Panama, May 11 Vice President Shri M Venkaiah Naidu has said that mounting inequality and disparity in the distribution of wealth, economic and social opportunities in different parts of the world is a major challenge. Addressing students of International Studies, University of Panama and other Panamanian Diplomats in Panama today, Shri Naidu said, politics should have ethical principles embedded in every action and there is need to create a polity that respects each individual. He said mounting threats of cyber security, terrorism, nuclear and chemical warfare have threaten the existence of mankind.



The Vice President also asked the students to march forward with a common goal, to be open-minded and work together in harmony. He said, despite expertise and mastery over the physical sciences, new and more powerful challenges have emerged in the wake of our

technological, scientific, medical and other kinds of progress. He further said that even though India and Panama might be thousands of miles apart, technology and innovation have brought everyone together. He said, challenges such as

Corruption, discrimination, exploitation, violence, especially against women and violation of basic human rights continue to erode social fabric. Later, the Vice President paid floral tribute to the statue of Mahatma Gandhi at Plaza Cinco de Mayo in Panama City.

Mumbai, May 11 Civil Aviation Minister, Shri Suresh Prabhu yesterday said early operationalisation of 56 new airports under the regional connectivity scheme, UDAN, would be among his focus areas. In a statement issued in Mumbai today, Shri Prabhu said, improving passenger

amenities, promoting cargo handling facilities and early operationalisation of new airports under UDAN would be his focus areas. The statement said, five airlines including Alliance Air, SpiceJet, TruJet, Air Odisha and Air Deccan, had bagged 128 routes connecting over 30 unserved airports under

the first phase. The UDAN scheme, Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik, seeks to connect unserved and under-served airports as well as make flying more affordable for the people. As many as 70 airports, including 31 unserved and 12 under-served ones, were to be connected under UDAN in the first phase.

Coast Guard evacuates medically ill patient off Makachua-Little Nicobar

Port Blair, May 11 The Indian Coast Guard undertook a medical evacuation of a 55 year old man off Makachua - Little Nicobar yesterday. At about 1100 hrs on May 10, 2018, the Coast Guard District Headquarters No-10 received a request from the Assistant Commissioner Office, Campbell Bay for medical evacuation of tribal captain of Makachua. It was intimated that the patient was feeling uncomfortable due to high BP and allied diseases. On receipt of information, the Ops team of DHQ-10 swung into action and the Coast Guard Ship ICGSC-414 on routine patrol was diverted for Medevac off Makachua. The Coast Guard Ship ICGS C-414 shaped her course with maximum speed, reached off Makachua at 1310 hrs and



the patient named Mr. Andrew William was taken onboard safely and headed towards Campbell Bay. The Ops team of DHQ-10 was maintaining constant communication with Assistant Commissioner Office and SHO Campbell Bay for prompt coordination. The ship entered Campbell Bay at 1600 hrs and the patient was received by the District Medical Officer (DMO) and his team along

with ambulance. The primary medical checkup was provided by DMO and patient was subsequently handed over to Public Health Centre (PHC) staff for further treatment. The condition of the patient was reported stable. Prompt medical evacuation and assistance go a long way in projecting the savior image of Indian Coast Guard in tune with its motto 'Vayam Rakshyam', a communique from Coast Guard said.

India's TT player G Sathiyar signs with top German club

Chennai, May 11
India's top table tennis player G Sathiyar, who won three medals at his Commonwealth Games debut last month, has signed with German Bundesliga's top division club ASV Grunewetersbach Tischtennis. Sathiyar won a team gold, a silver in men's doubles alongside Sharath Kamal, and a bronze in mixed doubles with Manika Batra at the Gold Coast Games. He was also a part of the Indian men's team that finished 13th, its best ever performance, in the World Team Championships in Sweden last week.



"I am really happy on becoming the second Indian to sign up with a club after Sharath Kamal in the most prestigious league in the world. I am looking forward to playing against world class players and I think it will be a great experience," Sathiyar told PTI. The World No 46 will start

playing in the Bundesliga from September after the Asian Games in Jakarta. "I am looking forward to playing with players like Timo Ball, (Simon Gauzy and Hugo Calderano)," added Sathiyar, who has previously played in leagues in Poland and Sweden.

Mohali girl makes cut for Young India fellowship Award in Squash

Mohali, May 11
Mohali squash player 20-year-old Priya Gupta got her letter for being selected for the Young India Fellowship Award by Ashoka University, Sonapat, her father Suresh Gupta was busy collecting scrap in nearby Maloya on his cycle cart. Gupta is currently ranked 14 in the national women's rankings by Squash Rackets Federation of India and the Khelshala trainee is now charting her playing career apart from studies. "When I started playing squash at Government High School, Sector 35, in 2009 started by squash coach Satinder Bajwa, I saw squash as a leisure activity. Later, my interest grew in the sport and when I won the U-15 title in the Chandigarh State Championships, it was a huge moment for my family. My father works as a scrap dealer and earns Rs 10,000 monthly.



Winning squash titles has always brought my family moments to cherish and getting this scholarship worth Rs 9 lakh means a lot for my family," shared Priya, who is a BA Honours final year student at PG Government College, Sector 42. The youngster started playing golf in 2009 at Khelshala, an NGO started by Satinder Bajwa, who has been the director of squash at Harvard University for more than a decade and mentor of eight-time world champion Jansher Khan of Pakistan. Gupta won the U-

15 title in the Chandigarh Squash Championships in 2012 and was a member of the Panjab University team which won the All India Inter University Squash Championships in 2016 and 2017. Last year also saw Gupta winning the title in the Second Khelshala SRFI Squash Championships and the youngster finished fourth at the Hamdard Delton Squash Open played in Delhi this February. Gupta plans to play in the Gymkhana Classic Senior Championships in Delhi next month.

Anirban Lahiri tied 27th after Day 1 of PLAYERS Championship golf

Ponte Vedra (USA), May 11
Indian golfer Anirban Lahiri shot a solid 3-under 69 to be Tied-27th even as the Stadium Course at TPC Sawgrass yielded a lot of low scores on the opening day of the PLAYERS Championship here. While six players including the World No. 1 Dustin Johnson shot a bogey-free 6-under 66 and shared the lead with five others, another six players were a shot behind at T-7th. However, despite a lot of low scores, some big names struggled and that lot included Phil Mickelson (79), Jordan Spieth (75), Rickie Fowler (74) and Justin Thomas (73) among others. Amidst this Tiger Woods (72)



salvaged his round with a closing eagle on the ninth and he was Tied-69th. The leaderboard was crowded with low scores as 14 others shot 4-under to be T-13 and another dozen players, including, Lahiri, carded 3-under to be T-27th. Lahiri, who exited last year with a disastrous 10 on the final Par-4 18th in the second round, got

some revenge with a birdie on it. He had six birdies against three bogeys and was bogey-free on the tougher front stretch of the course, which was his second nine. Lahiri's 69 was also his first round in the 60s at the PLAYERS, where he has missed the cut in both previous appearances in 2015 and 2017.

Serena Williams signs on for WTA tennis tournament in San Jose

California, May 11
Former world No. 1 Serena Williams will open her summer hardcourt season at the WTA tournament in San Jose, California, July 30 to August 5. "I am looking forward to opening my summer season at the Mubadala Silicon Valley Classic and competing in the new venue," Williams, a 23-time Grand Slam champion, said in a statement posted on the tournament website. "This tournament plays an historic role in women's tennis, and as a California native the fans in the Bay Area have always been incredibly supportive." The tournament formerly known as the Bank of the West Classic and held in Stanford, California, is



moving to the campus of San Jose State University this year. Five-time Grand Slam champion Maria Sharapova and defending champion and US Open finalist Madison Keys have also committed to play in the event that is part of the build up to the US Open. On Wednesday, the 36-year-old Williams pulled out of next week's Italian Open in Rome, a

tournament she has won four times. That followed her withdrawal from Madrid and raised doubts as to whether she'll be ready for the French Open in Paris May 27-June 10. The American tennis star made her return to the court in February, six months after giving birth to her daughter Olympia, but has admitted she is struggling to get fully fit.

Rafael Nadal breaks John McEnroe's record to reach Madrid Open quarters

Madrid, May 11
World number one Rafa Nadal set a new record of winning 50 consecutive sets on a single surface by beating Argentine Diego Schwartzman 6-3 6-4 on Thursday to reach the Madrid Open quarter-finals. The Mallorcan surpassed John McEnroe's previous record of 49 consecutive sets on carpet which had stood since 1984 by seeing off 13th seed Schwartzman and claiming a 21st consecutive win on clay. Nadal will face Austrian Dominic Thiem in the last eight on Friday in pursuit of a sixth Madrid Open title after beginning the claycourt season by winning an 11th Monte Carlo Masters and lifting the Barcelona Open trophy for the 11th time. Nadal said he was unaware of the record. "These moments I don't go out there



and think about these kind of things. I just think about my opponent, what I have to do to keep on going. That's all," Nadal told a news conference. "When my career is over, these are things that are going

to be there for always. They are big records. It's difficult to be able to win 50 sets in a row. But I've done it. Let's not talk about that any more and let's continue on what we have ahead."
