Prime Minister addresses Economic Times Global Business Summit; says Govt. focusing on empowerment & welfare of people

New Delhi, Feb. 18 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said that the Government is focusing on the empowerment of the poor so that they can contribute to national development.



Addressing the Economic Times Global Business Summit in New Delhi, Shri Modi said, the government re-imagined how to improve the delivery of services to the poor and the implementation of welfare schemes. He said, his government has given pucca houses to three crore

poor families in the last nine years, which reflects the government's dedication for upliftment of the poor. Shri Modi said, the government has so far transferred 28 lakh crore rupees under the Direct Benefit Transfer,

with zero leakage. Prime Minister said, better infrastructure is needed for the rapid growth of the country, therefore the government re-imagined infrastructure building as a grand strategy. He said, PM Gatishakti National

Master Plan is not only giving speed to the construction of infrastructure but also giving emphasis to area development and people development. Shri Modi said, highways are being built in the country at a

speed of 38 kilometres per day and more than five kilometres of rail lines are being built daily. He said, today, India has put a new model of physical and social infrastructure development in front of the whole world. Taking the example of the government's

concept of re-imagination, Shri Modi said, more than one hundred districts which were considered very backward in 2014 were turned into aspirational districts. He said, the sanitation coverage in rural areas of the

country at that time was less than 40 percent which has now reached 100 percent under 'Swachh Bharat

Dr. Jaishankar said that in the last four

Acting on a specific intelligence input from reliable source, Police team from Central Crime Station consisting of SI M.A. Rasheed, PCs K. Rajendran and Raja Rao intercepted one cargo truck on 17/02/2023 at Ferrargunj Junction bearing registration No. AN-01/R-3985 which was coming towards Port Blair from Diglipur. During checking of cargo items loaded in the truck, 33 gunny bags containing 1783.95 Kgs of endangered Trochus

Shells were found concealed clandestinely with coconut gunny bags. The truck along with Trochus Shell was seized and Driver of the truck namely C. Siva, 29, R/o Jirkatang, South Andaman and cleaner Rohan Toppo, 27, R/o Parnasala, Rangat were detained for violation U/s 50/51 of The Wildlife (Protection) Act-1972. Twelve cheetahs from South Africa arrive at Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh

Bhopal, Feb. 18
Twelve cheetahs from South Africa arrived at Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh today, February 18. These cheetahs were released into the Park by Union Ministers Shri Bhupendra Yadav and Shri Narendra Singh Tomar and Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan today. The cheetahs are being brought to India as part of the Reintroduction

Project on the basis of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed between the South African and the Indian Governments. Adequate arrangements have been made in the Kuno National Park to welcome African cheetahs who came to India through a long journey of about 8.5 thousand km. There are seven male and five female cheetahs in these 12 cheetahs. Thus, the number of cheetahs in Kuno National Park has increased now from 8 to 20. With the increase in the number of cheetahs in Kuno National Park, new doors of tourism and development will open for the entire region. Experts associated with the cheetah reintroduction project hope that cheetahs of South Africa will also quickly adopt Kuno National park as their new home like the cheetahs of Namibia.
