ANIIDCO's fresh cow milk & by-products bolstering Isles' Dairy Sector

Maintains eight Milk Chilling Centres & 3 milk tankers; 675725 liters of fresh cow milk procured from farmers since last one year

Port Blair, Nov. 18

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Integrated Corporation Ltd. (ANIIDCO) is engaged in the business of production and marketing of milk and milk products in A&N Islands with array of products ranging from toned milk, paneer, curd, cow milk etc. With a view to give further fillip to the dairy sector in A&N Islands and to strengthen its milk collection chain, ANIIDCO is currently



operating a fleet of 3 milk tankers.

To facilitate storage of fresh milk collected from the farmers from different villages, eight Milk Chilling Centres having storage capacity of up to 8000 liters have been established by

ANIIDCO at (BMCs) for hygienic storage of fresh cow milk collected from the farmers.

The collection of milk is carried out through the milk collection van which goes from door to door and collects the milk.

The milk is then taken to the Chilling Centres where it is chilled through Bulk Milk Cooler. The milk tanker goes to the Chilling Centres at N & M Andaman on alternate days and transports the collected milk to the Milk Plant at Dairy Farm, Port Blair for processing and packaging. Apart from this, ANIIDCO also maintains two Refrigerated Vans for emergency purpose.

Administration increases frequency of Helicopter Services to Inter-Islands

New schedule to be effective from Nov. 20

Port Blair, Nov. 18

Keeping in view the requirement of the Islands, the Directorate of Civil Aviation, A&N Administration has decided to increase the frequency of helicopter services to Inter-Islands. The new schedule will be effective from November 20th, 2020. As per the new schedule, there will be weekly three services for Campbell Bay on every Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday. For Kamorta, Katchal and Teressa there will be weekly three flights on every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. For Chowra, weekly two flights on



every Monday and Wednesday. For Car Nicobar, weekly eight flights from Monday to Saturday.

Similarly, for Mayabunder and Diglipur, there will be weekly four flights on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday. For Hutbay, weekly three flights on every

Wednesday and Friday. For Swaraj Dweep, the services will be available on every Monday and Saturday.

Further, all passengers intending to travel to destinations in Nicobar District are to undergo RT-PCR Test prior to travel and only those passengers tested negative will be

Transparency & accountability in the system: District Administration registering deeds through online process

General public urged not to fall prey to middleman

The registration process is an important aspect of the District Revenue Administration. In order to achieve transparency and accountability in the system, the District Administration has been registering deeds through online process. The general public have been appealed to register on URL <https://online.registration.ni.gov.in/> or visit their nearest Common Service Centers (CSCs) for uploading their documents at enlisted rates of CSCs.

Further, general public have been informed that the broad checklist of documents for registration includes



ROR, Sketch map, valuation of land (if applicable), No dues/ Non encumbrance from Revenue Department and PBMC (if applicable), or report (in case of agriculture land) and sale permission (in case of house site), to be uploaded. The checklist of documents has already been provided on the above mentioned

URL for public convenience. Since the District Administration believes in simplifying and streamlining process therefore, all the redundant documents have been removed.

The District Administration has once again urged the general public to not fall

prey to middleman and there is no need to visit the Office separately for the registration process. In case of any undue influence or any difficulty/issues, they can also approach the Help Desk set up at DC Office, South Andaman, a press release from DC (SA) said.

have benefitted from this scheme. Shri Adhinageshwar Rao, hailing from Wimberlygunj village of South Andaman District is one such beneficiary who learned about this scheme from a known person working in the Industries Department.

With an education of only upto IX standard, he worked under a private firm taking up fabrication works for few years but was always desperate to own an enterprise. Having made up his mind, he met the officials of A&N KVIB and discussed with them the support available from Government to start a self-employment venture. They advised him to do a small market survey and find out what he would like to do. His market survey revealed that there was a scope for fabrication unit in his area.

Finally, he submitted his application to the KVIB Office for sanction of loan through A&N SCB, Wimberlygunj. On the strength of the proposal and good recommendation by KVIB, A&N State Co-operative Bank sanctioned a loan of Rs. 1,94,000/- under PMEGP scheme for setting up of his fabrication works during 2011. He also undertook the EDP training through SBI R-SETI which endowed him with a vision of an entrepreneur.

He is now running a successful business and earning a monthly income of Rs. 30,000. He expressed his gratitude to PMEGP scheme for making him a successful entrepreneur. (Source: A&N KVIB)

technical and industrial attitude in the minds of younger generation. The Scheme being the most important in the field of Vocational Training, has been shaping craftsmen to meet the existing as well as future manpower need, through the vast network of ITIs spread over various States/Union Territories in the country.

The Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) plays a vital role in growth of GDP of the country in terms of providing skilled manpower to the industry. The educational qualification varies from Class VIII pass to Class XII pass depending upon the trades. The duration of training varies from one to two years. The trainees after completion of craftsmen training appear in the All India Trade Test (AITT) for National Trade Certificate (NTC) awarded by National Council for Vocational Education & Training (NCVT), which is recognized for the purpose of recruitment to the subordinate technical posts at the shop floor level within the country as well as abroad.

The State Governments through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) impart institutionalized vocational training under Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS), which is one of the flagship programmes run by the Directorate General of Training (DGT), MSDE, GoI.

As on date, a total of 3 Government ITIs are functioning one in each District in A&N Islands. Under Craftsman Training Scheme, 13 conventional trades are offered in 41 Training Units with a total intake capacity of 928 seats. The duration of the trades are full time 2 years & 1 year. Admission to these trades courses are conducted every year in the month of July-August, a press release from ITI said.

collects about 1500 litres of fresh cow milk daily from approximately 550 farmers of N & M and South Andaman. The milk is stored in the Bulk Milk Coolers until the milk tanker collects the same. The farmer is paid Rs.40 per liter depending on the quality of milk he supplies and the amount is directly transferred into his/her bank account on monthly basis. In South Andaman, fresh cow milk is collected from Tirur, Habdipur, Cattlegunj, Ferrargunj, Shaitankari, Namunagar and Mithakhari. Approximately 200 litres of milk are collected from South Andaman on a daily basis from 50 collection points.

During the last one year, ANIIDCO has procured 675725 liters of fresh cow milk from the farmers and paid an amount of Rs. 27,715,846/- to them, thereby adding to their income and supporting their livelihood. ANIIDCO has sold 870670 liters of toned milk 1,76,921 kg curd, 7130 kg paneer, 7,34,378 liters of cow milk in the last one year, thereby generating a revenue amounting to Rs.104,337,836/-.

Presently, ANIIDCO is engaging with the Department of Social Welfare in providing toned, milk specially packed in 200ml pouches for door delivery to the Anganwadi children as the Anganwadis are not functional due to COVID-19. However, the nutritional requirements of the children are being met through doorstep supply of entitled rations/meals which includes 200ml milk. Since 8th September, 2020, ANIIDCO has been able to provide 82519 litres of toned milk specially packed for Aganwadi children.

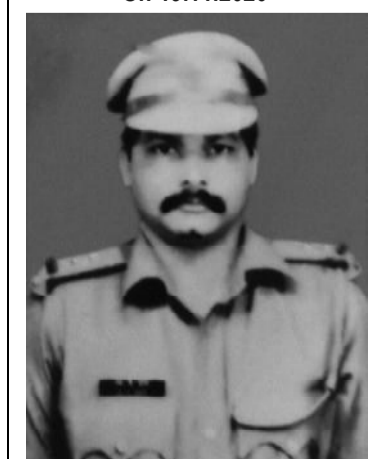
