India will thwart evil designs of terrorists, backers: President

New Delhi, Sep 18 President Shri Pranab Mukherjee today condemned the "outrageous" terrorist attack on an Army base at Uri and said India would thwart the "evil designs" of terrorists and their backers. "India will not be cowed down by such attacks, we will thwart the evil designs of terrorists and their backers," the President said. Shri Mukherjee, who is also the Supreme Commander of the Indian Armed Forces, strongly condemned the "outrageous terrorist

attack on Army base in Uri". Paying rich tributes to brave soldiers who made supreme sacrifice, the President expressed heartfelt condolences to the families of those who laid down their lives in the terror strike. He also prayed for speedy recovery of those injured. Uri, a small town located 103 kms north of Srinagar, woke up to heavy gunfire when four terrorists of Jaish-e-Mohammed group entered the battalion headquarters of 10 Dogra regiment and killed 17 soldiers. All the four terrorists were eliminated.

Srinagar, Sep 18 India has blamed Pakistan for today's terrorist attack at an Army camp in Jammu and Kashmir that claimed the lives of 17 soldiers. The terrorists had launched the attack on Rear Administrative Base Camp of Infantry Battalion in Uri town of Baramulla district at around 4 this morning triggering a fierce encounter.



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi condemned the attack, calling it cowardly. In a series of tweets, Shri Modi assured the nation that those behind the attack will be punished. Saluting the martyrs, he offered his condolences to the bereaved families and said their service to the nation will always be remembered. The Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh later

reviewed the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir in the wake of terror incident in Uri. Shri Singh said, there are definite and conclusive indications that the perpetrators were highly

trained, heavily armed and specially equipped. Extending his condolences to the families of the martyred, the Home Minister said that those behind this terror incident would be brought to

justice. The Minister expressed his distress at the loss of 17 brave soldiers and hoped for the speedy recovery of the injured. He said, Pakistan is a

Indian shooter Subhankar Pramanick wins gold in ISSF Junior World Cup

Gabala, (Azerbaijan), Sept 18
Young Indian shooter Subhankar Pramanick clinched the gold medal in 50-metre rifle prone event at the ISSF Junior World Cup for pistol, rifle and shotgun here on Sunday. The Indian shot 205.5 overall to finish top of the podium. Czech Republic's Filip

Nepejchal (205.2) followed in second position, while Romania's Dragomir lordache (185.1) was placed third at the end of the finals. A total of 279 junior athletes, representing 27 countries, are battling it out in 18 events. Pramanick had finished sixth in the qualification after shooting 613.8 over six

and institutions volunteering for the Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyaan (PMSMA). Essentially these services will be provided by the Medical Officer and OBGY specialists.

Facilities where such trained manpower is not available, services from private practitioners on volunteering services basis are to be arranged. PMSMA will help in providing quality ANC and also detection, referral treatment and follow up of high risk pregnancies and women having complication. During this campaign, trained service provider and ASHA will focus their efforts to identify and reach out to pregnant women who have not registered for Antenatal Care (ANC) (left out and missed ANC) and also those who have registered but have not availed the services (drop out) as well as high risk pregnant women. It will also be ensured that not only all pregnant women complete their schedule ANC visits, but also undertake all essential investigations. While 9th of every month will be organized as a special day, the routine and planned services such as Antenatal Care (ANC), Postnatal Care (PNC) etc. will continue to be delivered at all the facilities as scheduled in their respective micro-plans, a communication from the Director of Health Services, A&N Administration said.

collected by the Authority, cannot be shared with anyone for any reason. Any violation of the Aadhaar Act will constitute an offence and is punishable under the Act. The agencies that collect the Aadhaar number will also have to specify whether submission of the number or proof of Aadhaar is mandatory or voluntary. The regulations also provide for obtaining consent of the Aadhaar number holder for collection, storage and use of the same for specified purposes.
