Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 17 The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, released the 22nd installment (December 2025 - March 2026) of the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme from the Jyoti-Bishnu International Cultural Centre, Khanapara, Guwahati, Assam on March 13. The PM-KISAN Scheme is a Central Sector Scheme introduced

during February 2019 to support landholding farmers across the country in meeting their financial needs. Under this initiative, farmers receive direct benefit transfers of Rs. 6000/- per year, in three equal installments of Rs. 2000/- per Quarter directly into their bank accounts linked with their Aadhaar numbers.

The Department of Agriculture successfully

organized a programme at all Blocks and various Gram Panchayats on 13th March, 2026 to witness the live telecast of the release of the 22nd installment of the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) Scheme by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

State-level re-orientation training on 'Management of metabolic disorders in Homoeopathy' held at TGCE

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 17 A three-day state-level re-orientation training programme on 'Management of Metabolic Disorders in the Homoeopathic System of Medicine' was organized by the AYUSH Wing of the Directorate of Health Services in collaboration with ANSAS, NAM for Medical Officers and CHOs (Homoeopathy) under the Health Department from Mar. 12 to 14 at the TGCE Auditorium.

Chairing the inaugural session, Dr. H.M. Siddharaju, Director of Health Services, as the chief

guest stated that the programme would provide an invaluable opportunity for Medical Officers to gain deeper insights into Homoeopathic practices in view of the increasing prevalence of metabolic diseases and emphasized the need for continuous training and capacity building.

Dr. Pradip Kumar Bairy, Former Professor and HOD, Department of Repertory, MBH Medical College and Hospital; Dr. Sajeev, BHMS, MD (Practice of Medicine), CMO, Department of Homoeopathy, Government of Kerala and District

Convenor, Janani Infertility Project; and Dr. Santi Adhikari, RO I/c, Central Research Unit, CCRH, SVP also addressed the trainees.

The technical sessions covered various metabolic disorders such as Diabetes Mellitus, Dyslipidemia, Insulin Resistance, Gout, NAFLD (Non-Alcoholic Fatty Liver Disease), and Obesity, and the speakers presented the Homoeopathic approach to their management.

7.365 kg ganja seized in consignment from Kolkata; accused apprehended by Anti-Narcotics Police

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 17 Demonstrating its firm commitment in combating drug trafficking and substance abuse in the Islands, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station (ANPS), Andaman & Nicobar Police has achieved another significant breakthrough in the investigation of a Narcotics trafficking case registered earlier this year.

On 29.01.2026 at about 1000 hrs, credible and specific intelligence was received that a suspicious parcel sent anonymously from Kolkata through a private courier had reached the godown of a courier service at Sri Vijaya Puram, which was suspected to contain contraband substances. Acting swiftly on the information, and after completing legal formalities a raiding team of the Anti-Narcotics Police Station was constituted.

The team proceeded to the godown along with independent witnesses and verified the consignment records. It was found that the

consignment consisted of three parcels, namely a refrigerator, MG-3 jars and a sound bar. The parcels were opened in the presence of witnesses and officers.

During inspection of the refrigerator, seven packets wrapped with brown adhesive tape were found concealed inside the same. On examination, the packets were found to contain dry leafy substance with flowering tops emitting the characteristic odour of ganja, the same was tested using the field kit which tested positive for ganja.

The packets were weighed individually and the total quantity of ganja was found to be 7.365 kilograms. The contraband along with the articles used for concealment, namely the refrigerator, sound bar and mixer grinder, were seized and sealed on the spot following the due legal procedures.

Accordingly, FIR No. 01/2026 dated 29.01.2026 was registered at Anti-Narcotics Police Station under Section 20(b)(ii)(B)

of the NDPS Act, 1985, and investigation was taken up.

During the course of technical investigation, the accused Haripada Mondal (34 yrs), R/o Amlamethi, Dighirpar Para, Gosaba, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal, was traced to Kolkata. Accordingly, a police team consisting of SI A. Santhosh, PC Raja Rao and PC Anup Das proceeded to Kolkata on 10.03.2026 under the close supervision of Inspector K. Binoj, SHO, Anti-Narcotics Police Station. After sustained efforts, the team successfully apprehended the accused from Kolkata and brought him to Sri Vijaya Puram by air on 16.03.2026.

The accused shall be produced before the Hon'ble Court to obtain Police Custody (PC) remand for sustained interrogation to identify his associates involved in the narcotics network and to trace the financial trail connected with the trafficking of contraband, a press release from DIGP (CID) said.

N&MA Police launched Operation Sea Vigil; 9 poachers apprehended, engine dinghy seized

Mayabunder, Mar. 17 Acting on credible intelligence, the N&M Andaman District Police launched 'Operation Sea Vigil' on 15/03/2026 to prevent illegal poaching activities in vulnerable coastal areas under the jurisdiction of PS Kalighat, with assistance from the Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC).

A specialized Anti-Poaching Team carried out intensive combing operations in the coastal creeks and mangrove belts. During the operation, police intercepted a wooden engine dinghy carrying nine Myanmarese poachers. Six of them were immediately apprehended, while three managed to escape into the dense mangrove forest.

Upon inspection of the dinghy, the team recovered approximately 350 kg of sea



cucumbers. The engine dinghy along with all materials found onboard was seized.

On 16/03/2026, the Anti-Poaching Team resumed search operations in the mangrove area and successfully apprehended the remaining three absconding poachers who were hiding in the forest. With this, the total number of arrests in the operation reached nine.

All apprehended poachers along with the

seized materials have been taken into custody for further legal action under relevant laws.

the drive was centred on a meticulous sweep of the entire stretch of Wandoor Beach. Every corner of the sandy expanse was scrutinized to ensure the removal of accumulated debris that threatens both aesthetic beauty and marine health. By the conclusion of the event, it was reported that approximately 25 to 30 gunny bags of refuse had been successfully collected. This waste consisted of a variety of non-biodegradable materials, including plastic and glass bottles, fragments of thermocol, discarded tin cans, and disposable catering items like plates and cups.

Once the debris was gathered, it was not simply moved elsewhere but was handed over for systematic disposal. It was ensured that all collected garbage was processed through appropriate waste management channels to prevent it from re-entering the ecosystem. This systematic approach highlights a transition from temporary "clean-ups" to a more sustainable model of waste logistics. By removing these pollutants, the immediate threat to the coastal fauna-which often mistakes plastic for food or becomes entangled in debris-was significantly mitigated.

Leadership at the Forefront of Change

The importance of the drive was elevated by the presence of Director of Tourism, and SDM, South Andaman. Furthermore, significant contributions were made by Director (RD/PRI & ULBs), and Joint Director of Tourism. The participation of these officials, alongside the Pradhan and various PRI members, served to validate the importance of environmental maintenance in the eyes of the public.

When leadership is seen actively participating in the manual labour of a cleanliness drive, a powerful message is sent regarding the island's priorities. These officials highlighted the intrinsic link between a clean environment and the economic viability of the tourism sector. It was emphasized that the appeal of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a world-class travel hub is directly dependent on the health and cleanliness of its beaches. Consequently, environmental preservation is now being treated as a cornerstone of the islands' development strategy.

Beyond the physical removal of trash, the initiative was designed to plant the seeds of long-term behavioural change. Police trace missing woman from forest at Kalighat

In a swift and coordinated effort, the Police of North & Middle Andaman District traced a missing woman from a dense forest area under the jurisdiction of Police Station Kalighat.

On 12/03/2026, Shri Segwa Toppo, aged about 47 years, a resident of Nabagram Village, reported at Police Station Kalighat that his wife Budhni Munda, aged about 46 years, who has been suffering from mental illness for the last 20 years, had been missing from their residence since the morning of 10th March, 2026. Acting promptly, the police team, with the assistance of the relatives



of the missing woman and local villagers, launched an extensive search operation in the nearby forest areas. After sustained and coordinated efforts covering more than 100 square kilometres of forest area since 12/03/2026, the missing woman was finally traced deep inside the forest on 15/03/2026. She was immediately shifted to PHC Kalighat for medical examination and necessary treatment, as her health condition had deteriorated due to prolonged fasting. After receiving medical aid and recovering her health condition, Budhni Munda was safely handed over to her husband, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.
