Providing assistive devices to Divyangjans under ADIP Scheme

Social Welfare Deptt. provides devices to 160 Divyangjans; urges beneficiaries to approach CRC for receiving aids

Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of Aids/Appliances (ADIP Scheme) is one of the major initiatives of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India to assist the needy Divyangjan in procuring durable and scientifically manufactured standard aids and appliances to promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation. Assistive devices are given to PwDs with the aim to improve their independent functioning, to arrest the extent of disability and occurrence of secondary disabilities.

A person with disabilities fulfilling the conditions as mentioned would be eligible for assistance under ADIP Scheme viz. Indian citizen of any age who holds a 40% Disability Certificate and his monthly income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 20,000/- per month. In case of dependents, the income of parents/guardians should not exceed Rs. 20,000/- per month. Should not have received assistance



during the last 3 years for the same purpose from any source. However, for children below 12 years of age, this limit would be one year. It is also to mention that Income Certificate of beneficiaries staying in orphanages and half-way homes etc. will be accepted on certification of District Collector or Head of the Organization concerned.

The documents required for availing the benefits under ADIP Scheme are recent colour Passport size photograph (2 Nos), Disability Certificate (photo copy) and original for verification and entry purpose, Ration Card/Voter ID/Driving License (any one photo copy)- (of Parents/beneficiaries), Aadhaar Card (photo copy) for

(beneficiaries/parents), valid mobile number (beneficiaries/parents) and photocopy of Income Certificate.

Income upto Rs. 15,000/- per month will be provided full cost of aid/appliance and income from Rs. 15,001/- to Rs. 20,000/- per month will be provided 50% of the cost of aid/appliance.

The aids & assistive devices provided under ADIP Scheme for Locomotor Disability are Tricycle, Wheel Chair (Adult), Wheel Chair (Child), Auxiliary Crutch (Large), Auxiliary Crutch (Medium), Elbow Crutch (Large), ROLLATOR (Child), Walking Stick, CP Wheel Chair

Mobilization campaign under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana held at Great Nicobar

Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojna (DDU-GKY) is a centrally sponsored Scheme of the Ministry of Rural Development that aims to skill the underserved, rural youth in order to provide them with a regular source of income. DDU-GKY is a skilling and placement initiative with the objective to 'transform rural poor youth into an economically independent and globally relevant



workforce'. A mobilization camp was conducted under this scheme in seven awareness-cum-sensitization programmes at different villages of Campbell Bay by the DDU-GKY team with the help of respective Blocks. In

this programme, rural youth, captains of Tribal Councils, VLWs and Block officials participated. Through this scheme which is being implemented by the Directorate of RD & PRIs, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration aims to provide skill

Five distressed fishermen rescued by Coast Guard & Fisheries Deptt. at sea

Port Blair, Feb. 18

A registered fishing boat MFV Madhana Sea Foods which departed from Port Blair to Rameshwaram on Feb. 13, 2021 was reported to be in distress. MRCC, Chennai received a DAT distress alert from the fishing boat. The Department of Fisheries in coordination with the Coast Guard (East) and Coast Guard, Port Blair conducted a sea-air rescue operation and rescued five fishermen along with the boat in distress at sea. The boat is now being towed to Karaikal, Tamil

Nadu. The condition of the crew is reported to be stable and they were supplied with basic necessities by Coast Guard. The boat owner has reached Kariakal today to receive all the five fishermen.

Meanwhile, the fishermen community expressed their gratitude to the Indian Coast Guard and Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration for taking timely coordinated efforts for effective rescue of the crew and the fishing boat in time, a press release from Fisheries Deptt. said.

Food Business Operators from Aberdeen Bazaar, Haddo, Junglight, Dairy Farm, Shadipur & surrounding areas participated in the programme. During this Mela, the procedure for obtaining New Licenses/ Registration certificates from FSSAI was briefed to the New Food Business Operators. Procedure for uploading online applications, documents which are required to be uploaded along with License/



Registration application form, remittance of License fee through online were also explained in detail to the visitors. Further, procedure for conversion and modification of existing registration certificates into licenses were also elaborated in detail.

Altogether seventy seven FBOs participated in the mela. Three licenses were generated and issued to the applicants on the spot and six new applications for registration certificates were uploaded. Similar licensing and registration melas shall be organized in various parts of the Islands in coming days to ensure no food premises should run without license/registration certificate as per annual turnover.

India supplied corona vaccines to 25 countries; 49 more nations in line for Made-in-India vaccines

New Delhi, Feb. 18
External Affairs Minister, Shri S Jaishankar has said that Made in India COVID vaccines were supplied to 25 nations and 49 countries across the world will be added soon. Speaking at the UNSC Open Debate on Implementation of Resolution 2532, Dr Jaishankar said 2 lakh doses will be given as a gift to UN Peacekeepers. He also suggested the need for persisting with



the vaccination drive, collaborating on genomic surveillance and exchange information, public resistance to vaccines and improving public health infrastructure and build capacity. Dr Jaishankar said 'Vaccine nationalism' must stop and internationalism should be promoted. (Source: india.gov.in)

and Corner Chair. For hearing impairment the equipments provided are Mild class (BTE), Moderate class (BTE) and Extra strong class (BTE). For visual impairment, the devices provided are Smart Cane, Universal Braille Slate, Braille Slate, Tylors Frame, Abacus, Hand Magnifier, Cricket Ball, Daisy Player & Android Tablet. Under intellectual disability, the aids provided are Teaching Learning Material TLM for 0-3 years, Teaching Learning Material TLM for 4-6 years, Teaching Learning Material TLM for 7-11 years and Teaching Learning Material TLM for 12-18 years.

Composite Regional Centre (CRC), Port Blair is implementing ADIP Scheme in this UT. So far, 160 beneficiaries have been assisted during 2020-21 and no target has been fixed by the MoSJ&E. The Centre has facilities for providing speech therapy, physiotherapy, vocational training, prosthetic and orthotic assessment, special education assessment and intellectual assessment.

Eligible and interested Divyangjan have been requested to contact CRC and applicants who are yet to receive their appliances have also been urged to contact the Composite Regional Centre (CRC) at the earliest to remove the deficiencies in their application and avail the benefit. and the Islanders. He also briefed the house about the support available from NABARD through various programmes such as PACS to MSCs, Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF), Watershed Development Fund (WDF), Tribal Development Fund (TDF), Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) and Climate Change Fund. KCC for Fisheries and Animal Husbandry, finalization of scale of finance for the recurring expenditure in Animal Husbandry & Fisheries sector, SHG bank linkage, promotion and credit linkage of FPOs and dissemination of digital literacy awareness in every nook and corner of the Islands were emphasized.

Potential for Priority Sector Lending in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands was estimated at Rs.942.64 crore for the financial year 2021-22. Potential for farm credit (including crop production and term loan) was assessed at Rs.403.09 crore, MSME at Rs. 368.76 crore, informal credit delivery system including lending to SHGs at Rs.10.62 crore and other priority sectors at Rs.160.17 crore.

The theme of the PLP for the year 2021-22 is 'Collectivization of Agricultural Produce for enhancing Farmer's Income'. The major thrust areas for the Islands are nurturing and strengthening the FPOs, supporting primary agricultural credit societies as multi-service cooperatives, de-risking farm income through integrated farm models, financial inclusion, tribal development, mainstreaming the financially excluded, creation of infrastructure for agriculture, fisheries, watershed development and climate change adaptation.

Shri R V Ramakrishna, GM, NABARD mentioned that NABARD prepares Potential Linked Credit Plans for all the districts in the country and also State Focus Papers for ensuring smooth flow of credit to agriculture and rural sectors of the economy. This is considered a unique exercise in credit planning which is based on grass-root planning with the district as the base for development, a press release from NABARD said.


