The destroyed or damaged infrastructures have been rebuilt, in much stronger and better way, he said, adding that the best way to plan the way ahead is to look back and learn from our experiences. ## Lt Governor undertakes aerial sortie on Indian Navy's P8 I aircraft



Port Blair, Mar. 17 The Lt Governor A&N Islands, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi embarked onboard Indian Navy's modern state of the art Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance (LRMR) aircraft, P8 I, for an aerial sortie on Mar 16, 2017. The sortie was aimed at introducing the capabilities and performance of force multiplier, which would enable the nation's Armed Forces to dominate the future battle space.

The Lt Governor was impressed with the capability of the aircraft and appreciated Indian Navy's role in safeguarding the nation's vast maritime boundary. The P8 I aircraft squadron operates from INS Rajali near Chennai. The P-8 I aircraft is equipped for long range anti submarine warfare, anti - surface warfare, intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance in support of broad area, maritime and littoral operations. With its high

speed and high endurance, the aircraft is capable of thrusting a punitive response and maintaining a watch over India's immediate and extended areas of interest.

The P8 I aircraft has been operating from INS Utkrosh for over a year. The aircraft is deployed at Port Blair every month for undertaking surveillance missions in the Area of Responsibility of

the Andaman Nicobar Command. The aircraft, in addition, also undertakes regular surveillance sorties of Andaman Nicobar Islands from INS Rajali.

The aircraft is capable of carrying Torpedoes, Depth Charges and Harpoon anti-ship missiles. The aircraft is also capable of operating sonobuoys to detect and track submarines, an ANC communique said.

Port Blair, Mar 17 The circuit sitting of CAT, Calcuta Bench at Port Blair will be held from March 27 to April 10 (both days inclusive) to dispose of cases pending in the Court of Central Administrative Tribunal. Fresh application will also be entertained during this period.

### No health cess in new National Health Policy: Govt

New Delhi, Mar 17 The new National Health Policy has rejected earlier proposals to introduce a health cess to scale up the public investments in health care. The new policy which was unveiled yesterday, aims at providing assured health services to all and also

proposes free drugs, diagnostics and emergency care services in all public hospitals. Briefing reporters in New Delhi yesterday, Health Minister Shri J P Nadda said, the talks of introducing a health cess is wrong and there is no question of introducing health cess.

### Govt extends support for promotion of AYUSH healthcare to States, Union Territories

New Delhi, Mar 17 The government today said through centrally sponsored scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) it extends support for promotion of AYUSH healthcare to the states and union territories for co-location of Ayush facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and Community Health Centres (CHCs). Replying to questions in the Lok Sabha, Minister of

Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy Minister Shri Shripad Yesso Naik said NAM also extends support for development of Ayush educational institution, Quality Control of Ayurveda, Unnai and Homeopathy. Shri Naik also informed the House that nearly 3590 hospitals are providing Ayush medical treatment in the country. The minister also said NAM also provides

support to District Hospitals (DHs) for development of infrastructure, purchase of equipment and furniture and supply of essential AYUSH medicines. Shri Naik said under National Health Mission support is provided to states for strengthening their healthcare systems including for mainstreaming of AYUSH based on the requirements.

On receiving the information, a team from Manglutan Range rushed to the spot to trap the crocodile with the help of net. While doing so, the crocodile suddenly attacked one of the staff namely, Shri. C. Ummer, Regular Mazdoor of Manglutan Range who received minor injuries on his leg. Later, he



was shifted to Primary Health Center, Manglutan for treatment.

Later, the animal rescue team of Wildlife Division swung into action, and the team led by Shri. Manjeet Singh Bohra, Deputy Ranger, Shri. Abdul Razak, Veterinary Compounder, Shri. V.K. Unush, Forest Guard, Shri. K. Lakshman, Animal Attender along with Shri. Gopi, Forest Guard and

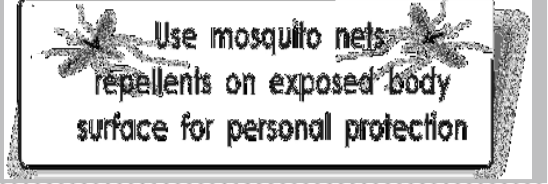

Ministry of Road Transport and Highways vide Notification No. GSR 1183 (E) dated 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 has further amended Rule 32 and Rule 81 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 110 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which is reproduced below for the information of public:

- (1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (Twenty-second Amendment) Rules, 2016.
- They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- In the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989,-
  - in rule 9, in sub-rule (2), for the words, letters and figures "as is referred to in Sl.No.8 of the Table to rule 32", the words and figures "as specified in the Table in rule 32" shall be substituted;
  - in rule 14, in sub-rule (1), for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-  
“(b) appropriate fee as specified in rule 32, for the test, or the subsequent test, as the case may be, of competence to drive for each class and for issue of licence;”
  - for rule 32, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-  
“32. Fees.—The fees which shall be charged under the provisions of this Chapter shall be as specified in the table below:  
Provided that the States may levy additional amounts to cover the cost of automation and technology utilized for conducting the testing or providing value added services.

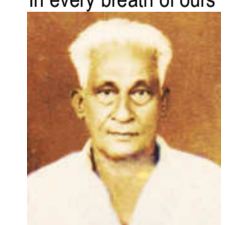

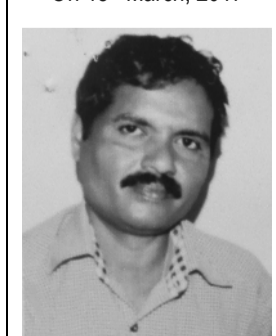

India reach 120/1 after Smith takes Australia to 451

Ranchi, Mar 17  
The Indian batsmen showed positive intent in their reply to Australia's commanding score of 451 by reaching 120 for 1 on the second day of the third cricket Test here. K L Rahul (67) scored his fourth half-century of the series and together with Murali Vijay (42 batting), conjured up a stand of 91 -- their best of the series -- on a JSCA track that remained good for batting. India still need 132 runs to avoid the follow-on but with Virat Kohli's fitness a concern, the onus will be on other batsmen to help India post a substantial total. By far India's best batsman in the current series, this was Rahul's fifth half-century in Test cricket. But just when he was looking good for a big score, Rahul frittered away the advantage edging one to Matthew Wade off comeback man Pat Cummins' delivery.



He faced 102 balls hitting nine boundaries while Vijay also looked compact at the other end remaining unbeaten on 42 in his 50th Test appearance. Cheteshwar Pujara was at the other end, batting on 10, when stumps were drawn for the day. Vijay hit six boundaries in 102 balls showing enormous patience as he left anything that was remotely pitched outside the off-stump. The Smith-Maxwell duo put on 191 runs for the fifth wicket, laying the foundation for the big Australian total. Australia's last five wickets fell for a mere 56 runs which prevented Smith from completing his double hundred. For India, Ravindra Jadeja (5/124) bowled with a lot of heart sending down as many as 49.3 overs. Equally praiseworthy was Umesh Yadav's performance (3/108 in 31 overs), who bowled with pace and got the old ball to reverse on a consistent basis. Ravichandran Ashwin had a bad day in office as he got 1/114 in 34 overs. More noticeably, not for once did he look menacing on a track that did not offer much help unlike the first two Test matches.

Sports Minister urges J&K CM to provide infrastructure for Kickboxers

New Delhi, Mar 17  
Sports Minister Shri Vijay Goel has urged Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Ms. Mehbooba Mufti to provide adequate infrastructure to the state kickboxers after a medal-winning young Kashmiri athlete uploaded a video in social media requesting the

government to improve facilities. Tajamul Islam, an 8-year-old Kashmiri girl, who had won a gold medal in 2016 World Kickboxing Championship in Italy in the sub-junior category, released a video in social networking site twitter. In the letter addressed to Ms. Mehbooba Mufti, the Sports Minister said, Centre has funded establishment of Multi-Purpose Halls in all districts in Jammu and Kashmir under the special package. In the video, Tajamul urged the government to take steps towards creating indoor facilities for the athletes in the state of Jammu and Kashmir.

We have to set a benchmark by qualifying regularly for AFC Asian Cup: Sunil Chhetri

Mumbai, Mar 17  
Indian football team's talismanic striker Sunil Chhetri has his country to "set a benchmark" by regularly qualifying for AFC Asian Cup, the continent's premier tournament. India are preparing for the Asian Cup Qualifiers, and first up will be Myanmar, who had emerged winners in the last meeting between the two sides -- in the 2014 edition of AFC Challenge Cup. "I just want to win this game. We have to set a benchmark that we are regularly qualifying



for the AFC Asian Cup and this is the time to achieve it. That is how you will know that you are improving. This game against Myanmar is of huge importance for us as we have a realistic chance of qualification," Chhetri said today. India's highest scorer in the international arena, Chhetri said that he and his boys will "need to play at our best" to beat Myanmar. "Myanmar are one of the toughest teams to face in South East Asia at the moment. It will be a tough challenge for us and we have to play to the best of our abilities if we have to win there," Chhetri said prior to a practice session at the Andheri Sports Complex. India have been clubbed in Group A alongside Kyrgyzstan, Myanmar and Macau.

process was a great success with few shortcomings. He suggested for few actions to be included for disaster preparedness which include enhancement of safety operation in sectors viz. shipping, communication, setting up of doppler weather radar of long range which can cover about 400 km range, marking of channel in Port Blair harbor for easy berthing of ships during night, constructing sluice gate to check flooding of Port Blair Airport and various other steps for safeguarding low flying aircrafts in the Islands. He also paid glowing tributes to the then Lt Governor, Late Prof Ram Kapse for playing a proactive role during the disaster.  
The other members of the panel also highlighted their experiences and gave suggestions for future action plan. Shri Govind Ram suggested for initiating new plan of action in disaster management. Shri Rajiv Shukla suggested for improvement in sectors like communication, roads and power which are essential for relief and rehabilitation work. Shri Naresh Kumar stressed the need for identifying the requirements from the affected people, procurement of the relief materials and to ascertain whether the assets can be operated by them. This, he said, will check wastage of certain relief materials such as DG Set etc. Shri Puneet Goel also shared his experience during the relief and rehabilitation process and suggested for strengthening the disaster management mechanism for tackling future calamities. He also suggested that all stakeholders, right from top to bottom, including civil societies, NGOs must extend all possible cooperation during relief work.  
In the second session which was presided over by Shri D.S.Negi, former Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, the panelists suggested for tackling situation post disaster such as trauma and psychological issues of the affected people. Shri Negi stated that psychological problems of the affected people should be addressed by involving experts for counseling. He also stressed for focusing on training and communication which are the key sectors that need to be strengthened. Through training, man power can be augmented from among the trained public in dealing with disaster as volunteers while communication will also help disseminate information on the required manpower and materials for the affected areas. The members of the panel including Shri Govind Ram, Shri Puneet Goel, Shri Naresh Kumar also highlighted their experiences during the relief operation and suggested that the affected people need to be consulted as to what activities can be selected as a long term rehabilitation for their livelihood. This, they said, will enable them to take up economic activities viable for them.  
Summing up the deliberation, Shri VV Bhatt urged all individual involved in rehabilitation process to learn from the lacunas of the past and upgrade their knowledge based on the suggestions made during the deliberation so as to prepare them to meet any exigencies. "While discharging our duties as relief officers, we must be clear of our decision and take steps accordingly", he said.

Lewis Hamilton still the man to beat; Mercedes eye another title

London, Mar 17  
Last season was the one that got away for Lewis Hamilton and the triple Formula One world champion is not prepared to let that happen again in 2017. The Briton has won more grands prix than anyone still driving around a racetrack, and knows all the tricks as he starts his 11th season. Bookmakers have him as the uncontested 10/11 favourite ahead of the March 26 season-opener in Australia. There could still be a few bumps in the road ahead, however. For those who fear the Mercedes man will have it easy following the retirement of Nico Rosberg, the German team mate who



beat him to the title while winning fewer races, there is an alternative scenario. "Imagine Ferrari are great and the championship is being fought between Sebastian Vettel, with four world championships and Lewis, with three," 1996 world champion Damon Hill told reporters. "That's going to be an exciting battle." It could happen, with Ferrari fastest in pre-season testing and raising suspicions that their new SF70H car has closed the chasm between Mercedes and the rest. Vettel is the second favourite in the betting odds at 4/1. Mercedes have won 51 of the last 59 races, and all but two of 21 last year.

Brazil qualify for 2017 Fifa U-17 World Cup in India

New Delhi, Mar 17  
Football powerhouse Brazil on Friday qualified for the 2017 Fifa Under-17 World Cup to be held in India from October 6-28. Along with Brazil, Chile and Paraguay have also booked their ticket for the event from South America. The three teams qualified from the South American U-17 Championship, currently underway in Chile. The three countries have now secured three of the four Conmebol tickets on offer to the Fifa U-17 World Cup with a match to spare.

said that to have a proper strategy for disaster reduction, the Administration has adopted a holistic, positive and technology-driven strategy by promoting values of prevention, mitigation, preparedness and response. He emphasized that disaster risk reduction remains the primary objective of the Administration.

Mentioning about the preparedness, he pointed that despite the best preparedness and highest response standards, disasters, both manmade and natural, remain a challenge to mankind. To capture information about all incidents; hazardous situation that occurs daily in and around these Islands, a State Emergency Operation Centre has been established with State-of-the-Art communication facility which is functioning 24x7, he informed the gathering.

The Lt Governor further disclosed that to augment better information and communication network, the Administration has taken up major initiatives under which 10 Automated Weather Stations have been set up at all the Helipads in coordination with ISRO and data is being gathered for smooth navigation of our helicopters. Further, 35 locations have already been identified by the Administration in coordination with Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad for installing GPS strong motion Sensors to collect the data related to movement of Earth, he said.

He also informed that the Administration has already taken up with Indian Meteorological Department (IMD), New Delhi for commissioning of Doppler Weather Radar (DWR) in these Islands, the land for which has been allocated.

The IMD has assured that in the second phase of their plan, they will be installing the DWR in these Islands. This will help forecasting of Weather in an accurate manner as these Islands are also prone to Hydro-Meteorological disasters, he said. Apart from this, the Administration has also signed a tri-partite agreement with INCOIS, BSNL, Port Blair for setting up of Automated Tsunami Sirens along with 35 GPS observatories for disseminating Tsunami Sirens by centrally triggering it from the State Emergency Operation Centre, the Lt Governor informed.

Concluding his speech, the Lt Governor said "I am hopeful that the symposium on 'Tsunami-2004: Memories & Lessons', would be fruitful and deliberations of the delegates and the resource persons during various sessions of the symposium would be insightful". A compilation of the deliberations will be useful handbook for the Directorate of Disaster Management in planning their future strategies, said the Lt Governor.

In his address on occasion, the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar recalled the tragedy of Dec, 26, 2004, the massive Tsunami which struck the Islands and other parts of neighboring countries. He also narrated about the relief and evacuation process and the various contributions made by the team led by Shri V.V.Bhatt (former Chief Secretary, A&N Administration). He said the whole team galvanized into action with the cooperation of defense forces, police, civil societies, IRBn, CISF and other agencies despite limited resources and no relief aid from International Organizations, unlike other countries. He also highlighted the rehabilitation process which was executed excellently by the team led by Shri DS Negi (former Chief Secretary, A&N Administration). The Chief Secretary also acknowledged the contributions made by many unsung heroes during the time of disaster and said, it was concerted efforts from all quarters. The Tsunami of 2004 brought out the leadership qualities among people and they were united in all their efforts, he said.

About the symposium, he said, memories of the past need to be recalled to an extent that it guides us in the future and this seminar will focus on what the Administration did, what it could have done and what it should do in the future.

Highlighting the journey post 2004, the Chief Secretary remarked that we have traversed a long journey. A lot of developments have taken place and a fully fledged Department of Disaster Management came into effect from 2009-10 onwards. Besides, infrastructure developments, communication set ups were improved, SEO centers have been set up in Port Blair and six other locations of Isles which are interlinked with the support of INCOIS besides hotlines and VSATs have been strengthened and with the help of INCOIS, the Administration is monitoring the events of the Islands on timely basis.

He further added that capacity building trainings were also provided and NDRF has stationed a team of 45 persons here to help during emergency. Apart from this, each Department has been strengthened internally and is working in coordinated efforts besides awareness campaign and mock drills are being conducted from time to time.

Mentioning that the Islands lies in the seismic zone, the Chief Secretary stressed that response to disaster and mobilization of people needs to be tested time and again so that we are fully prepared for any untoward incidents. Mentioning about cyclone 'Vardha' which struck the Islands in the recent past, the Chief Secretary remarked that it gave an opportunity for the Administration to test its preparedness and response to disaster which was done reasonably well. However, he added, certain shortcomings came to fore and more efforts need to be put for mitigating future instances. He highlighted the need to have a broader and bolder understanding of different types of disaster and to integrate the best in technology, adding that human elements, along with feeling of commitment should continue. He expressed hope that the timely symposium would yield effective outputs leading to an action plans which will be a guiding force for the Administration to be prepared to meet future exigencies.

During the first session, a documentary on disaster management activities in A&N Islands and a presentation on vulnerability, preparedness, response, mitigation and capacity building was made by the Directorate of Disaster Management. This was followed by views, observations and suggestions of the delegates.
