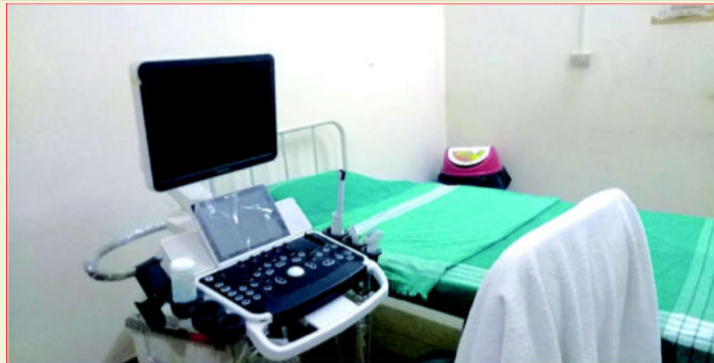
### Ultrasound facility at CHC Rangat, PHC Hut Bay, PHC Swaraj Dweep benefits needy people

Dialysis Machines to be installed at BJR Hospital Car Nicobar, CHC Diglipur, CHC Rangat, CHC Bambooflat & PHC Swaraj Dweep

Port Blair, Feb. 17

With the commitment to provide better health care services including better diagnostic facilities to the residents of these Islands, the A&N Administration has decided to install Ultrasound Machines and Dialysis Units at all CHCs and PHCs of all major Islands. Recently, the Administration has procured 3 more Ultrasound Machines and commissioned them at CHC Rangat, PHC Hut Bay and PHC Swaraj Dweep for the benefit of local people of these areas, especially the expecting mothers.

These facilities are providing great relief to the residents of these areas, especially the people of Hut Bay and Swaraj Dweep, who had to travel long distances by Ship/Boat to avail such facilities at Port Blair. With the installation of these diagnosis equipments, the Administration has fulfilled its commitment to provide ultrasound facilities to all Blocks/Major Islands of the UT. At present, the ultrasound facilities are available at G.B Pant Hospital, Port Blair, PHC Garacharma (to be upgraded to District

Hospital), CHC Bambooflat, PHC Hut Bay, PHC Swaraj Dweep, Dr. R.P. Hospital Mayabunder, CHC Rangat, CHC Diglipur, BJR Hospital Car Nicobar, CHC Nancowry and PHC Campbell Bay. It is to mention that, presently only two Dialysis Units are functional in these Islands, one at GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair and the other at Dr. R.P. Hospital Mayabunder.

Keeping in view of the increased number of patients requiring regular dialysis session and the difficulties faced by such patients to reach the existing Dialysis Unit, the Administration has decided to

## Rate of compensation for coconut palm damage enhanced

Port Blair, Feb. 17

The Lt Governor, A & N Islands has enhanced the rate of compensation for coconut palm damaged due to acquisition of land for development activities, Forest Department etc. or otherwise which shall be as under:

The order will be applicable in the entire Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands with immediate effect. As per the order, the revised rate of compensation should be for the bearing palms.

The payment of the compensation is subject to the recommendation of the Compensation Assessment Committee. The percentage of damage of palm should be assessed and the amount of compensation should be worked out accordingly. Compensation for non-bearing palm be on proportioned basis on the actual age of the palm i.e. the rate of compensation fixed to be multiplied by the actual age of the plant/ crop and divided by the age of the initial bearing of should be for the bearing palms.

## Ministry of Earth Sciences rolls out Draft Blue Economy Policy Invites suggestions & inputs from various stakeholders including industry, NGOs, academia & citizens by Feb. 27

New Delhi, Feb. 17 (PIB) The Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) has rolled out the Draft Blue Economy policy for India in the public domain inviting suggestions and inputs from various stakeholders including industry, NGOs, academia, and citizens. The draft blue economy policy document outlines the vision and strategy that can be adopted by the Government of India to utilize the plethora of oceanic resources available in the country. The policy document has been disseminated for public consultation on several outreach platforms including websites and social media handles of MoES and its institutes. Stakeholders have been invited to submit inputs and ideas by February 27, 2021. The policy document aims to enhance contribution of the blue economy to India's GDP, improve lives of coastal communities, preserve marine biodiversity, and maintain the national security of marine areas and resources.

India's blue economy is understood as a subset of the national economy comprising an entire ocean resources system and human-made economic infrastructure in marine, maritime, and onshore coastal zones within the country's legal jurisdiction. It aids the production of goods and services that have clear linkages with economic growth, environmental sustainability, and national security. The blue economy is a vast socio-economic opportunity for coastal nations like India to utilize ocean resources for societal benefit responsibly.

With a coastline of nearly 7.5 thousand kilometers, India has a unique maritime position. Nine of its 29 states are coastal, and the nation's geography includes 1,382 Islands. There are nearly 199 ports, including 12 major ports that handle approximately 1,400 million tons of cargo each year. Moreover, India's Exclusive Economic Zone of over 2 million square kilometers has a bounty of living and non-living resources with significant recoverable resources such as crude oil and natural gas. Also, the coastal economy sustains over 4 million fisherfolk and coastal communities. With these vast maritime interests, the blue economy occupies a vital potential position in India's economic growth. It could well be the next multiplier of GDP and well-being, provided sustainability and socio-economic welfare are kept center-stage. Therefore, India's draft blue economy policy is envisaged as a crucial framework towards unlocking country's potential for economic growth and welfare.

The MoES prepared the draft blue economy policy framework in line with the Government of India's Vision of New India by 2030. It highlighted blue economy as one of the ten core dimensions for national growth. The draft policy framework emphasizes policies across several key sectors to achieve holistic growth of India's economy. The document recognizes the following seven thematic areas.

- National accounting framework for the blue economy and ocean governance.
- Coastal marine spatial planning and tourism.
- Marine fisheries, aquaculture, and fish processing.
- Manufacturing, emerging industries, trade, technology, services, and skill development.
- Logistics, infrastructure and shipping, including trans-shippments.
- Coastal and deep-sea mining and offshore energy.
- Security, strategic dimensions, and international engagement.

(Contd. from page 1) any accident or other untoward incident. Section 49 of the said Act makes it mandatory for the owners of the motor vehicles to inform the change of residence or place of business to the Registering Authority having jurisdiction over the new place. In case of failure to do so, the owners of such motor vehicles are liable to be penalized under MV Act 2019. As per Rule 39 of ANIMVR, 2006 if any motor vehicle which is not registered in the UT has been kept for a period exceeding 14 days, the owner of the vehicle shall inform the same to Registering Authority, A & N Islands with details like his name, address, registration mark, description of vehicle and in case of transport vehicle the date on which the permit has been issued. This has been brought to the notice of all concerned on earlier occasion by publishing it in the local newspapers but it is observed that such vehicles continue to ply on the road violating the legal provisions.

All the vehicle owners of mainland registration vehicle are therefore once again advised to intimate the Transport Department of their vehicle details alongwith complete information of the owner with phone number. If any person/vehicle owners whose vehicles registered in others States are found plying on the roads in A&N Islands without intimation and permission from this Department, strict action will be taken against them. All the owners of the motor vehicles registered in other States but brought to the UT of A&N Islands have been directed to intimate the details of such change in address to the Office of Transport Department within 14 days as prescribed to avoid legal action as per law. Such owners are also advised to keep documents related to transportation of their vehicles to this UT for verification.

Transport and Police Department will be conducting stringent enforcement drives to regulate such practices and defaulters/ violators will be booked under relevant MV Act/Rule for penal action, a press release from Directorate of Transport said.

No. 32/2021/F. No. 34-982/2020-Rev.- This notification is issued in supersession of Administration's Notification Number 34-982/2020-Rev. dated 30.12.2020.

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And, whereas, the Department of Revenue, Andaman & Nicobar Administration (hereinafter referred to as Department) is administering and implementing the "World War II Veterans Pension Scheme" (hereinafter referred to as Scheme) to provide financial assistance to the World War II Veterans/Widows of the Veterans settled in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

And, whereas, under the Scheme, monthly financial assistance (hereinafter referred to as the benefit) is given to World War-II Veterans/Widows of the War Veterans (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries) as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And, whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Lt. Governor of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby notifies the following, namely:-

1. (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar Number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(2) Any individual desirous of availing the benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar Number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per the Section 3 of the said Act, and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar Enrolment Centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website [www.uidai.gov.in](http://www.uidai.gov.in)) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3) As per Regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar Enrolment Centre located in the respective Block or Tehsil, the Department shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents, namely:-

- if he has enrolled, Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip; and
- any one of the following documents, namely-
  - Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or
  - Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
  - Passport; or
  - Ration Card; or
  - Islander Identity Card; or
  - Voter Identity Card; or
  - MGNREGA Card; or
  - Kisan Photo Passbook; or
  - Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or
  - Certificate of Identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or
  - any other document as specified by the Department.

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an Officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the requirement of Aadhaar under the Scheme.

4. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no bonafide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the Department shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum of Direct Benefit Transfer Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India No. D-26011/04/2017-DBT dated 19th December, 2017 (available on <http://dbt Bharat.gov.in/>).
5. This Notification shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

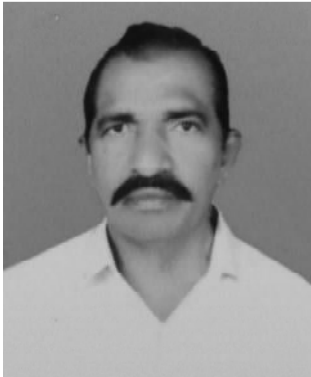

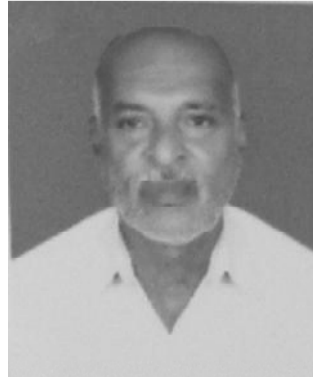

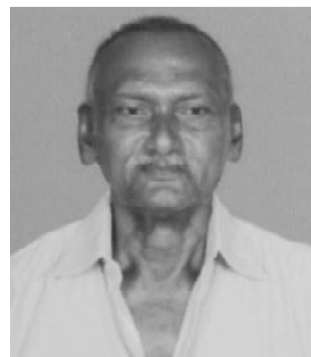
