Two-day WTO ministerial meeting to begin today

New Delhi, Mar 18
 Representatives from 50 countries will gather in New Delhi tomorrow for a two-day informal World Trade Organisation (WTO) ministerial meeting. The meeting will provide an opportunity to engage in free and frank discussions with the hope that it will lead to political guidance on some major issues. In the absence of Ministerial guidance at the Eleventh Ministerial Conference (MC 11) that took place in Buenos Aires, it is hoped that the meeting in New Delhi will provide an opportunity for ministers to explore in greater detail options on different issues for re-energizing the WTO.

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Take precaution while sharing Aadhaar info on internet: UIDAI

New Delhi, Mar 18
 The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has asked people to take due precautions while sharing their personal information such as Aadhaar number on the internet for availing any service. In a statement, UIDAI asserted the robustness of the Aadhaar identity system. It said, publication or posting of Aadhaar cards on the internet

people have absolutely no bearing on UIDAI and the least on Aadhaar security. The nodal body, which issues the 12 digits biometric identifier, emphasized that just like any other identity document, Aadhaar too is not a confidential document. UIDAI argued that mere knowledge about someone's Aadhaar card is not sufficient to impersonate that person as biometric authentication is needed to establish one's

identity. It also said, publication of someone's personal information does not threaten or impact the security of Aadhaar and its database which remains safe and secure. The statement by UIDAI came in the backdrop of reports claiming that information about Aadhaar may be available from third-party websites and that a Google search may lead to Aadhaar details of several people.

The State Transport Authority has been receiving complaints from general public regarding plying of autorickshaws without putting fare meters on and charging of exorbitant fares by the drivers. The autorickshaw permit holders have been once again warned to refrain from such practices as repeated violations will warrant actions for cancellation of Permits. In a press release received here, the Director, STA has clarified that the MV Act 1988 mandates that in case

of Autorickshaw/Taxi, a taximeter shall be fitted and maintained in proper working order. Despite several warnings through media, the STA has been receiving complaints against the Autorickshaw/taxi. The STA has asked the Autorickshaw Permit holders/Drivers to get their fare meter calibrated and stamped as per the notified Fares from the Legal

Metrology, Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs. The fare meters are being stamped free of cost, in case they are not functioning or defective within one year of stamping. The Autorickshaw owners shall display the fare chart issued by STA in their Autorickshaw. Fare should be charged strictly as per the Fare meter. Exorbitant or overcharging of auto fares shall be viewed strictly.

Meanwhile, enforcement drives will be conducted and actions will be initiated against those Autorickshaw owners found not exhibiting the fare chart/ with defective/ faulty/ non functional /& non calibrated & stamped fare meters. General public have also been advised to send their complaints regarding refusal to ply Autorickshaw, refusal to put on the fare meter

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Women empowerment through DAY-NRLM

ANIRLM to release Community Investment Fund to SHGs submitting MCP

Port Blair, Mar 18
 Towards empowerment of women, since last one year the Directorate of RD, PRIs&ULBs, the Nodal Department of A&N Islands Rural Livelihood Mission (ANIRLM) has been forming the Self-Help Groups (SHGs) under the scheme Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) by bringing together poor rural women in all the Blocks of this UT. To promote livelihood activities of the SHGs members, the ANIRLM is to release Community Investment Fund (CIF) to the SHGs submitting the Micro Credit Plan (MCP).



MCP for release of CIF to the NRLM-SHGs at CD Block Prothrapur, Ferrargunj, Rangat and Diglipur recently. A team of eight state level community trainers under the supervision of Shri. T. Ravinder Rao and Shri. Venkateshwar Rao, National Mission Managers, NRLM, NIRD&PR conducted field survey to assess the social-economic status of the NRLM-SHG members of these areas and guided the SHG members as well as dedicated NRLM staff consisting of Cluster Coordinators and

Community Resource Persons to prepare MCP to get CIF. During the training, 50 SHGs prepared MCP under the guidance of the resource persons; and the ANIRLM shall be releasing Community Investment Fund (CIF) to these SHGs soon. The CIF released to the SHGs will help the SHG members to start their livelihood activity and turn as financial support to her family.

CIARI organizes field day for farmers

Port Blair, Mar. 18
 A field day was conducted by CIARI for farmers at the experimental farm, Garacharma Complex to create awareness among the farmers for promotion of china aster cultivation in A&N Islands. About 40 farmers from different places of South Andaman viz. Ferrargunj, Guptapara, Garacharma and Burmanallah attended the programme. Dr. A. Kundu, Director, ICAR-CIARI briefed the farmers about the scope and importance of floriculture in the Island and also insisted that flower cultivation is an important sector for income generation and livelihood security.



Dr. V. Baskaran and Dr. K. Abirami, Scientists from the Division of Horticulture and Forestry and organizing secretaries of the event explained to the farmers about the different cultivation practices to be followed for cultivation of China aster from nursery raising till harvest. The importance of china aster as loose flower and its varietal wealth was

briefed by Dr. B. A. Jerard, Head, Division of Horticulture & Forestry. Planting material of china aster was also distributed to the participants, a communication said.

Closed season for operation of sport fishing vessels

Port Blair, March 18
 The period commencing from 1st day of May and expiring on 30th day of September, every year (inclusive of day of commencement and day of expiry) shall be closed season for operation of

sport fishing vessels for conducting sport fishing activity in A&N waters. No permit shall be issued for sport fishing during the aforesaid period, a communication from Directorate of Fisheries said.

Indian Coast Guard to organizes maritime search & rescue operations on Mar 21

Port Blair, March 18
 Indian Coast Guard has been entrusted with the responsibility for co-ordinating the search and rescue operations over the Indian Search & Rescue Region. There are total three Maritime Rescue Co-ordinating Centres (MRCC) in India and are manned 24x 7 by Indian Coast Guard to tackle any eventualities over sea. Three MRCCs provides search and rescue services over the vast area of 40 lakh

sq.km of Indian Ocean amongst which MRCC, Port Blair covers 9 lakh sq.km through which world's busiest International shipping lanes are crossing. It has successfully co-ordinated rescue of 3088 lives since inception and has played important role during mass rescue operations such as the tsunami and cyclones. During past one year alone, Indian Coast Guard has rescued 59 lives in Andaman Sea.

Considering importance of search and rescue operations and approaching monsoon season, a SAR exercise has been planned off Port Blair on Mar 21, preceded by table top exercise on Mar 19. This exercise will be an effort towards training and will help in synchronizing various Govt agencies on SAR and mass rescue operations, in compliance with A&N Regional Search and Rescue plan and National Maritime SAR manual, a CG communiqué said.

A+ category was proposed by Virat Kohli and MS Dhoni: Vinod Rai

New Delhi, Mar 18
Contrary to popular belief that Mahendra Singh Dhoni was relegated from the elite category of central contracts, it was the former skipper himself who wanted an A+ grade for top performers, says Supreme Court appointed Committee of Administrators (CoA) chief Vinod Rai. Twenty-six cricketers have been handed central contracts with skipper Virat Kohli, Rohit Sharma, Shikhar Dhawan, Bhuvneshwar Kumar and Jasprit Bumrah being included in the Rs 7 crore A+ category. Dhoni is in the A category with Rs 5 crore annual retainership. The head of the CoA said both Dhoni and Kohli wanted A+ to be a functional category to indicate who are the Indian team's top performers. "This should be a functional category where players move in and out. Also it will show that the best in



the business are rewarded as per performance." What the former CAG found heartening was the camaraderie between Kohli and Dhoni. "Their camaraderie is exceptional with so much mutual respect. Virat respects Dhoni's cricketing acumen and Dhoni respects what Virat is achieving as a player," said Rai. In fact, Virat has told the CoA why he thinks Dhoni is irreplaceable in the limited overs set up as of now. "Virat feels that there are no faster pair of gloves than MS Dhoni today. Also Dhoni's

cricketing mind honed over so many years is an asset for Virat. As far as how many years of cricket is left in him, time and his performance will tell," he said. Rai said that the best part about central contracts was that it ensured a decent earning for domestic players. "These increases have been proposed in consultation with the players. Domestic players, who were getting Rs 10-12 lakh per annum, will now get Rs 20-22 lakh per annum in addition to the earnings from Gross Revenue System (profits from TV broadcast).

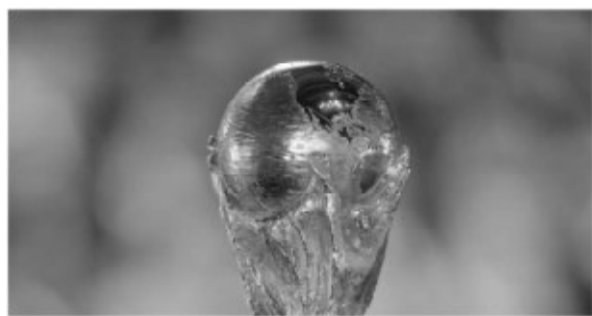

Morocco plans to spend \$15.8 billion if it gets 2026 FIFA World Cup

Rabat, Mar 18
Morocco has proposed using 14 stadiums and budgeting to spend 15.8 billion dollars on infrastructure if it wins the right to host the World Cup soccer finals in 2026, the country's bid committee announced at a news conference on Saturday. But Morocco will not build any new stadiums for the tournament, preferring to renovate and modify existing venues and add temporary capacity to others, said candidature chairman Moulay Hafid Elalamy, who is also a government minister. The North African country is up against a joint bid from Canada, Mexico and the United States when world soccer governing body FIFA's member countries decide in Moscow on June 13 who will host the tournament eight years from now. Saturday's news conference revealed details of Morocco's bid book, which was presented



to FIFA on Friday, with the central theme being making their football infrastructure sustainable after the tournament and keeping down construction costs. At least five stadiums, termed legacy modular stadiums and with largely temporary capacity,

will be downscaled after the finals to meet the specific needs of their local communities. Casablanca and Marrakech will both have two stadiums with other venues being the capital Rabat, Agadir, El Jadida, Fez, Meknes, Nador, Ouarzazate Oujda, Tangier and Tetouan.

Kevin Pietersen retires from all forms of cricket



UAE, Mar 18
Former England batsman Kevin Pietersen has at last walked off into the sunset. The match between Quetta Gladiators and Islamabad United in the Pakistan Super League (PSL) on Thursday turned out to be his last game. Pietersen didn't do much for the Gladiators this season but they were still good enough to make

the play-offs. But with his team's next game scheduled to take place in Pakistan, the 37-year-old called it quits since he had already announced he wouldn't extend his commitment beyond the United Arab Emirates (UAE). He took to Twitter the next day after the match and announced his decision in a subtle way, leaving everyone to speculate.

West Indies agree to play day-night Test in India

New Delhi, Mar 18
The Cricket West Indies (CWI) has agreed to play a day/night Test in India in the coming season. Replying to an email from the BCCI acting secretary Amitabh Choudhary, the CWI chief Dave Cameron has said: "As per our discussions we would gladly agree to a day/night Test Match being the first one. Additionally, we would require the warm up game to be under lights as well. Thanks

much and look forward to finalizing the schedule." During its meeting on Saturday, the cricket board's Tour, Programme and Fixtures Committee picked Rajkot and Hyderabad as the venues for the two Test matches against West Indies, in October. Mumbai, Guwahati, Kochi, Indore and Pune will host the five ODIs against the Caribbeans, while Kolkata, Chennai and Kanpur have been selected for three

T20 internationals. The historic one-off Test against Afghanistan in June will precede the West Indies series and India will leave for Australia after completing their assignments against the Caribbeans. Then, the Aussies will come for five ODIs and two T20 internationals in February-March next year. Mohali, Hyderabad, Nagpur, Delhi and Ranchi will play host to the ODIs against Australia followed by the T20s at Bangalore and Vizag.
