Upon expiry of the aforesaid notice period, the Administration, shall initiate strict enforcement action against all vehicles found parked illegally on public roads and road shoulders, under various Sections of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and the Motor Vehicles (Driving) Regulations, 2017.

Such motor vehicles would be towed away by the Enforcement teams. Enforcement action shall include imposition of fines, towing of vehicles at the owner's expense, and wheel-clamping, in addition to any other action permissible under law.
