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Prime Minister launches SC/ST hub in Ludhiana

Ludhiana, Oct 18
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on Tuesday unveiled key initiatives and a hub, to provide support to entrepreneurs from the SC/ST community in Ludhiana. The National SC/ST Hub, under the MSME Ministry, was announced in the Budget as well. With an initial outlay of 490 crore rupees, the hub will work towards strengthening market access/linkage, monitoring, capacity building, leveraging financial support schemes



and sharing industry-best practices. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi also presented national awards to outstanding micro, small and medium enterprises. He also distributed 500 traditional wooden

effect' (on environment) scheme which is aimed at raising quality levels in the unregulated MSME sector. It will hand-hold MSMEs across the country in all 'make in India' sectors through quality control cells constituted by the government, which will rate them after carrying out annual assessment of their products. Shri Modi also said a spirit of entrepreneurship among Dalits will benefit the country. He added there are youngsters whose dreams are to create enterprises and jobs.

State sponsored & state protected terrorism is biggest global challenge: External Affairs Minister

New Delhi, Oct 18
External Affairs Minister Smti Sushma Swaraj has said that global prosperity is dependent on continued peace and security and terrorism is a key threat to stability, progress and development. Inaugurating BRICS media forum in New Delhi today, Smti Swaraj said, terrorism featured prominently in discussions and the eventual outcome of just concluded BRICS summit. Smti Swaraj said, global community must be prepared to extract costs

from those who sponsor and support terrorists, who provide them sanctuary, and despite their own claimed victimhood, continue to make the false distinction between good and bad terrorists. She said, today there is no bigger global challenge than state-sponsored and state-protected terrorism. The Minister said, when India took over Chair of BRICS, it laid out an ambitious agenda premised on building responsive, inclusive and

collective solutions. She said, the selection of BIMSTEC as outreach group for BRICS this year is worth reflecting as the BIMSTEC nations-Bhutan, Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand represent the polar opposite of a terrorism promoting polity. They are focused on improving the quality of life of their people, on skills and employment, on education and health, and on the quality of governance and the deepening of democracy.

The Minister said, there cannot be a greater contrast with those who reject even trade and connectivity for political reasons. Smti Swaraj said, the media forum is an opportunity for review and evaluation for marking one more milestone along the common journey. She added that 115 plus BRICS events have been held so far which includes Parliamentary meetings, senior officials meetings, workshops, business meetings.

MP requests District Administration for closure of Bamboo bar

Port Blair, Oct. 18
The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray has requested the District Administration, South Andaman to close the Bamboo Bar at Bambooflat for maintaining peace, law & order in the locality. In a letter written to the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, the Member of Parliament said he personally spoke to many residents of Bambooflat and adjoining villages who complained about various

social issues related with the bar. The bar situated in the market area has been a perennial source of disruption of peace and tranquility in the area. The women complain that they are unable to walk or use the shops during evening hours due to nuisance created by the bar users. Small children are afraid to use the footpath and go alone due to intimidation and eve teasing. The recent quarrel in the bar resulted in the death of

a resident of Bambooflat, Rajesh Barla. He was grievously injured in a scuffle after drinking alcohol from the bar, said the MP in his letter. The MP visited GB Pant Hospital to see the body of the young man and also met his family. The MP further mentioned that most of the women he met, appealed to help them close the bar, which is ruining their peace, a communication from the MP's Office said here.

Govt to bring new Consumer Protection law to check misleading ads

New Delhi, Oct 18
Food and Consumer Affairs Minister Shri Ram Vilas Paswan has said that the government will bring a new Consumer Protection law in the upcoming Parliament session, that will have strong provisions against celebrities endorsing misleading advertisements as well as adulteration. He said, a group of ministers, headed by Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley, will soon meet to finalise the amendments to the new Consumer Protection Bill, 2015, based on the recommendation of the Parliamentary Standing

Committee. Shri Paswan was talking to media persons on the sidelines of a function in New Delhi recently. The GoM had in late August, asked the Consumer Affairs Ministry to look at laws of other countries related to misleading ads by celebrities before finalising the Bill. The Consumer Affairs Ministry had proposed stringent provisions to tackle misleading advertisements as well as to fix liability on endorsers/celebrities. For the first time offence, a fine of 10 lakh rupees and

MP requests LG for shifting of wholesale market to outskirts of Port Blair

Port Blair, Oct. 18
The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray has requested the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, for shifting of wholesale market in the outskirts of Port Blair. In a letter addressed to the Lt. Governor, a copy of which has been sent to the press, the Member of Parliament said, presently the main wholesale-cum-retail market is located at Aberdeen Bazar (mostly in Babu Lane), Gurudwara Lane, Junglighat, Prem Nagar, Delanipur, Haddo, Phoenix Bay etc. These traders deal with a variety of commodities such as hardware/spare parts

items, food gains, textile, electronic items, medicines and other consumable of daily use. These shops also have godowns in the vicinity or behind the same shop itself. The MP further said, this practice started prior to independence in many areas, when business in the territory was miniscule. With the increase in population, the volume of business also increased proportionately. Vehicular traffic over these roads is also the maximum being the heart of the city. There is limited or no scope for further expansion of the roads at these locations.

There is a felt need to decongest these areas of the vehicular movement and also to shift the godowns of wholesale traders to other locations, preferably at the outskirts of the city in a planned manner, the MP said. Accordingly, the Member of Parliament has requested the Lt. Governor to look into the matter and identify locations for setting up the facility at the outskirts of the city. This will be beneficial to traders as well as ease congestion over the roads and the areas, a communication from the Office of the MP said here today.

SSWB Chairperson holds meeting with functionaries of Mahila Mandals/NGOs

Port Blair, Oct. 18
The Chairperson, A&N State Social Welfare Board, Dr. (Smt.) Poonam Arora held a meeting with the functionaries of Mahila Mandals/NGOs at the conference hall of A&N SSWB here yesterday. Functionaries of the aided/un-aided institutions from Port Blair, different places in South Andaman, Havelock, Rangat, Mayabunder attended the meeting. The terms and conditions of the revised Rajiv Gandhi National Creche scheme were also discussed in



detail in the meeting and Dr. Poonam Arora, Chairperson of the Board assured that their points will be placed in the Central Social Welfare Board. The Chairperson also made it clear that the Mahila Mandals not only for run

PBMC Chairperson inspects Dhanikhari dam; issues directions to officials

Port Blair, Oct. 18
Planning and organizing to ensure daily water supply to the citizens of Port Blair Municipal area has been flagged by the Council for which all out efforts are being made. The Port Blair Municipal Council has mandate to supply water to the citizens and APWD, after the required treatment, supplies the water to Port Blair Municipal Council. In order to assess the demand-supply gap, Shri B. Eswar Rao, Chairperson, PBMC personally inspected the Dhanikhari Dam today along with a team of Councilors and Officers of PBMC. It was noticed that the earlier capacity of the Dam was 4370 ML. Having raised the capacity, presently the dam including the catchment area holds 8544 ML water. Under such circumstances, preliminary assessment showed that daily supply of water is within the ambit of PBMC



subject to the condition that adequate supply is ensured by the APWD. During earlier inspection at various facilities of water distribution pertaining to APWD, water treatment plant at Lambaline was also inspected by the

Chairperson along with Councilors and officers of the Council in presence of representative of APWD and it was observed that the filter beds have not been dedicated for the service to the citizens. (Contd. on last page)

Food Business Operators urged to adhere to good manufacturing & hygiene practices

Port Blair, Oct. 18
Keeping in view the ensuring Diwali festival, the Department of Food Safety has cautioned all the FBO involved in the procurement of 'khoa' from mainland for sale to the Food Business Operators involved in manufacture, storage, distribution and sale of 'khoa' based

sweetmeats, to meet the Food Safety and Standards (packing & labeling) Regulation, 2011 of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006. The Food Business Operators have been asked to inform the department about the arrival of khoa, so that the enforcement officials could inspect & determine the quality of

khoa being sold in A&N Islands. Further, the Department has urged all the owners of bakery and sweetmeat manufacturers and bakery and sweetmeat shops of A&N Islands to maintain strict personal hygiene, cleanliness and also wear proper dress code during business hours.

The Food Business Operators have also been advised to adhere to good manufacturing practices and good hygiene practices. Any laxity during inspection will invite legal action under the relevant sections of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, a communication from the Commissioner Food Safety said here today.

Administration not to admit requisition for reservation of tickets

Port Blair, Oct. 18
The A&N Administration has decided to keep only 10 tickets reserved under Administration's quota for the sector Port Blair-Chennai-Port Blair and Port Blair-Kolkata-Port Blair chartered flights while the balance 30 (40-10) of the earlier reserved quota of the Administration has been made available/offered to general public of both categories (Islanders/

Non-Islanders) through the Common Service Center (CSC) or Inter-Island Helicopter Ticketing Counter Office of the Assistant Director (Shipping), Chennai & DRC Kolkata. Due to heavy flow of requisitions for tickets from general public including the medically referred cases (referral by ship), political parties, PRIs & from Defence, the Administration

has decided to discontinue the practice of admitting any applications/requisition for reservation of tickets and therefore no applications/requisition will be accepted. However, only the cases of emergency nature of Govt. servants/departments shall be accepted and shall be allotted on merit of the cases, a communication from the Assistant Secretary (GA) said.

No.F.No. 4-11(RR)/Estt-Ind/2008.--In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi Notification No. 14/3/60-ANL dated 11/04/1960 and in supersession of Notification No. 160/88/ F.No. 50-370/79-Dev-I dated 17.03.1988, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' post of Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade) borne in the establishment of Directorate of Industries in the Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

1. Short title and commencement:-
i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Directorate of Industries Group 'C') Recruitment Rules, 2016.
ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number, classification and scale of pay:-
The number of the post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed thereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification:-
The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in paras 5 to 15 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification:-
No person--
a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

5. Powers to relax:-
Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings:-
Nothing in these rules shall effect the reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

ANNEXURE-1

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF STAFF CAR DRIVER (ORDINARY GRADE)

- Should drive the vehicle in safe way as per traffic rules.
- Should maintain accounts of the journeys of vehicle in the log book of the vehicle properly and maintain accounts for the fuel drawn for vehicle on weekly basis.
- Should get the log book verified and signed by the designated authority on monthly basis.
- Should keep the vehicle neat and clean by water washing, wiping and polishing.
- Should check the oil lubricant, water and brake every day before the vehicle being taken by driving.
- Must be able to change wheels and correctly inflate the tyre.
- Should maintain tool kit in the vehicle.
- Should keep the spare wheel/ parts in the vehicle in safe custody and in good condition.
- On the vehicle being sent for repairs etc. he would be required to maintain close coordination with workshop to get the vehicle repaired in time and keep himself abreast of the progress of repair/ replacement of damaged parts etc.
- The damage / replaced parts of vehicle after repair shall be made available to vehicle incharge of the office.
- Should maintain a date-wise record entry in respect of the repairs, cost of spare parts replaced at the time of carrying out the repair.
- Responsible for timely reporting of breakdowns/ accidents to the authorities.

NOTE: As the service of the department is an essential service, he is required to work even after duty hours as & when required for any such important / urgent work of the department.

Saina Nehwal appointed member of International Olympic Committee's Athletes' Commission

Hyderabad, Oct 18
In a rare honour for an Indian sportsperson, ace shuttler Saina Nehwal has been appointed as a member of the International Olympic Committee's (IOC) Athletes' Commission.
Saina has received a letter to the effect from the IOC President Thomas Bach last night. "Following your candidature for the elections of the IOC Athletes' Commission during the Olympic Games Rio 2016, it is with great pleasure to appoint you in consultation with the Chair, as Member of the Athletes' Commission," the letter said. The Athletes' Commission is chaired by Angela Ruggiero and it comprises nine vice presidents and 10 other members. The next meeting of the Commission is scheduled for November 6. Saina's appointment to the prestigious panel has come just when she is set to resume practice after recovering from a knee injury. Saina, who sustained an intra-articular injury (inside the joint) to her right knee, had said in an interview last month that she hoped play in tournaments in



November if everything went well. Saina's father Harvir Singh expressed happiness over her appointment to the Olympic panel. "I have become very emotional. It is a matter of great privilege for us that they recognised her and to be a part of the IOC. They thought that she could be of some use. She lost (a medal in the Olympics) because of the injury. We are proud of her," Harvir Singh said.

European Leagues: AC Milan in third place

Milan, Oct 18
Juraj Kucka and M'Baye Niang struck either side of half-time and Carlos Bacca added a flukey third as AC Milan moved up to third in Serie A with a 3-1 win at Chievo on Sunday. Chievo had been among the early season pacesetters in Italy's top flight, Rolando Maran's men sitting among the

top five after starting their campaign with a 2-0 home win over Inter Milan. But the Flying Donkeys were brought back to earth with a bump with a first home defeat of the season that, for seven-time European champion Milan, revived ambitions of qualifying for continental football next season.

Indian football team captain Sunil Chhetri today urged the entire nation to root for his club Bengaluru FC as they chase a historic final berth in the AFC Cup here on Wednesday.
Bengaluru FC will host the I-League football champions - Malaysia's Johor Darul Ta'zim FC - in a crucial Asian Football Confederation (AFC) Cup second-leg semi-final.



The first-leg semi-final ended in a 1-1 draw. "To put it simply, this game will decide if Indian club football can write a new chapter in history or not. We're on the brink of something special and it's going to take a determined 90 minutes to set foot where no club from the country has before," Chhetri, the country's highest scorer said. He said the match is about the whole country, and not just Bengaluru. Bengaluru played out a 1-1 draw with Johor Darul Ta'zim FC in the first leg match away at Johor Bahru. They will carry an advantage of an away goal in the second leg

at the Kanteerava Stadium here. Chhetri has been a part of quite a few glorious moments in Indian football history both for his club as well as the country.

jail term of up to two years, while for second and subsequent offences, a fine of 50 lakh rupees and imprisonment of five years has been proposed for brand ambassadors.
