In a major step to contain the burgeoning number of COVID-19 cases in South Andaman District, the District Magistrate has prohibited manufacture, storage, distribution and sale on all forms of processed/flavoured/scented chewing tobacco, whether going by the name of Gutkha, Pan masala, Zarda packed and unpacked/loose etc. which contain tobacco and or nicotine as an



ingredient in the entire District of South Andaman.

quantities of Gutkha, Pan Masala, Khaini and scented tinned tobacco were seized. Punitive actions as deemed fit are being initiated against the violators.

The District Magistrate, South Andaman District has warned all concerned to refrain from sale of tobacco products to deter public from spitting in public places to contain the spread of COVID 19 in the District. The general (Contd. on last page)

Media briefed on COVID-19

Secretary (IP&T) hails tremendous response of people towards vaccination drive

Port Blair, July 16

The Secretary, IP&T, Shri Sunil Kumar Singh while briefing media on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that two corona positive cases have been detected during the RTPCR test conducted on 349 passengers who arrived here yesterday. He said, RAT was conducted on 234 persons bound for Middle & North Andaman at Ferrargunj

and it is encouraging to note that no positive case was detected.

About vaccination drive which is smoothly conducted in the Islands, he said that till 3 pm today, 1952 eligible persons were inoculated in South Andaman District, out of which 352 were in the age group of 18-44. Today, 1 flight with 153 passengers arrived here and their RTPCR reports are awaited. He

said, out of the total 2,81,603 (approx) target beneficiaries to be vaccinated, 2,48,150 have been administered doses of vaccine.

The Secretary also urged the people to follow COVID appropriate behaviour to protect themselves and other members of the family from the virus.

The Deputy Director, G.B. Pant Hospital, Dr.

Amitabha De informed that the number of corona positive patients admitted in the G. B Pant Hospital is presently 5, out of which, 1 patient is on Oxygen support and no patient is on ventilator. No COVID patients are admitted in the COVID Care Centres in Port Blair. He also disclosed that no corona cases are in North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar District.

New Delhi July 16 (PIB) Union Education Minister, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan and Tribal Affairs Minister, Shri Arjun Munda jointly launched the 'School Innovation Ambassador Training Program' for 50,000 school teachers today. Speaking on the occasion, Minister Pradhan said that teachers are the biggest influence in our lives. He said that we aim to make our teachers, change-agents and ambassadors of innovation to make our students future-ready. Shri Pradhan stressed that technology is reshaping the world and our students have the potential to not only address domestic but also the global challenges. The program launched today is a collaborative effort by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, CBSE

and AICTE, which will in turn nurture lakhs of students with innovation capabilities, develop a culture of innovation and lay the foundation of a new and vibrant India, he added. The Union Minister for Tribal Affairs, Shri Arjun Munda expressed his gratitude that the Ministry of Education has launched its new initiative in the field of innovation in collaboration with Tribal Affairs Ministry which will benefit the large number of schools for tribal children across the country. This programme will have far reaching consequences which will help to fulfil the Prime Minister's vision of a New India, the Minister elaborated. Shri. Arjun Munda further said that 'SIATP' will give wings to the creativity of the children and provide a platform so that they can give

something new to the world with their ideas. Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) for tribal children is another ambitious programme of the Prime Minister under which 740 EMRS will be established in tribal dominated areas over the next three years, he said. The students of EMRS will greatly benefit from SIATP since it is also the endeavour of Tribal Affairs Ministry to give the best possible education to the tribal children. Sh Arjun Munda explained that through this unique capacity building programme for teachers, prominence has been given to development of creativity, collaboration, critical thinking and communication skills among children and the integration of Eklavya Schools into the entire

programme is a big step in this direction for the meaningful development of tribal children. Speaking on the occasion, Secretary, Tribal Affairs, Shri Anil Kumar Jha said that encouraging innovation is at the core of the New Education Policy. Teachers will need to evolve new methods of teaching; they will need to first transform themselves into guides from being instruments of written text books. Shri Jha further said that apart from running Ekalavya World Education School, the Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been supporting initiatives of States / Union Territories in spreading scientific education to tribal students and the new initiative will help promote quality education among tribal children.

2,51,493 eligible beneficiaries inoculated with COVISHIELD vaccine in Isles so far
66,595 persons vaccinated in the age group of 18 to 44 years

Port Blair, July 16

As per health data, a total of 2,51,493 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). Today, a total of 3343 doses of vaccine were administered to the beneficiaries in A&N Islands. In South Andaman District, 1962 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 352 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

Similarly, in North & Middle Andaman District, 699 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 89 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In Nicobar District, 682 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 496 were in the age group of 18-44 years. As on date, a total of 66,595 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated in A&N Islands. Meanwhile, the registration slot for 18 plus category for COVID-19 vaccination will open from 9. 30 am onwards on July 17, 2021, a press release from DHS said.

- Take adequate sleep (7-8 hours) and avoid day time sleep.

II. Ayurvedic Immunity Promoting Measures

Option-1:

- Consume Chyavanprash 20 gm in divided doses on empty stomach with lukewarm water.
- Golden Milk- Half teaspoon Haldi (turmeric) powder in 150 ml hot milk - once or twice a day.

Option-2:

- Take Guduchi GhanVati 500 mg/ Ashwagandha tablet 500 mg twice daily after meals with lukewarm water.
- Golden Milk- Half teaspoon Haldi (turmeric) powder in 150 ml hot milk - once or twice a day.

Option-3:

- Drink herbal tea/decoction (Kadha) made from 3 gm powder comprising Tulasi (Basil)-4 part, Dalchini (Cinnamon)-2 part, Shunthi (Dry Ginger)-2 Kalimirch (Black pepper)-1 part, mixed in 150ml hot boiled water once or twice a day. Add Gud (Jaggery)/Munakka (Raisin)/Choti Elaichi (Cardamom) to improve taste and flavor.
- Golden Milk- Half teaspoon Haldi (turmeric) powder in 150 ml hot milk once or twice a day.

III. Simple Ayurvedic Procedures

- Nasal application - Apply Sesame oil / Coconut oil / Cow Ghee or Anu Taila in both the nostrils in morning and evening.
- Oil pulling therapy- Take 1 table spoon sesame oil or coconut oil in the mouth. Do not drink, swish in the mouth for 2 to 3 minutes and spit it off followed by warm water rinse. This can be done once or twice a day.

IV. During dry cough /sore throat

- Steam inhalation with plain water OR fresh Pudina (Mint) leaves OR Ajwain (Caraway seeds) OR Karpur (Camphor) can be practiced once in a day.
- Lavang (Clove)/Mulethi (Licorice) powder mixed with natural sugar/honey can be taken 2-3 times a day in case of cough or throat irritation.






