Strengthening passenger facilitation in Indian Aviation; Ministry issues various directions through DGCA

Minimum 60% of seats on any flight to be allocated free of charge; Passengers travelling on the same PNR to be seated together

New Delhi, Mar. 18 (PIB)

India has emerged as the third-largest domestic aviation market globally, with air travel becoming increasingly accessible and inclusive under the UDAN scheme. Indian airports today handle over five lakh passengers daily, reflecting the rapid growth of the sector.

Passenger facilitation remains the highest priority of the Ministry of Civil Aviation. In line with this commitment, the Ministry has undertaken several passenger-centric initiatives to enhance ease of travel, including UDAN Yatri Cafés for affordable food, Flybrary for free access to books and provision of free Wi-Fi at airports.

To further strengthen passenger convenience, transparency and uniformity of practices across airlines, the Ministry has issued the following directions through



the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA):

- > Minimum 60% of seats on any flight to be allocated free of

charge to ensure fair access

- > Passengers travelling on the same PNR to be seated together, preferably in adjacent

seats

- > Carriage of sports equipment and musical instruments to be facilitated in a transparent and

passenger-friendly manner, subject to applicable safety and operational regulations. Airlines shall also bring out clear, transparent policies for carriage of pets.

- > Strict adherence to passenger rights framework, particularly in cases of delays, cancellations and denied boarding

- > Prominent display of passenger rights across airline websites, mobile applications, booking platforms, and airport counters

- > Clear communication of passenger entitlements in regional languages to ensure wider accessibility and awareness

The Ministry of Civil Aviation remains committed to enhancing passenger experience, ensuring transparency, reducing grievances and upholding the highest standards of safety across the aviation ecosystem.

IIHMR Bangalore launches LASI Wave-2 Survey in A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 18

The Indian Institute of Health Management Research (IIHMR), Bangalore has completed an intensive training programme for field investigators in the A&N Islands as part of the second wave of the Longitudinal Aging Study in India (LASI). IIHMR is serving as the field agency for Andaman & Nicobar Islands under the direction of the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), an autonomous organisation of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

LASI Wave-2 is India's flagship study on ageing, designed to generate nationally representative data on adults aged 45 years and above and their spouses. The survey instrument comprises three schedules-household, individual and community health surveys. Household questionnaires collect detailed information on housing conditions, access to water, sanitation and electricity, consumption patterns, assets and debts, income and insurance. Individual interviews cover

demographics, work history, retirement, self reported health and mental health, cognitive functioning, family and social networks, and health care utilization. The survey also incorporates health assessments, including measurements of blood pressure, pulse, handgrip strength, balance, vision, height, weight, waist/hip circumference and spirometry, along with dried blood spot collection for laboratory analysis.

Sixteen field investigators were trained intensively.

They received hands on practice in obtaining informed consent, administering Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI) instruments, and conducting health assessments. Mock interviews and supervised field visits to both urban and rural communities ensure that each investigator can build rapport with participants and accurately collect sensitive information. 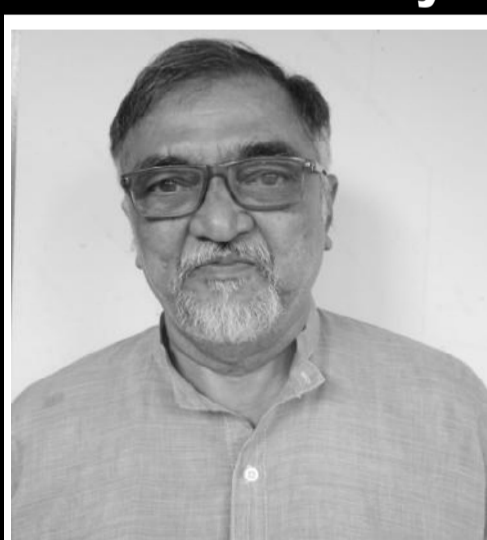

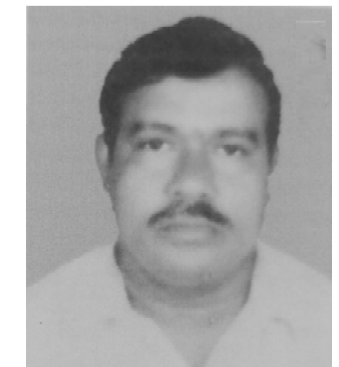
