Yoga 365 aims to make Yoga an integral part of daily life

New Delhi, June 18 (PIB) Kolkata is set to host the national celebrations of the 12th International Day of Yoga (IDY) on June 21 at the iconic Red Road, where Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will lead the nation in the Common Yoga Protocol. The national celebration at Red Road will begin at 5 AM on June 21, with thousands of participants joining physically and millions expected to participate virtually from across India and the world, reaffirming Yoga's role as a global movement for health, harmony and collective well-being.

Ahead of the IDY celebrations, Chief Minister of West Bengal, Shri Suwendu Adhikari and Union Minister of State



(Independent Charge) for Ayush and Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, Shri Prataprao Jadhav addressed a curtain raiser press conference at Nabanna Sabhaghar today, highlighting the significance, scale and preparations for this year's International Day of Yoga.

During the press conference, twelve

special philatelic covers commemorating International Day of Yoga 2026, were released by Chief Minister of West Bengal, Shri Suwendu Adhikari and Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Ayush, Shri Prataprao Jadhav.

Hon'ble Prime Minister to release 23rd installment of Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Scheme to farmers on June 20

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 18 Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) is a flagship Central Sector Scheme of the Government of India, launched in February 2019 to provide income support of Rs. 6,000 per annum to eligible landholding farmer families through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) into their Aadhaar-linked and DBT-enabled active bank

accounts. Since its inception, an amount of more than Rs. 64.48 crore has been transferred to farmers of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands through 22 installments. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India will release the 23rd installment of PM-KISAN to eligible beneficiaries for the period April 2026 to July 2026 from Tarakeswar, Hooghly, West Bengal

on 20th June, 2026. In view of the significance of the occasion and to enhance outreach among the farming community, 20th June, 2026 will be observed as "PM-KISAN Utsav Diwas" in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands in coordination with ICAR-KVKs. 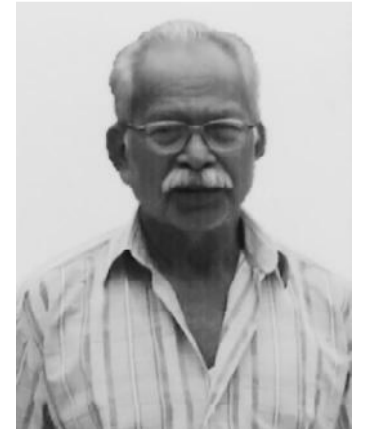
