

Budget Session of Parliament to be held from Jan. 31 to April 8

New Delhi, Jan. 18
The Budget Session of Parliament will commence on January 31. The first half of the budget session will run from January 31 to February 11. It will reassemble on March 14 to sit until 8th of April subject to exigencies of government business. The Government will present the Budget for fiscal year 2022-23 on 1st of February. President, Shri Ram Nath Kovind will address both the Houses of Parliament assembled together at 11 am on 31st of



January, the first day of Budget Session of Parliament. Lok Sabha Secretariat in a communique said that the eighth session of the 17th Lok Sabha will commence on 31st of January and subject to exigencies of government business, the Session is scheduled to conclude on 8th April, 2022. Big boost for A&N Islands Near Coastal Voyage (NCV) gets in-principle approval; Draft policy and negotiation likely to start

Port Blair, Jan. 18

In what can be termed as a major boost for Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the proposal of the Administration to allow seafarers holding Near Coastal Voyage (NCV) Certificate of Competency to travel to Southeast Asian countries such as Thailand, Malaysia and Indonesia received in-principle approval and the drafting of the multilateral agreement to be executed with these countries through the Ministry of External Affairs along with negotiations for the same is likely to start shortly.

The matter was hanging fire for many years and after the 1997 agreement of BIMMS, where similar agreement with regards to NCV seafarers was reached between India, Bangladesh, Myanmar, Maldives and Sri Lanka, there had been no progress forward. In this regard, a virtual meeting on A&N Administration's proposal for notification of Ports of Ranong & Phuket of Thailand, Ports of Lankavi, Lumut and Klang of Malaysia, Northern Ports of Indonesia under Near Coastal Voyage (NCV) was held today under the Chairmanship of the Union Home Secretary. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration,



Shri Jitendra Narain & Senior Officers attended the meeting.

Although the Administration has been trying to resolve the issue for many years, the proposal has finally been agreed to by the Ministry of Shipping, the DG Shipping, the Ministry of External Affairs and the Ministry of Home Affairs who have shown a positive and favourable response. In the next few months, through a multilateral agreement, it is likely that this will come through. The matter was important as it will allow our seafarers to go to these countries, thus enabling easier movement of ships thereby encouraging growth of tourism, trade, movement of raw materials and construction materials and for opening up of Andamans, not only to particular Ports, but to the entire country and these countries.

In order to de-congest GB Pant Hospital, 3 Specialists, one each from General Medicine, General Surgery and Orthopaedics will be available for OPD consultation at PHC Garacharama with effect from Jan. 19. Patients pertaining to the concerned discipline, who are seriously ill can avail this facility from PHC Garacharama instead of visiting GB Pant Hospital. Meanwhile, an exclusive 'Fever Clinic' has also been opened in GB Pant Hospital away from OPD complex to cater to patients having symptoms suggestive of COVID infection, a press release from GB Pant Hospital said.

National Immunization Day for Polio to be observed in Isles on Feb. 27 instead of Jan. 23

Port Blair, Jan. 18
The National Immunization Day for Polio under the Pulse Polio Immunization programme will now be held in these Islands on February 27 instead of January 23. Due to the current situation of COVID cases, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare while responding on the requests received from the States/ UTs has given directions to observe the National Immunization Day for Polio on Feb. 27, 2022. On the National Immunization Day for Polio, polio drops will be given to all the children in the age group of 0-5 years, a press release from DHS said.

Students whose birth year is 2007 or before are eligible for first dose of vaccination against COVID-19 virus: DoE Appeals to get vaccinated at the earliest

Port Blair, Jan. 18
The Directorate of Education in a press release has informed that all students whose birth year is 2007 or before are eligible for first dose of vaccination against COVID-19 virus and has appealed to all those who have not taken the vaccine so far may get themselves vaccinated at the earliest in their nearest Vaccination Centres. This will enable the Education Department to resume physical teaching as early as possible and minimize the academic loss. For any facilitation regarding vaccination, students/ parents may contact class teachers and school Principals and necessary assistance will be provided to them, the release added.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Jan. 18
During the RT-PCR test conducted on 95 passengers who arrived here yesterday, 25 positive cases have been detected. Today, 10 flights with 488 passengers arrived, out of which, 354 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 124 passengers (4 foreign travellers) and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 34 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, three positive cases have been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 31 passengers and two positive cases have been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 16 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. RTPCR test was conducted on 48 crew members of MV Bharat Seema, 46 crew members of MV Kalighat and 9 crew members of MV Sindhu, the reports of which are awaited. Till 3 pm, 163 eligible persons were vaccinated, out of which, 21 were in the age group of 15-18 years, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Over 158 Crore 4 lakh vaccine doses administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive

New Delhi, Jan. 18

Over 158 Crore 4 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, 79 lakh 91 thousand doses were administered yesterday. Recovery Rate is currently at 94.09 percent. Over one lakh 57 thousand people recovered from COVID-19 infection during last 24 hours. Till now, 3 crore 53 lakh 94 thousand 882 people recovered from COVID-19. India's Active caseload currently stands at 17 lakh 36 thousand 628. Active cases stand at 4.62 percent. Over 2 lakh 38 thousand new cases were recorded in the last 24 hours. Daily positivity rate is at 14.43 percent and Weekly Positivity Rate is at 14.92 percent. Eight thousand 891 total Omicron cases detected so far, an increase of 8.31 per cent since yesterday. 310 deaths were reported in the last 24 hours. Over 70 crore 54 lakh Tests conducted so far. Over 16 lakh 49 thousand tests were conducted in the last 24 hours. (Source: india.gov.in)

Australian Open: Andy Murray, Daniil Medvedev sail into second round

Melbourne, Jan. 18

Former World Number One Andy Murray and favourite Daniil Medvedev have advanced to the second round of Australian Open Tennis tournament. Andy Murray of Britain earned his first victory at the tournament in five years, overcoming 21st seed Nikoloz Basilashvili 6-1, 3-6, 6-4, 6-7(5), 6-4 in the first round of Men's Singles in Melbourne. Russia's Daniil Medvedev registered a 6-1, 6-4, 7-6 (3) win over Henri Laaksonen of Switzerland in the first round at Melbourne Park. In the Women's draw, top-10 seeds Aryna Sabalenka, 21st seed Nikoloz Garbine Muguruza, Iga Swiatek and Anett Kontaveit, all made comfortable starts to their campaign and entered the second round. Former number one Simona Halep also won despite struggling with her serve. Second seed Sabalenka triumphed defeated wildcard Storm Sanders 5-7, 6-3, 6-2 in the opening round. (Source: india.gov.in)

India to take on South Africa in first ODI match of three match series at Paarl today

Paarl, Jan. 18

The Indian cricket team will be up against South Africa in a three-match ODI series starting with the first ODI at the Bolan Park in Paarl tomorrow (Jan. 19) at 2 pm. The Men in Blue face the Proteas in the limited-overs format after suffering a 2-1 defeat in the three-match Test series, following which Virat Kohli announced his decision to step down from the captaincy of India in the Test format. KL Rahul has been appointed the skipper of India for the ODI series in the absence of Rohit Sharma, who is recovering from a hamstring injury. While KL Rahul will lead India for the first time in ODIs, Jasprit Bumrah will be his deputy. Meanwhile, the first two matches of the series will be played at the same venue in Paarl on January 19 and 21, respectively. The teams will then travel to Cape Town for the final ODI of the series, to be played on January 23.

The Labour Department has also appealed to all NGOs, Trade Unions, Social Work Organizations and committed social leaders to conduct e-SHRAM Registration Camps in their respective areas for which the Department will extend all support, a press release from Labour Commissioner (I/c) said.

Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS), Port Blair has been approved 114 MBBS seats by Ministry of Health & Family welfare (MoHFW), Govt. of India and Andaman & Nicobar Administration for the academic year 2021-22.

NEET-2021 qualified students will be admitted through All India quota counseling and state quota counseling. Out of total approved 114 seats, 17 seats of All India quota will be filled by online counseling by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), and rest of the 97 seats will be admitted under state quota (10 EWS plus 87 Category seat).

The Applications will be invited from NEET eligible candidates for admission to ANIIMS, the applicants can apply through common Admission online Portal (www.collegeadmission.andaman.gov.in)

Only NEET-2021 qualified students from Andaman and Nicobar Islands can apply for above mentioned 97 seats of state quota. Remaining 17 seats of All India quota will be filled by online counseling by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC).



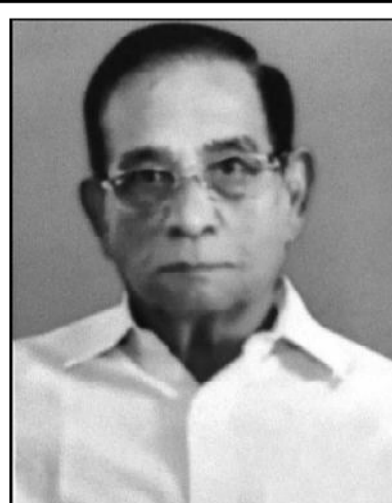
