. Powers, duties and responsibilities of Administrator.— The Administrator shall have the following powers, duties and responsibilities, namely:-

- to conduct a survey and undertake a census of the affected families and details of livestock possessed by each affected family in accordance with rule 7;
- to prepare a draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme (hereinafter referred to as the draft Scheme);
- to give wide publicity to the draft Scheme in accordance with sub-rule (5) of rule 7 in the affected areas;
- to make the draft Scheme available to the concerned persons and authorities;
- to organise and conduct public hearings on the draft Scheme;
- to submit the draft Scheme to the Collector;
- to execute and monitor the Rehabilitation and Resettlement scheme;
- to assist the Commissioner in post-implementation social audit of Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme; and
- any other work required to be done for Rehabilitation and Resettlement.

17. Rehabilitation and Resettlement Committee at Project Level.— (1) The Rehabilitation and Resettlement Committee constituted under section 45 shall follow the following procedures:-

- the Committee shall have its first meeting when a draft Scheme has been prepared by the Administrator;
- the Committee shall discuss the draft Scheme and make suggestions and recommendations and thereafter, the Committee shall meet to review and monitor the progress of rehabilitation and resettlement once in a month till the process of rehabilitation and resettlement is completed;
- for the purpose of carrying out the post-implementation social audits, the Committee shall meet once in three months;
- the Committee may visit the affected area and discuss with the affected families if it so requires and also visit the resettlement area to monitor the resettlement process.

(2) The Member-Convenor of the Committee shall be assisted by subordinate officers and staff provided by the appropriate Government.

(3) The non-official members of the Committee shall be entitled to travelling and daily allowance at the rate admissible to the Group 'A' Officers of the Central Government.

18. Salaries, allowances, etc. of Presiding Officer, Registrar and other officers and employees of Authority.— (1) The salary and allowances payable to and the other terms and conditions of service (including pension, gratuity and other retirement benefits) and procedure for the investigation of misbehavior or incapacity of the Presiding Officer of Authority shall be the same as applicable to a District Judge.

(2) The salary and allowances payable to and the other terms and conditions of service (including pension, gratuity and other retirement benefits) of the Registrar of the Authority shall be the same as applicable to an officer of the rank of Deputy Secretary in the Central Government.

(3) The salary and allowances payable to and the other terms and conditions of service (including pension, gratuity and other retirement benefits) of the officers and employees of the Authority shall be the same as applicable to the officers of the Central Government of equivalent rank.

19. Procedure of National Monitoring Committee.— (1) The National Monitoring Committee constituted under section 48 shall review and monitor the implementation of the rehabilitation and resettlement schemes for the projects within two months of the publication of the approved schemes by the Commissioner under section 18 and thereafter, the meetings of the Committee shall be held once in three months to review and monitor the implementation of the rehabilitation and resettlement schemes.

(2) For the purposes of sub-rule (1), the Committee may -

- call for records and information of rehabilitation and resettlement schemes;
- call the Requiring Body for discussion as and when required;
- ask for report about implementation of its decision.

(3) The non-official experts associated with the National Monitoring Committee shall be paid travelling and daily allowance at the rate admissible to an officer of the rank of Joint Secretary in the Central Government.

**CHAPTER VI
Miscellaneous**

20. Manner of return of unutilised land.— (1) When any land acquired under the Act remains unutilised for a period of five years as referred to in section 101, the same shall be returned to the original owner or owners or their legal heirs, as the case may be, or to the Land Bank by issuing a notice to the Requiring Body for whom the land was acquired and by giving an opportunity of being heard and by passing necessary order in writing by the Collector in this behalf for this purpose.

(2) After passing the order by Collector under sub-rule (1), the Collector shall take the possession of the acquired land for the purpose of returning the same to the original owner or owners or their legal heirs, as the case may be, or to the Land Bank.

(3) If the land is being returned to the original owner or owners or their legal heirs, as the case may be, the compensation paid to them excluding solatium shall be returned and deposited by them in the designated account of the office of the Collector as specified by him before taking possession of the land and the amount so refunded shall be used towards development of culturable wastelands.

(4) If the Requiring Body does not handover possession of the said land to Collector, the Collector shall be competent to take the help of the concerned Executive Magistrate and police force to take the possession after giving prior notice to the Requiring Body.

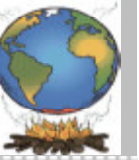
