SC introduces scheme to provide legal services to middle income group

New Delhi, Feb 17
Now, it is easier for the middle and relatively lower income group to avail and enjoy the legal services of the country. The Supreme Court has introduced the Middle Income Group Scheme. It is a self-

supporting scheme which provides legal services to the middle income group whose gross income is not exceeding Rs. 60,000 per month. Under the scheme, middle class people who can't afford the expensive litigation in the Supreme

Court can avail the services of the society for a nominal amount. The person desirous of availing the benefit of the Scheme shall have to fill up the form prescribed and accept all the terms and conditions contained therein.

India's economic growth to make a sharp recovery following demonetisation: RBI Governor

New Delhi, Feb 17
Reserve Bank Governor Shri Urjit Patel today said India's economic growth will make a sharp recovery following the recall of old 500 and 1,000 rupee notes. In an interview to CNBC-TV18, Shri Patel made a strong case for continuing with globalisation, even in the face of a potential shift to trade protectionism under US President Mr Donald Trump, as India has benefited from open

trade. He said, the demonetisation has happened at a fast pace and that was part of the plan. RBI last week lowered economic growth projection for the current fiscal to 6.9 per cent from the previously estimated 7.1 per cent, but saw it bouncing back in a big way to 7.4 per cent in 2017-18. Shri Patel said, the benefit of junking 86 per cent of currency in circulation will take time to fully play out

and needs more work to ensure they are lasting. Asked when India could achieve 9 per cent GDP growth, he said it is difficult to predict sustainable growth rates. The six-member monetary policy committee (MPC) headed by Shri Patel had last week kept interest rates unchanged at 6.25 per cent for the second straight meeting and changed policy stance to neutral from accommodative.

Centre launches campaign to promote bio waste management

Chandigarh, Feb 17
Union Ministry of Urban Development has launched its new publicity campaign under the Swachh Bharat Mission aimed at encouraging people to convert kitchen waste into compost for scientific processing of municipal solid. Named as 'Compost Banao, Compost Apnao', the campaign has superstar Amitabh Bachchan as its brand ambassador. Stating this here today, Joint Secretary of Urban Development Ministry

Shri Praveen Prakash said that scientific processing of solid waste in all urban areas was one of the key initiatives being carried out under Swachh Bharat Mission. The Centre has been stepping up efforts to encourage conversion of biodegradable waste into compost, for use as fertilizer, and reduce the amount of waste going to landfill sites, he said. The new campaign is an attempt to encourage citizens to contribute towards making their city

clean. Shri Prakash said the Ministry has adopted a multimedia approach for the campaign. To maximize the impact and reach of the messaging, the campaign comprises TV commercials, which would be aired through all leading TV channels and would be supported through print, digital cinema, radio and outdoor ad campaigns-posters, hoardings in public spaces across various cities, he said. 'Swachh Bharat' Ambassador visits Boys School

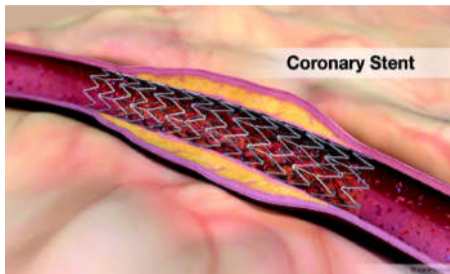
Port Blair, Feb. 17

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Normalcy in currency operations restored: Finance Minister



New Delhi, Feb 17
Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley on Friday said normalcy has been restored within few weeks of the unprecedented decision to recall 86 per cent of the currency in circulation and there is no shortage of notes in market. Currency note printing presses of Reserve Bank of India as well as Security Printing and Minting Corporation of India Ltd (SPMCIL) have worked without a break to remonetise by issuing new bank notes, he said. Speaking at the 11th Foundation Day function of SPMCIL here, he said the easiest task during demonetisation was to pass comments and make snide remarks. "But, the toughest work is to

implement it. This is perhaps the biggest demonetisation drive in the world that was aimed at striking at the very root of corruption, black money and counterfeit currency," he said. Stating that people often commented that it may take up to one year or at least seven months to restore normalcy, he said the task has been achieved within a few weeks and there is no shortage (of bank notes) in market for even a day," he said. And this has been achieved "without a single incident" of unrest anywhere in the country, he said, adding that this was possible because of the exemplary work done by the

Shuttler PV Sindhu jumps to career-best number 5 in BWF rankings

New Delhi, Feb 17 India's star shuttler PV Sindhu has risen to a career best BWF ranking of number five. She overtook Japan's Akane Yamaguchi, as per the latest rankings released on Wednesday. This is the first time that Sindhu has broken into the top five. Saina Nehwal, who is ranked ninth, is the other Indian in the top 10, while Chinese Taipei's Tai Tzu Ying continues to lead the rankings. Saina had a rather forgettable year in 2016



as she had been out for most of the year due to a knee injury. Sindhu, in contrast, had probably the best year of her career as she won the Silver Medal at the Rio Olympics and became the first Indian woman to win an Olympic silver medal.

DRS enabled umpires to make 98.5 per cent correct calls: ICC

Dubai, Feb 17 The ICC Chief Executive David Richardson has revealed that the Emirates Panel of Umpires' usage of the Decision Review System (DRS) has enabled them to attain a staggering accuracy rate of 98.5 per cent. "I am very proud of the Emirates Elite Panel of Match Officials and our targets for correct decision making this year currently stands at 94 per cent rising to 98.5 per cent after DRS," Richardson wrote in his article for ICC's official website. Richardson also said that another round of deliberations will happen during the first half of this year on working out a strategy for the inclusion of cricket in Olympic Games. "...We also

need to determine cricket's strategy in respect of participation in the Olympic Games. Is it something we will continue to explore in the first half of 2017 and if our Members agree they would like to pursue it, then that's when the real work for Olympic inclusion begins," he stated. Richardson also said that the global body's endeavour remains to protect the integrity of the sport. "Protecting the integrity of the sport, is of fundamental importance to everyone here at the ICC. We must continue to provide leadership and support in the global fight against corruption and we will complete the implementation of all agreed recommendations made by the Integrity Working Party. "But protecting the integrity of

cricket goes beyond our Anti-Corruption unit and we must ensure that our anti-doping programme is as effective as possible. We will introduce blood testing in 2017 as part of our ongoing commitment to a drug free sport and will continue to maintain our WADA compliance," Richardson wrote.
