About 13,000 sportspersons participated in the 'Thomas Cook Andaman Marathon-2018', the mega event of the Islands, which was conducted here today. The Lt. The Chief Secretary, Shri Anindo Majumdar and the President, Andaman Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI), Shri Girish Arora were among others who graced the occasion. Later, giving away cash prizes and trophies to the winners of the Marathon at the Netaji Stadium here this morning, the Lt. Governor congratulated them for the achievement. The huge number of the participants speaks about the magnitude of the event, which is

now an annual mega event of the Islands, he said and complimented the organizers for the successful conduct of the event. Praising Shri Rahul Bose, the Brand Ambassador of the event, the Lt. Governor recalled how he came across the actor and philanthropist while the latter was planning his rehabilitation trip to the Islands after the 2004 tsunami. He said that it was a tough time with no transportation available, but Rahul's strong will and philanthropist nature made him land here and visit all the affected Islands, braving all odds to see the tsunami impact and provide relief materials to the affected people. The Lt Governor expressed hope that Shri Bose will take part in the various projects and schemes that are coming up in the Islands. Shri Rahul Bose, while speaking on the occasion informed how he landed up in the

Islands for the first time, on 30th December 2004, just four days after the tsunami, how he visited the affected areas in the Islands and selected 6 students for further studies in the mainland under his care. He proudly announced that the first Graduate in fashion designing from the Islands, of the six students sponsored by him, is a tribal girl. He said, during his 42 trips to the Islands after the tsunami, he has witnessed a great transformation here. He praised the Islanders who, despite hailing from diverse cultural and linguistic backgrounds, live here in perfect harmony.

Isles cyclist Esow clinches 2 gold for India in Junior Asian Track Cycling Championship

The ecstasy on the faces of the prize winners was visible when they received trophies and cash award by none other than the Lt. Governor A&N Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) during the prize distribution ceremony of the "Thomas Cook Andaman Marathon-2018" held at the Netaji Stadium here this morning. The winners waved their trophies to the audience in jubilation, cherishing every moment of the Marathon, amidst loud applause from the sports lovers present in the Stadium.

In the half Marathon (21Km), Juned of 12 Jat Regiment and Ms Reena Kumari of SAI bagged the first position in men and women categories.

Surender Nath Sai of Delanipur and Sukhmaniya Devi of Jirkatang No-2 stood first in the men and women senior citizen above 50yrs category respectively. Ravi Shankar of 12 Jat Regiment and Ganga Devi of Austinabad bagged the first prize in the 10K open men and women category. Abdul Aziz of Mannarghat and Metelin Minj of SAI remained winners by securing first position in the boys and girls

10K respectively (15 to 18 yrs) category. Juned received trophy and cash prize of Rs 60,000/- clocking (1:17:18) and Ravi Shankar who got trophy and cash prize of Rs 40,000/- clocked (35:10). They were elated for securing the top slot in their respective categories. Speaking to our Reporter, both the sprinters from 12 Jat Regiment said that they have participated in a marathon race for the first time. "We used to practiced daily at our defence area and our hard work bore fruit", they said.

Surender Nath Sai of Delanipur who received trophy and cash prize of Rs 40,000/- clocking (45:48), expressed his happiness for coming out with flying colors in the senior citizen category. Shri Sai, 54, being the centre of attraction and inspiration for all at the Netaji Stadium, said he used to practices for this big event running in the Netaji Stadium. Running is the best way to maintain physical fitness, he added.

Smt. Sukhmaniya Devi who received trophy and cash prize of Rs 40,000/- in the 40 & above category for women clocking (57:55:82), expressed her happiness for achieving this feat in the Marathon. Sukhmaniya, 42, mother of three, hailing from Jirkatang No-2 said that she practiced for 15 days for the marathon and she

was lucky to get the first prize. Ms. Ganga Devi of Austinabad who received trophy and cash prize of Rs 40,000/- clocking (45:45) said she participated in the marathon for the 6th time. She secured second position for 4 times and stood first in two occasions including the current one, said an elated Ganga a graduate from ANCOL.

Ms Reena Kumari received trophy and cash prize of Rs. 60,000/- clocking (1:50:56) while Metelen Minj received trophy and cash prize of Rs. 30,000/- . Both the SAI sportspersons were elated to bag the first prize in their respective categories. For Ms Reena this was her second marathon prize as she has won the first prize in the 2017- marathon too. I participated for the first time in a marathon and I got first prize, said a beaming Metelin Minj adding that being sportsperson in SAI always have an advantage.

Shri Abdul Aziz who received trophy and cash prize of Rs 30,000/- clocking (37:33) was the happiest among the prize winners to come out with flying colors. He said, he practiced for this marathon at Netaji Stadium under the supervision of a coach and the result was unexpected.

Master Esow, a young budding Car Nicobar Boy, son of Mr. and Mrs Alben of A & N Police and the Junior Ranking Cyclist of these Islands has once again proved himself as he stood at the podium today with 2 Gold Medals for India, on the Second day of 25th Junior Asian Track Cycling Championship 2018, at Nilai Velodrome, Malaysia.

Our Ace Cyclist Master Esow of A & N Islands has created history by winning the 1st ever Gold Medal in Asian Continental Junior Track Cycling Championship, in the event, Team Sprint along with his co-riders Master Mayur Pawar of Maharashtra and K. James Singh of Manipur beating the Champion Country team Japan.

Master Esow grabbed another Gold Medal for the country today in the Keirin event. India's topping the list No 1 Ranking Cyclist in the Junior Boys, Master Esow has clinched 2 Gold Medals in the ongoing Asian Track Cycling Championship so far. Esow has got one more event to finish ie. 200 Mtr Sprint, to be held tomorrow. Islands Star Cyclist Ms. Deborah is also participating and representing India in the same event.

(Civil) No. 17135/2008 and Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, New Delhi Notification No. GSR 424(E) dated 1st May, 2017, read with Clause (f) of sub-section (1) Section 110 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) and in supersession of A & N Administration's Notification No. 36/2017/F.No.3-37/MVD/Speed Governor/ 2016 dated 10-03-2017, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby notifies that the following classes of Transport Vehicles specified conforming to the standard AIS: 018/2001 as amended from time to time, namely:-

| 5. | Goods vehicles exceeding 3500 kilograms gross vehicle weight (GVW) except dumpers, tankers and those carrying hazardous goods. | 60 kms. |
| 6. | Dumpers, tankers and those carrying hazardous goods. | 45 kms. |

Conditions:

The Speed Governor shall be fitted in respect of:-

- (a) Vehicles manufactured on or after the 1st October, 2015 shall be equipped or fitted by the vehicle manufacturer either in the manufacturing stage or at the dealership stage with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function), having maximum pre-set speed as specified in the above Table.
 - (b) The above categories of transport vehicles registered prior to 1st October, 2015, which are not already fitted with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function) shall be equipped or fitted by the operators of those vehicles with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function), having maximum pre-set speed as specified in the above Table within 120 days from the date of publication of the Notification in the Official Gazette/The Daily Telegrams.
- The maximum speed of such vehicles is fixed as per the above Table, under sub-section (2) of Section 112 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act 59 of 1988);
- (2) The permit granting Authority/ Registering Authority concerned in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands shall ensure that "speed governor" is fitted in each of the aforesaid classes of vehicles and the "official seal" of the permit granting Authority/ Registering Authority concerned shall be put up on such "speed governor" in such a manner that the seal cannot be removed or tampered, without the seal being broken;
 - (3) The speed governor so fitted shall be functionally capable of limiting the speed of the vehicles to the maximum speed as specified by the Government, from time to time;
 - (4) The manufacturer of the speed governor shall obtain a type approval certificate in respect of the speed governor to be fitted from any of the testing agencies referred to in rule 126 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989;
 - (5) The Registering Authority concerned or any officer authorized by the Registering Authority shall seal the points with the official seal after satisfying himself that the speed governor is capable of limiting the speed of the vehicle as specified by the Government;
 - (6) No notified vehicle required to be fitted with a speed governor shall be used in any public place unless it bears the official seal;
 - (7) No person shall open, tamper or otherwise interfere with the official seal on a speed governor;
 - (8) In case, the official seal is broken, damaged or opened due to any reason whatsoever, the vehicle shall not be used in any public place unless a new official seal is affixed by the authority concerned;
 - (9) The owner of the vehicle shall provide an inspection window on the floor of the vehicle just above the gear box or otherwise, where sensor of the speed governor is connected to the gear box for applying the official seal or for inspection of the same;
 - (10) Any officer of the Transport Department not below the rank of Motor Vehicle Inspector is authorized to stop a vehicle for such reasonable time, as is necessary to satisfy himself that the official seal is intact and the speed governor is capable of limiting the speed as specified for such vehicle notwithstanding that the official seal on the speed governor appears to be intact;
 - (11) It shall be the duty of the owner of the vehicle to train or educate the driver of the vehicle about the necessity and importance of the speed governor and the official seal therein;
 - (12) Every vehicle required to be fitted with a speed governor shall display the words "SPEED GOVERNOR INSTALLED" legibly written in English at the bottom of both front and rear wind screen. The letters shall be written in white colour and shall be of 15 cms. height with appropriate thickness;
 - (13) If, at any time, it is observed by the driver or the owner that the speed governor is not functioning properly or by any means it is observed that the speed of the vehicle does not limit to the prescribed speed, the driver or the owner shall ply the vehicles, only after necessary rectification. In such an event, it shall be necessary to obtain fresh official seal of the concerned Registering Authority or any officer authorized by the Registering Authority on the speed governor;
 - (14) The penalty provided under Section 177 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act 59 of 1988) shall apply for violation of this Notification.
