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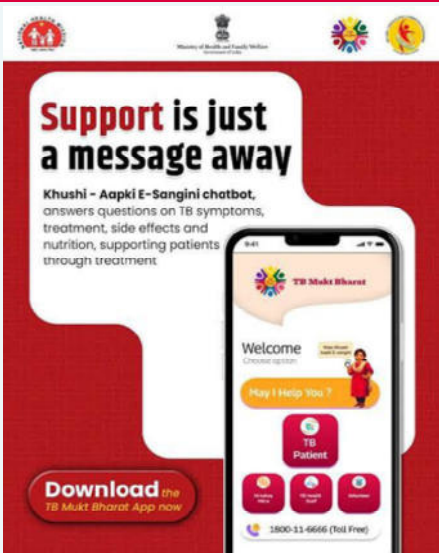
TB Mukth Bharat App providing easy access to TB-related information and services

The TB Mukth Bharat App is a user-friendly digital platform designed to provide easy access to TB-related information and services. The application supports TB patients in their treatment journey by offering treatment guidance, adherence support, and follow-up assistance. It is also integrated with existing systems such as Nikshay to ensure seamless delivery of patient-centric services.

In addition to patient support, the app serves as a powerful tool for disseminating accurate



information on TB, including its symptoms, prevention, and treatment, thereby helping to reduce stigma and encourage early diagnosis.

A key feature of the application is the facilitation of community engagement through the Nikshay Mitra initiative. Members of the general public, institutions, corporates, and organizations are encouraged to register as Nikshay Mitras through the app and extend support to TB patients by providing

nutritional, social, or financial assistance during their treatment period.

The app also features "Khushi - Aap Ke e-Sangini", an interactive chatbot designed to provide instant, reliable, and user-friendly information on TB. The chatbot assists users by answering queries related to symptoms, diagnosis, treatment, and available government support services. The TB Mukth Bharat App will play a crucial role in bridging gaps in awareness, improving treatment adherence, and mobilizing community support.

District Consultation Meet on '10 Years of Juvenile Justice Act, 2015' held

A District-Level Stakeholder Consultation Meeting on "10 Years of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015" was held today in the Conference Hall of the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman in accordance with the guidance of the Hon'ble Juvenile Justice Committee, High Court at Calcutta, pursuant to the initiative of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The consultation brought together key stakeholders from various departments and institutions, including the Police, Education, Health, Social Welfare, District Child Protection Unit



(DCPU), Child Care Institutions (CCIs), Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) and other agencies associated with child protection and welfare. The meeting focused on strengthening collaborative mechanisms for ensuring the safety, rights, protection, rehabilitation and holistic development of children in need of care and protection, children in conflict with law, and children involved in adoption processes, in accordance with the provisions of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

The consultation commenced with a discussion on the key focus areas and cross-cutting themes circulated by the Hon'ble Juvenile Justice Committee. Emphasis was laid on

effective implementation of the Juvenile Justice Act, timely intervention, inter-departmental coordination, child-friendly procedures and strengthening community-level child protection mechanisms.

The District Child Protection Unit, South Andaman, made a detailed Power Point presentation covering adoption, children in need of care and protection, children in conflict with law, and the major achievements and developments during the last ten years of implementation of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 in the district.

Op Falcon - Joint Anti-Intrusion Operation by Andaman & Nicobar Command

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 18

In a sustained and coordinated operation to safeguard the territorial integrity and security of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Andaman & Nicobar Command (ANC) successfully culminated Op Falcon on 17th August, 2026, following a prolonged search operation in the remote and densely forested areas of North Andaman.

The operation was launched by ANC on 9th August, 2026 based on credible and actionable inputs regarding the presence of suspected intruders in the region. The Command swiftly mobilised its joint operational resources and initiated a systematic search and area domination operation in the challenging terrain of North Andaman.

The operation involved sustained and coordinated deployment of personnel and assets of all components of ANC and Andaman & Nicobar Police. Quick Reaction Teams (QRTs), New Generation Mini UAVs, surveillance copters and trained tracker dogs were effectively employed to enhance detection, tracking and search capabilities across the dense tropical forests. The seamless integration of land, maritime and aerial surveillance resources enabled sustained domination of the area and facilitated the progressive detection, tracking and apprehension of the intruders.



Operating continuously under difficult terrain and environmental conditions, the search elements displayed exceptional perseverance, operational readiness and adaptability. The integrated deployment of ground forces, aerial surveillance and specialised tracking assets enabled the forces to progressively narrow down the search area and locate the intruders attempting to evade apprehension in the dense forest.

The sustained joint operation

resulted in the apprehension of 12 intruders. The apprehended individuals and other recovered material are being dealt with as per established procedures and further investigation is in progress.

The successful culmination of Op Falcon demonstrates the high state of operational preparedness, surveillance capability and jointmanship of ANC. The operation also highlights ANC's ability to respond swiftly and effectively to emerging security challenges in

Shri Subhra Bandopadhyay, Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge; Shri Umesh Singh, Hon'ble Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, POCsO, Shri Samrat Roy, Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate, and Shri Jayanta Mukherjee, Judicial Magistrate First Class cum Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, highlighted the importance of sensitizing the Judiciary, Police and other concerned departments towards adopting child-friendly procedures while dealing with matters relating to children in need of care and protection, children in conflict with law and adoption under the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 especially in the preliminary assessment Under Sec 15 of Juvenile Justice Act .

PM-KISAN beneficiaries urged to complete e-kyc & Aadhaar seeding

The Department of Agriculture, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, has urged all PM-KISAN beneficiaries whose e-KYC and/or Aadhaar seeding of their bank accounts has been pending for a long time. The lists of such PM-KISAN beneficiaries have been displayed at the respective Gram Panchayats for information and necessary action.

Beneficiaries are advised to visit their respective Gram Panchayats, check their names in the displayed lists, and complete the pending requirements at the earliest.

earliest.

It is informed that beneficiaries who fail to complete the mandatory requirements within the stipulated time may face non-release of subsequent installments and may be liable for removal from the PM-KISAN beneficiary database.

The e-KYC can be completed through the PM-KISAN Portal, PM-KISAN Mobile App, or through the nearest Common Service Centre (CSC). For Aadhaar seeding of bank accounts, beneficiaries may approach their respective bank branches and request Aadhaar seeding/ linking of their bank accounts.

Therefore, all concerned PM-KISAN beneficiaries are requested to check the beneficiary lists displayed at their respective Gram Panchayats and complete their pending e-KYC and/or Aadhaar seeding without further delay, in order to avoid any inconvenience in receiving benefits under the Scheme.

Further, farmers who have already completed e-KYC in the past but have not completed the Annual e-KYC for the year 2026-27 may also complete the e-KYC at the earliest to receive the benefits for the current year, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

the site during 2025 and submitted a project proposal for preparation of DPR for these two dams. Proposal after due scrutiny has been approved by Administration.

Accordingly, in a solemn function the MoU was signed by the SE (Plg) of APWD and SE (Plg) of CWC in the presence of Er. T K Prijiht Rekha, Chief Engineer, APWD and other officials of APWD and CWC to take up DPR preparation for these two dams. DPR preparation is likely to be completed in next 18 months. Thereafter, work can be started after obtaining necessary administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

On completion of these two projects, there will be an additional reserve of approximately 13000 ML which will be more than 1.5 times of the net reservoir capacity of existing Dhanikhari Dam, a press release from APWD received here said.

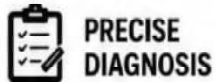

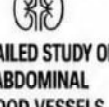
