Transport Department awarded for achieving lowest road accident record by Ministry of Road Transport for second consecutive time

Multi-pronged road safety strategy yields result

Port Blair, Jan. 18

Road accidents continue to be a leading cause of death, disabilities and hospitalization in the country despite the commitment and efforts of various agencies involved. India ranks first in the number of road accident deaths across the 199 countries and accounts for almost 11% of the accident related deaths in the World. Government has been taking multiple initiatives including those related to vehicular and road engineering as well as educational measures for raising awareness in the field of Road Safety.

Transport Department, Andaman & Nicobar Administration is operating bus service in 13 Islands ensuring mobility to the citizen through public transport. Every effort is taken to ensure that the service is provided in a safe and reliable manner. Proactive action has been taken by the Department so that scope of road accidents is reduced to barest minimum. Timely preventive maintenance of buses, training to drivers on correct and safe driving, sensitizing the drivers on rash & negligent driving as well as drunken driving are some of the measures taken by the Department to reduce accidents. Other actions like constant monitoring of their performances, frequent checking with breath



analyzers and motivating the employees are also adopted by the Department. This effort has not only minimized road accidents but also resulted in financial saving for the Department on account of increased mileage, less breakdown etc.

Ministry of Road Transport has been motivating the State Transport Undertakings in the country by facilitating them with Transport Minister's Road Safety award for safe operation of buses on the basis of number of accidents.

This year Andaman and Nicobar Administration has been adjudged as winner in the category 'Moffusil operation for STUs having fleet size up to 1000 buses in 2019-20 and 2020-21 for lowest accident record'. The road accident record in Andaman & Nicobar Islands has been

the lowest in the country. In the previous year 2018-19 also the Andaman & Nicobar Administration was adjudged as the winner for the lowest accident record. The award was given jointly by Shri. Nitin Gadkari, Hon'ble Union Minister of Road Transport & Highways and Shri. Rajnath Singh, Hon'ble Defence Minister in the presence of Gen. V.K. Singh, (Retd) Hon'ble Minister of State for Road Transport & Highways in a grand function held in New Delhi. The award which contained a trophy and a cash prize of one lakh rupees was received by the Joint Resident Commissioner, A&N Administration, Delhi on behalf of A&N Administration.

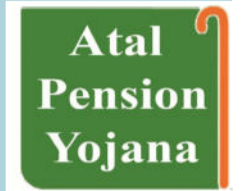

Electronic 'Pension Payment Order' promises ease of living for senior citizens: Minister

New Delhi, Jan. 18

The Minister of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr Jitendra Singh has said that the recently introduced Electronic Pension Payment Order (PPO) promises ease of living for senior citizens. Referring to some path-breaking reforms introduced in the Ministry, Dr Singh said that the Department of Pensions was often at the receiving end of

complaints from senior citizens about the original copies of their Pension Payment Order getting misplaced. He said, in such situations, the pensioners, particularly the older pensioners, had to face several hardships.

Accordingly, the Department of Pensions and Pensioners' Welfare decided to integrate the electronic PPO generated through PFMS application of Controller General of

Accounts with Digi-locker. This enables the pensioner to obtain an instant print-out of the latest copy of his PPO from the Digi-locker account. Dr Singh said, a number of reforms have been introduced to bring ease of living and convenience in the lives of pensioners whose population is increasing day by day with the increase in lifespan and improved status of health. Towards 100% coverage of PwDs fulfilling criteria for inclusion under NFSA, 2013

Civil Supplies Deptt. urges leftout households with PwDs to submit their application

Port Blair, Jan. 18

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed for inclusion of all eligible households with PwDs/disabled persons under NFSA by conversion of their existing APL ration card to PHH ration card. To attain 100% coverage of all PwDs fulfilling the criteria for inclusion under NFSA, 2013, such

eligible ration card holders have been directed to approach their respective Civil Supplies Units positively by 1st March, 2021 for further course of action. In this regard, the Department of Civil Supplies has issued a press note for sensitizing the eligible households which resulted in coverage of many household with PwDs under NFSA.

It is once again requested that those leftout household with PwDs to submit their application or contact the Civil Supplies Department within the time frame of 1st March, 2021. No application will be entertained after 1st March, 2021 for inclusion of such household under NFSA.

Enhancing fish production

Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana- flagship scheme for focused & sustainable development of fisheries sector

Interested persons urged to submit project proposals at Zonal Fisheries Offices

Port Blair, Jan. 18

The Govt. of India, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying has launched the flagship scheme 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)' to address critical gaps in fish production and productivity, quality, technology, traceability, post harvest infrastructure and management. PMMSY also envisages creation of a conducive environment for private sector participation, development of entrepreneurship, promotion of ease of doing business, innovations and innovative projects including startups, incubators etc in fisheries sector. Accordingly, the Government of India, Ministry of Fisheries has formulated detailed guidelines on entrepreneur model in fisheries and aquaculture. The objective of entrepreneurship model are to attract private investment, foster linkages among producers, aggregators, processors



and exporters, generate sustainable employment and livelihood opportunities besides creation of ecosystem for growth of entrepreneurship in fisheries and aquaculture.

The beneficiaries eligible under entrepreneurship model are individual, entrepreneurs and private firms; fishers,

fish farmers, fish workers and fish vendors and Self Help Groups (SHGs)/ Fisher Cooperatives/Joint Liability Group/Fish Farmer Producer Organizations (FFPOs)/ Companies.

The broad requirements of the scheme are applicants/ beneficiaries should possess own land with clear title free from all encumbrances for the implementation of the projects; the applicant shall have necessary clearance/permission etc from concerned local authorities wherever applicable as per project requirements; the applicant should not have availed similar assistance/subsidy for any activity under Government schemes or Government agency and assets created out of the assistance provided shall not be disposed off in any form by way of sale, gift, transfer and lease for a period of ten years from the date of sanction of project. The funding pattern shall be upto 25% of the total project cost for General Category with a ceiling of Rs. 1.25 crores per project or upto 30% of SC/ST/Women with a ceiling of Rs. 1.50 crores per project; bank loan shall be upto 65% of the project cost for General Category and upto 60% of the

project cost in case of SC/ST/Women; beneficiary contribution shall be minimum 10% of the project cost. Beneficiary may contribute higher margin money in lieu of loan which in any case shall not exceed 40% of the total project cost and the Government assistance shall be released in three installments to the beneficiaries loan account as mile stone link backhanded subsidy in the ratio of 50:30 as per guidelines laid down by the Ministry.

The integration and packing of activities into entrepreneurship model is left to the applicant and some of the suggested entrepreneurship model are:

- ♦ Development of aquaculture Construction of pond with necessary electricity, water supply facilities, development of hatcheries for seed production, feed mill, quality testing labs, fish storage/preservation facilities (ice plant/cold storages), pre-processing facilities, fish transport facilities.
- ♦ Integrated fish farm: Establishment of RAS, Bio-floc, hatchery for seed requirement, feed mill, ice plant, cold storage, testing labs, fish transport facilities (insulated/refrigerated vehicles), kiosks etc.

Under the APY, the subscribers would receive fixed minimum pension of Rs. 1000 per month, Rs. 2000 per month, Rs. 3000 per month, Rs. 4000 per month, Rs. 5000 per month, at the age of 60 years, depending on their contributions, which itself would be based on the age of joining the APY. The minimum age of joining APY is 18 years and maximum age is 40 years. The age of exit and start of pension would be 60 years. Therefore, minimum period of contribution by any subscriber under APY would be 20 years or more. The benefit of fixed minimum pension would be guaranteed by the Government.

APY is open to all bank account holders with auto debit facility to accounts, leading to reduction in contribution collection charges. The subscribers should keep the required balance in their savings bank accounts on the stipulated due dates to avoid any late payment penalty. Due dates for monthly contribution payment is arrived based on the deposit of first contribution amount. In case of repeated defaults for specified period, the account is liable for foreclosure and the GoI co-contributions, if any shall be forfeited.
