New Delhi, Mar 18
Chief Justice of India J S Khehar said, justice for all is still a dream for many in the country. Addressing the 15th All India Meet of State Legal Services Authorities in New Delhi today, Justice Khehar said expeditious disposal of cases is the need of the hour and voiceless and vulnerable must not be denied legal aid and services. The Chief Justice said, procedures should be less in the cases to ensure their earliest disposal. Justice Khehar said, no accused should remain unrepresented and legal aid should be given to everyone as and when required. He said, the judiciary should make sure that cases will not be closed with an acquittal of an accused. Speaking on the occasion,

Rs 534 Crores released to States/UTs for upgradation of 87,293 Anganwadis: WCD Minister

New Delhi, Mar 18
During the strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme, 2 lakh Anganwadi Centres were approved for upgradation. Out of these, 87,293 AWCs have been sanctioned for upgradation and the fund amounting to Rs. 53394.62 lakh has been released to the States/UTs. This information was given by

Further, construction of 4 lakh Anganwadi Centre (AWC) buildings have been approved under Mahatma Gandhi Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in convergence with Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme. For the

purpose, joint guidelines have been issued on 17.02.2016 by Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and Ministry of Women and Child Development. The guidelines have the provision for providing drinking water and sanitation facilities in these AWCs from the funds available with Panchayati

The government has said that it is giving utmost priority to the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) and it is reviewed at many levels for close monitoring and speedy resolution of the issues.

Group Accident Insurance for fishermen; Fisheries Department clarifies

The Director of Fisheries in a press release received here has clarified on a news item published in a section of news paper about Group Accident Insurance Scheme.

According to the release, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Govt. of India implements a Central Sector Component "Group Accident Insurance for

Active Fishermen". The National Federation of Fishermen's Cooperatives Ltd. (FISHCOPFED), New Delhi is the implementing agency of the component through Oriental Insurance Co. and the Department of Fisheries of the Administration functions as Facilitator. Under this component, the fishermen / nominees of the fishermen are eligible for Rs 2,00,000/- against death or permanent total disability,

Rs 1,00,000/- for partial permanent disability and a cover of Rs 10,000/- towards hospitalization expenses occurred due to accidents.

The release further said that as on date, about 06 insurance claims are pending with the FISHCOPFED, New Delhi/ Insurance Company. The Department of Fisheries is pursuing the pending cases personally with the FISHCOPFED and Oriental

At present, Anganwadi Workers are paid Rs. 3000 per month, Anganwadi Helpers are paid Rs. 1500 per month and Mini Anganwadi Workers are paid Rs.2250 per month. Besides this, some States/UTs are also giving additional honorarium to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers out of their own resources for any additional work assigned to them from time to time.

Indian Wells Masters: I played unbelievably well against Rafael Nadal, says Roger Federer

California, Mar 18
Elated with his win over fourteen-time grand slam champion Rafael Nadal in the Round 4 of the ongoing Indian Wells Masters, Swiss maestro Roger Federer has said that he played "unbelievably" against the Spaniard and "couldn't be more happy" with his performance. Federer defeated his long time rival 6-2 6-3 in a contest that lasted for 68 minutes to advance to the last eight of the tournament. "I played unbelievably against Rafa and I couldn't be more happy," Federer was quoted as saying by the tournament website.



"The six months off last year was really difficult. I played one tournament last year where I felt normal and that was the Australian Open. At all the other tournaments, I was sick, hurt, injured or not well," he added. This was Federer's third successive victory over the Spaniard. The 35-year-old is looking to win his second title of the season, having made his comeback from a six-month injury lay-off in stunning fashion, by capturing his 18th Grand Slam championship at the Australian Open with a five-set victory over Nadal.
