## Pharmacopoeia Commission of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy set up

New Delhi, Dec 18  
 Manufacturing of Ayurvedic drugs in the country is regulated under the provisions of Chapter IVA of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules framed thereunder. Rule 158-B of the Drugs & Cosmetics Rules, 1945 specifically prescribes the guidelines and requirements licensing of various categories of Ayurvedic products. Adherence to the quality standards of drugs prescribed in the Ayurvedic Pharmacopoeia and authoritative books and

compliance of Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) are mandatory for the Ayurvedic drugs manufacturer. Need-based amendments are made in the Drugs & Cosmetics Rules from time to time in consultation with the Ayurvedic, Siddha and Unani Drugs Technical Advisory Board. Pharmacopoeia Commission of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy has been set up to undertake the work of developing quality standards and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for drugs. Financial support is

extended through National AYUSH Mission and Central Sector Schemes for drugs quality control activities, development of industry clusters, research & development projects and participation in scientific conferences, workshops, promotional events etc. Ayurvedic Pharmacy courses of study and training are conducted in some states and it is proposed to set up a regulatory framework for promoting quality education and practice of pharmacy in Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy.

## Sahitya Academy Awards for 2015 declared

New Delhi, Dec 18  
 The prestigious Sahitya Academy Awards for 2015 have been announced. Playwright and novelist Cyrus Mistry's English novel "Chronicle of a Corpse Bearer" and KR Meera's "Aarachar" in Malayalam are among the works that have won the award. The other two novelist who have won the award are Jaswinder Singh in Punjabi and Madhu Acharya 'Ashawadi' in Rajasthani. Other than this, 6 books, each of short stories and poetry have been chosen for this year's

award. The poets honoured are Brajendra Kumar Brahma in Bodo, Dhian Singh in Dogri, Ramdarash Mishra in Hindi, K.V. Tirumalesh in Kannada, Kshetri Rajan in Manipuri and Ram Shankar Awasthi in Sanskrit. Six writers awarded for their short stories are Kula Saikia in Assamese, Man Mohan Jha in Maithili, Gupta Pradhan in Nepali, Bibhuti Pattanaik in Odia, Maya Rahi in Sindhi and Volga in Telugu. ## Reserve Bank of India Governor Dr. Raghuram Rajan to visit Isles

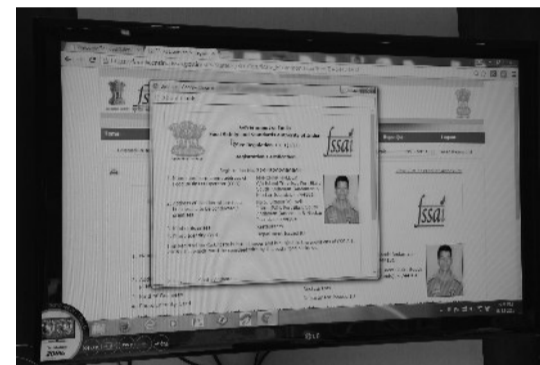
Port Blair, Dec. 18

## EPFO members can file withdrawal application without employer's attestation

Port Blair, Dec. 18  
 Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has allowed its subscribers/members to file their withdrawal application directly to the respective jurisdictional EPF office without employer's attestation. This facility will be available only to those subscribers/members whose Universal Account Number (UAN) is activated and KYC details such as Bank Account and Aadhar Number are seeded

and duly verified by the employer using digital signature and the details in Form No.11(new) have been completed. The claim can be made in the new Form-19(UAN), 10-C(UAN) & F/31(UAN), which is only one page form (each). It can be obtained from PF office free of cost or downloaded from EPFO website www.epfindia.gov.in/epfindia.com.

Hence, all employers are requested to seed KYC details of all of their employees and digitally verify it and complete Form-11(new) at the earliest. All other employees not fulfilling the above conditions shall continue to submit their claims for withdrawals in existing Form No.19, 10C and 31, as the case may be through their employers, a communication from the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner/OIC, Sub-Regional Office, Port Blair said.
