New Delhi, Aug 18
Tightening regulations, telecom regulator TRAI today raised the penalty on telecom operators to 5 lakh rupees for poor mobile service quality, including call drops. The regulator will also now measure call drops on the basis of data collected on the performance of telecom

towers and not from area offices of telecom companies. The penalty amount will be imposed if the operators are unable to meet the benchmark set for the quality of service in two quarters. The penalty will kick-in if call drops in a quarter average more than 2 per cent of the total traffic

Acquiring minimum qualifications mandated under the RTE Act; teachers advised

Port Blair, Aug 18
The Amendment to the section 23(2) of the RTE Act to extend the period for training to 31st March, 2019 has been passed by the Parliament. This is regarding training of untrained in-service elementary teachers in the Govt./Govt.Aided/unaided Private Schools.



In a press release received here today, the State Nodal Officer, (NIOS-ODL Trainig Prog) has

reiterated that this will be the last chance to acquire the requisite minimum professional qualifications. Any teacher in these schools, who does not have the minimum qualifications mandated under the RTE Act, 2009, would not be allowed to

continue in-service beyond 1st April, 2019, and procedure for dismissal shall be initiated against such teachers.

The D.EL.Ed training programme for the registered teachers will start from 3rd Oct, 2017. Hence they have to register themselves with NIOS by 15th September-2017.

The concerned in-service teachers are required to provide certain

Virat Kohli continues to top ICC ODI rankings for batsmen

Dubai, Aug 18
India captain Virat Kohli continued to be the world's top-ranked One-day batsman in the latest ICC ODI rankings, released in Dubai today. Having 873 points in his kitty, Kohli will have a chance to increase the 12-point lead over second-placed Australian David Warner at the upcoming five-match ODI series against Sri Lanka, starting in Dambulla on Sunday. Other Indian batsmen in the top-15 are former skipper Mahendra Singh Dhoni 12th, Shikhar Dhawan 13th and vice-captain Rohit Sharma 14th. However, no Indian bowler figure in the top-10 list. Pacer Bhuvneshwar Kumar



13th is the lone Indian in top 15. As for the ICC ODI Team Rankings, India are currently at number three and they would have to win the upcoming series at least by a 4-1 margin to ensure that they stay at that position, ahead of England. At 114 points, India, even if win the series 3-2, will slip to 113 points and behind England on decimal points. Meanwhile, Sri Lanka will be eyeing the chance to seal direct qualification for the ICC Cricket World Cup 2019 during the upcoming series.

Starc out; Faulkner back in Australia squad for India tour

Melbourn, Aug 18
Australia today recalled the pace duo of James Faulkner and Nathan Coulter-Nile for the five-match ODI series against India next month but Mitchell Starc was left out owing to a foot injury. Faulkner, who was man of the match in the 2015 World Cup final, was omitted from Australia's Champions Trophy squad. The 27-year-old has played 67 ODIs, grabbing 95 wickets. India and Australia are set to play five ODIs and three Twenty20s between September 17 and October 13. "Pacemen James Faulkner and Nathan Coulter-Nile have



been recalled to Australia's ODI squad for their tour of India in September and October, as have all-rounders Ashton Agar and Hilton Cartwright," Cricket Australia said in a statement. The 29-year-old Coulter-Nile, who has also been picked in the Twenty20 squad, has been battling injuries in recent years, which has resulted in a mere 16 ODI appearances. He has 27 wickets to his credit in the 50 over format.
