## Dr. (Prof.) Jagdish Mukhi appointed Lt. Governor of A&N Islands

Senior BJP leader, Dr. (Prof.) Jagdish Mukhi has been appointed as the Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands by the President, Shri Pranab Mukherjee. His appointment will take effect from the date of his assuming charge of office.

Born on 01-12-1942 at Dajal Distt., D.G. Khan (Now in Pakistan), Prof. Jagdish Mukhi is married to Smt. Prem Mukhi and has a daughter and a son. He holds a degree in M.Com and Ph.D.

Prof. Jagdish Mukhi has been active in politics since 25th June, 1975 when emergency was clamped. He was elected to the erstwhile Metropolitan Council Delhi in 1980 and remained Chief Whip of BJP in the Council from 1983 to 1989. He made valuable contribution to the Estimates Committee of the then Delhi Metropolitan Council. He was a Professor in Delhi University and has authored a book titled 'Company law & Secretarial Practice'. He has also made remarkable contribution in preparation of study material for Institute of Company Secretaries of India.

Prof. Jagdish Mukhi was Minister of Finance, Planning and Education in the first assembly of Delhi and Leader of Opposition in the Second Assembly and third Assembly. He was re-elected as MLA in fourth Legislative Assembly in 2008.

**Govt evacuates over 4,500 Indians & 2,500 foreigners from war torn Yemen**

New Delhi, Aug 17  
External Affairs Minister, Smti Sushma Swaraj today said that Government has evacuated more than 4,500 Indians and over 2,500 foreigners from war torn Yemen. In a series of tweets, Smti Swaraj said, government made repeated requests

calling upon Indians to leave Yemen. She said, ministry had to close the Embassy in Sanaa due to situation prevailing there. She said, however, some people chose to stay back and some of those evacuated, returned to Yemen.

**Govt launches several initiatives under Namami Gange projects in Mathura-Vrindavan**

New Delhi, Aug 17  
The government has launched several new initiatives including setting up of a water purification plant under Namami Gange projects in Mathura - Vrindavan today. The projects were launched in presence of Union Water Resources Minister Ms Uma Bharti,

Union Surface Transport and Shipping Minister Shri Nitin Gadkari, Petroleum Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan and Mathura MP Smti Hema Malini. Under the new projects a water recycling plant will be set up at Mathura Refinery where contaminated Yamuna water will be recycled and purified and made available for drinking. An MoU was also signed between Water Resources

Ministry and Petroleum Ministry on this occasion. The 40 crore rupees project will have capacity to purify two crore liter drinking water daily for Mathura and Vrindavan. Speaking on this occasion the Water Resources Minister Ms. Uma Bharti said as part of Namami Gange, the cremation and other ghats will be upgraded to ensure cleanness in Yamuna river.

Free LPG connections to three hundred poor families were also distributed on this occasion. Speaking on this occasion Surface Transport and Shipping Minister Shri Nitin Gadkari said that shipping transport will start between Delhi- Agra waterways. He said water sports is also being planned to promote tourism with business as well in this area.

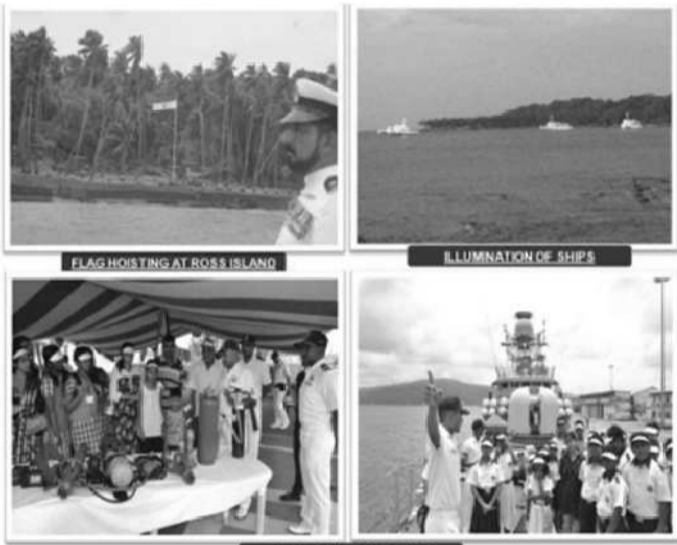
**Individual bankers should take onus for loan sanctions: RBI Governor**



Mumbai, Aug 17  
Reserve Bank Governor Dr Raghuram Rajan on Tuesday said there is a need to shift loan sanctioning process from the present committee-based approach to single banker taking up the responsibility. He also suggested for rewarding the person if the project goes on well. Addressing the annual bankers conference in Mumbai, Dr Rajan said, the incentive structure for bankers should be worked out so that they evaluate, design and monitor projects carefully. He said, technology can

go a long way in helping arrive at a better due diligence. Dr Rajan said, corporate debt markets, either through direct issues or securitised project loan portfolios, should be used to absorb some of the initial project risks. More such arm's length debt should typically refinance bank debt when construction is over. He also expressed optimism over some of the steps taken to strengthen corporate debt markets, including the new bankruptcy code, should make this possible.

**Historic flag hoisting at Ross Island on Independence Day**

On the occasion of 70th Independence Day, the Tricolour was hoisted at Ross Island for the first time since Independence. In this historic event, a majestic 60 feet high flag mast was installed by the Indian Navy at Ross Island. The heavy mast was transported to Ross Island in a unique and precise operation involving underslung carriage of the mast by an Air Force MI-17 V5 helicopter. ### ICC rankings: India displace Australia as No 1 Test team

New Delhi, Aug 17 The Indian cricket team has moved back to No 1 on the ICC table for Test teams on Wednesday, following Sri Lanka's 163-run win over Australia in Colombo. India can hold onto their numero uno status with victory over West Indies in the fourth and final Test starting tomorrow in Port of Spain, which would give them a 3-0 series win and keep them on 112 points. Should India draw the Test, they will slip to second with 110 points and a defeat will push them to fourth with 108 points which means that second-ranked Pakistan would displace them at the top. Pakistan had moved up the ladder following their ten-wicket win over England at The Oval this week, which drew that series 2-2. Pakistan have 111 points, one less than India with 112. They had earlier been at second place after beating England in the UAE late last year. Sri Lanka's 3-0 whitewash of Australia means that Steven Smith's team has fallen from No 1 to third, with 108 points. They lost each of their matches by big margins - 106 runs, 299 runs and 163 runs - for their ninth consecutive Test defeat in

Asia after 4-0 in India in 2013 and 2-0 to Pakistan in the UAE in 2014. South Africa have plummeted the depths of No 7, having been at the top as recently as November. ICC Test Rankings (as of 17 August)

New Delhi, Aug 17 The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) is in no mood to host a day-night Test match in a hurry until the top cricketers give their nod for the pink ball. With a few members of the current Test team like Murali Vijay and Cheteshwar Pujara named in different Duleep Trophy teams, the BCCI is keen on seeing that the others too take part in the tournament and get accustomed to pink-ball cricket in India. "The top players will have to give their opinion on the pink ball before a Test match under lights with it is scheduled," a top BCCI official said. Sources said that BCCI isn't keen to organise a pink-ball Test without the approval of the international cricketers and lose out on home advantage against established teams. Therefore, the Test regulars will have to play a first-class matches at some point to determine the success of pink ball. But with two Twenty20 Internationals against the West Indies slated to be held in USA later this month, the selectors didn't name the likes of Virat Kohli, Ajinkya Rahane and Rohit Sharma in the Duleep Trophy squads. Some of the front-line bowlers like Ishant Sharma, Mohammed Shami and R Ashwin too were excluded. The board would also seek opinions of the three captains of the Duleep Trophy teams - Yuvraj Singh, Gautam Gambhir and Suresh Raina - and wait for a final approval from the Indian Test captain Kohli.

Rio-De-Janeiro, Aug 17 India's Kidambi Srikanth has bowed out of the men's singles badminton at Rio Olympics this evening. He lost his quarter-final match against Lin Dan of China after a tough fight.
