milling copra. Accordingly, the Minimum Support Price (MSP) for matured dehusked coconut will be Rs.2030 per quintal for the crop season 2018. Interested farmers can sell their dehusked coconut as per the minimum support price announced by Government of India to the procurement agencies.

India, Sweden agree to strengthen defence, security cooperation

India and Sweden have agreed to strengthen defence and security cooperation.
