## Govt working to ensure that farmers get modern seeds, adequate power supply and easy market access: PM

New Delhi, Mar 17  
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said Government is working to ensure that farmers get modern seeds, adequate power supply and easy market access. Addressing the farmers at annual Krishi Unnati Mela in New Delhi today, the Prime Minister said, the Centre has decided that for all notified crops, Minimum Support Price (MSP) will be at least one and a half times the cost of produce.

He said, for this, the cost will include various elements including labour, rent for machinery, cost of seeds and fertilizers and land rent. He reiterated his government's commitment to double farmers' income by 2022.

Rural Retail Markets with wholesale and global markets. He said in this year's Union Budget, Grameen Retail Agriculture Markets have
