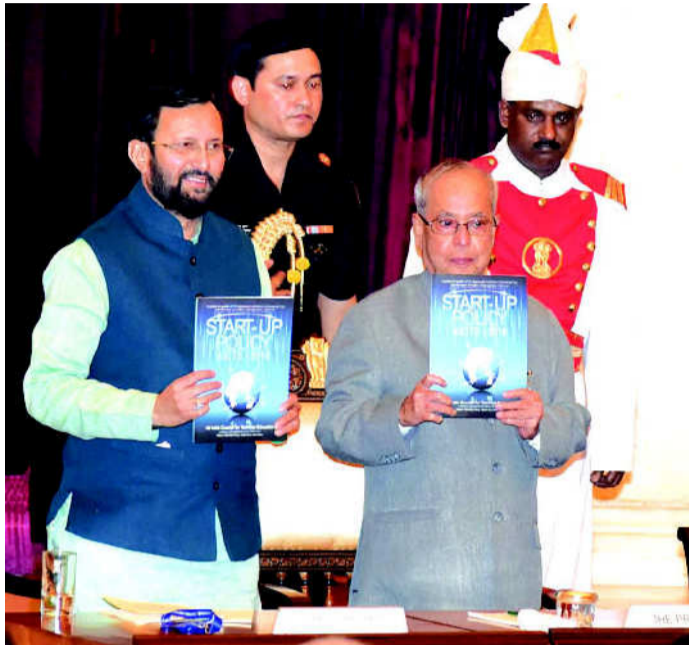

Higher education plays crucial role in national development: President

New Delhi, Nov 17 President Shri Pranab Mukherjee has said higher education sector has a crucial role in the national developmental effort. Addressing at three-day Visitor's Conference 2016 at Rashtrapati Bhavan yesterday, Shri Mukherjee said growth of the industrial sector depends on higher education in important ways. He said the quality of training provided to students employed by the sector determines the level of industrial competence. He said industry provides an outlet for various research and innovations taking place at the university level. Shri Mukherjee said technological developments improve efficiency of factories resulting in products of better quality at lesser cost. The President said research collaboration is an important component in the relationship between industry and academic institutions. The first day of conference concluded with 67 MOUS exchanged between industry and academia.

New Delhi, Nov 17 International Trade Fair at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. A set of service providers has been given access to exhibitors at IITF to offer services for cashless transactions to exhibitors and visitors.

Govt announces new measures to tackle demonetisation problems

New Delhi, Nov 17 Government today announced new measures to contain the problems faced by people following the demonetisation of 500 and 1000 rupees notes. Farmers have been allowed to withdraw 25 thousand rupees a week against crop loan and kisan credit card to ensure sowing in the rabi season. Briefing media in New Delhi today, Economic Affairs Secretary Shri Shaktikanta Das said, traders registered with Agriculture Produce Market Committee (APMC) markets and mandis have also been permitted to draw 50 thousand rupees in cash per week to pay for sundry expenses like wages. He said, the time limit for payment of crop loan insurance premium will be extended by 15 days. Shri Das said, up to rupees 2.5 lakh cash can be drawn from bank account for a marriage during ongoing wedding season. He said, one member of the family, be it father or mother, bride or bridegroom can withdraw the amount. The Secretary said, the existing limit of 4 thousand 5 hundred rupees for exchange of old 500 and 1000 rupee notes will be reduced to 2 thousand rupees from tomorrow. He said, Central government employees up to group C can draw salary advance up to 10 thousand rupees in cash that will be adjusted against their November salaries. He said, the Task Force constituted for recalibrating ATMs held a meeting and a road map has been formed to re-calibrate all the ATMs and it will be done soon. Shri Das said, there is enough cash available with the Government and there is no cash crunch. He said, currency printing presses are operating at over 100 per cent capacity.

Class X board exam for CBSE schools from 2017-18: HRD Minister



New Delhi, Nov 17 Union HRD Minister, Shri Prakash Javadekar has said that the government will reintroduce compulsory class X board examination for CBSE schools from the 2017-18 academic year. In an informal conversation with reporters after a meeting with the Rajasthan Education Minister, he informed about the decision to re-introduce class X board examination. Shri Javdekar said state governments will be given authority to reintroduce class V and VIII board examinations, a proposal for which will be tabled in the Cabinet and then in Parliament. He said, the main focus of HRD Ministry is on improving the quality of school education, specifically of government schools. Shri Javdekar said, Narendra Modi-led government is working to improve academic standard and wants the curiosity among students to grow with education.

2KWp rooftop SPV Power Plant inaugurated at Junglighthat

Port Blair, Nov. 17 The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy has allotted 20MW Rooftop Solar PV Power Plant to be installed in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. This target has to be completed by 2022 under various categories. To start with, in a simple function held at a residential building at Junglighthat, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Power), A&N Administration, Shri Sanjeev Khirwar inaugurated the roof top solar power plant of 2KWp capacity installed on the terrace of the residential building of Smt. Madhuri Shukla, in the presence of the senior officers of Electricity Department.

Kohli sparkles with 151 no, Pujara ton takes India to 317/4

Vishakapatnam, Nov 17
Skipper Virat Kohli batted like a man possessed, slamming an unbeaten 151 in company of another centurion Cheteshwar Pujara to steer India to a commendable 317 for four against England on the first day of the second cricket Test here.
In his 50th Test, Kohli led from the front by striking a classy 14th hundred and also added 226 runs for the third wicket with Pujara (119), who has now reached three-figure mark in his last three matches.
Incidentally, this was Pujara's 10th Test hundred. The duo made the English bowlers toil hard on an unresponsive pitch after Murali Vijay (20) and KL Rahul (0) were dismissed cheaply with the scoreboard

reading 22. Kohli mixed caution with aggression during his undefeated stay at the wicket in which he hit 15 boundaries and two sixes. His was a marathon near six-hour stay at the wicket (five hours and 52 minutes) He also claimed moral victory over his old nemesis Jimmy Anderson (3/44), who was the best English bowler on view. Anderson did try his variations but Kohli remained unruffled for the better part of his innings save once when on 56, his mistimed pull shot off Ben Stokes was dropped by Adil Rasheed at deep fine leg boundary. At the other end, continuing his purple patch after he was dropped from the second Test at St Lucia in West Indies, Pujara hit a strokeful 119 off 204 balls that was laced with 12

boundaries and two sixes. Batting in tandem, Kohli brought up his century with a cover drive after Pujara reached his milestone with a six. This time, after scoring his second ton against England, he just lifted his bat, acknowledged the crowd and went about the task to grind the visitors down. The determination and the coming-of-age of Kohli was quite evident. Ditto when he got to his 150 as he half-raised his bat to acknowledge the cheers. It was a tough day for the English bowling attack and quite arduous for Anderson, who is recovering from a shoulder injury. At stumps, Ravichandran Ashwin was in company of his skipper and India's healthy 3.5 run-rate would also be a cause of concern for the Englishmen.

premise owned by M/s KS Kumaran & Sons situated at Babulane, Port Blair, a stock of 42 cartoons Zen Mazza, 55 brand tobacco products, each cartoon containing 200 packets containing approx. 8400 tins of tobacco valuing to Rs.4,83,000/- in the market, was kept. The said contraband tobacco was seized and has been kept under the possession of the FBO by executing surety bonds.

The Food Business Operator violated by keeping the banned tobacco products in his custody under Food Safety Act' 2006. Necessary approval for adjudication in the matter have been obtained and the FBO is being adjudicated u/s 26(2)(iv) and 27(2) (e) which is punishable u/s 55 and 58 of FSS Act' 2006 in the Additional District Magistrate Court.

The inspection team was led by Shri. A. Khalid, Food Safety Officer, assisted by Shri. Tahseen Ali, Smti. S.Nisha and Shri. Abdul Shahid, Food Safety Officers.
Meanwhile in the Court of Additional District Magistrate one more FBO of M/s Samuel Store, Pathergudda has been adjudicated for storing contraband products and was imposed and realised a fine of Rs.2500/- under relevant section of Food Safety Act'2006.

All the food business operators have been warned not to stock, sell or distribute contraband products under ban throughout the A&N Islands, if found violating the ban, they will be booked under relevant Rules under FSS Act, a communication said.
