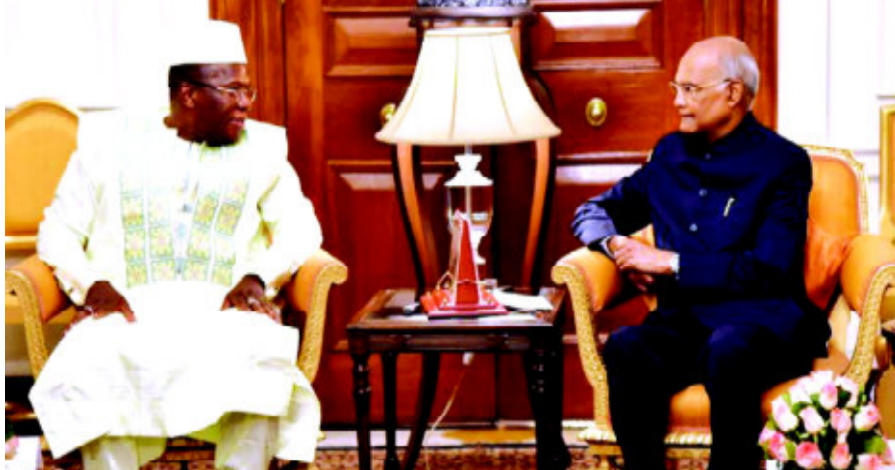

India, Guinea must work to enhance bilateral trade: President

New Delhi, Mar. 18
President Shri Ram Nath Kovind has said bilateral trade between India and Guinea reached almost 900 million US dollars in 2017-18. This represents an increase of nearly 40 per cent from the previous year. Shri Kovind said this while welcoming Prime Minister of Guinea, Dr. Ibrahima Kassory Fofana at Rashtrapati Bhavan today. The President said, both the countries must continue to work to further



enhance bilateral trade in coming years. Shri Kovind said recent high level visits have imparted a new momentum to India-Guinea bilateral ties. He expressed confidence that Dr. Ibrahima's visit will mark yet another high point.

Rear Admiral Krishna Swaminathan assumes charge

New Delhi, Mar. 18
Rear Admiral Krishna Swaminathan, VSM, has assumed charge as Flag Officer Sea Training (FOST) at Kochi on 18 Mar 19. Rear Admiral Swaminathan, a specialist in Communication and Electronic Warfare was commissioned into the Indian Navy on 01 Jul 87, and is an alumnus of the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla at



Pune; the Joint Services Command and Staff College, Shrivenham in the United Kingdom; the

College of Naval Warfare, Karanja at Mumbai, and the United States Naval War College, Newport, Rhode Island, USA. He has commanded five frontline ships of the Indian Navy including the missile vessels, INS Vidyut and INS Vinash; the missile corvette, INS Kulish; the guided missile destroyer, INS Mysore; and the aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya.

India to provide aid to Mozambique

New Delhi, Mar. 18
India has decided to divert three Indian naval ships to the port city of Beira in Mozambique to provide humanitarian assistance to the people affected by tropical cyclone 'IDAI'. External Affairs Ministry in a release said the ships will provide relief materials in the form of food, clothes and medicines. Three medical practitioners and five nurses will provide immediate medical help. In 2017, India had provided 10 million dollars to Mozambique for food grains after the country suffered food shortage due to natural calamities.

Awareness workshop on implementation of MCC held Depts. urged to ensure availability of AMF in polling stations

Port Blair, Mar. 18

A workshop was conducted by Election Department of the A & N Administration to create awareness among the Govt. employees about the implementation of Model Code of Conduct (MCC) and functioning, usage and advantage of polling through Electronic Voting Machine (EVM)/ Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT). Shri K R Meena, Chief Electoral Officer, A & N Islands in his opening remark informed the Head of Departments (HoDs) of all Central/State Government, that EVM/VVPAT, which are used by the Election Commission, are not only user friendly but also reliable, credible and authentic machines, which provide ease, comfort and accurate



voting by the electors. It was emphasized that the EVMs/VVPATs are manufactured by the two reputed Central Govt. undertakings and the software of EVM/VVPAT are scrutinised by the independent Technical Expert Committee before handing over the machines to States/UTs for election.

The EVM work as a standalone machine not connected with any network. The machines operate with one time programmable chip, which is neither computer control nor connected to internet. Moreover, the programme used in the EVM is one time programmable chip, which cannot be altered or

tampered with. It was also informed that there are several administrative safeguards which make its operation fair and transparent. The EVMs are closely monitored by political parties and their representatives during the First Level Checking,

Irfan KT becomes first Indian from athletics to qualify for Tokyo Olympics

New Delhi, Mar 18
National record holder Irfan KT on Sunday became the first Indian from athletics to qualify for the next year's Olympics while finishing fourth in the 20 km event of the Asian Race Walking Championships in Nomi, Japan. The 29-year-old Irfan clocked 1 hour 20 minutes and 57 seconds to better the Tokyo Olympics qualification standard of 1 hour 21 minutes. The Olympics qualification period for race walk events and marathon race has begun from January 1 this year and will run till May 31, 2020. The Olympics qualification period for all other athletics events will start from May 1 this year and will run till June 29, 2020.



No other Indian from athletics has so far qualified for Tokyo Olympics. Irfan, who has a personal best as well as national record of 1:20:21 which he did during his 10th place finish in 2012 Olympics, also qualified for this year's World Championships (September 27-October 6) in Doha, Qatar as he bettered the qualifying mark of 1:22:30. The Kerala race walker had won the 20 km event in the National Open Race Walk Championships in Chennai last month with a time of 1:26:18.

Tennis: Prajnesh rises to career-high ranking of 84

New Delhi, Mar 18
The breakthrough run at the Indian Wells has propelled India's Prajnesh Gunneswaran to career-high rank of 84 but injured Yuki Hombri on Monday dropped out of top-200 for the first time in almost two years. In the recently released ATP rankings, Prajnesh had collected 61 points after reaching the third round at the ATP Master series event, where he beat world number 18 Nikoloz Basilashvili to register the biggest win of his career. The performance helped him



zoom 13 places to his new career-best ranking. He was followed by Ramkumar Ramanathan (139), who dropped three places. Both of them will try to qualify for the singles main draw of the Miami Masters this week. Yuki, who is nursing a knee injury, slid 36 places to 207. The last time the Delhi player was placed outside the top-200 bracket was in July 2017.

ICC ODI rankings: Kohli, Bumrah retain top spots despite series defeat to Australia

New Delhi, Mar 18
India skipper Virat Kohli and pacer Jasprit Bumrah have retained their top positions in the batsmen and bowlers' list of the latest ICC ODI rankings issued Sunday. Kohli remained at number one spot after scoring 310 in the recently-concluded home series against Australia while his deputy Rohit Sharma hit 202 runs to maintain the No.2 spot in the batting chart. Kedar Jadhav's all-round effort has helped him move up 11 places to a career-best 24th after the five-match series, which India lost 2-3. Meanwhile, South Africa opener Quinton de Kock has grabbed fourth position among batsmen after playing a huge part in his team's 5-0 victory



over Sri Lanka in a home series that ended in Cape Town on Saturday. The 26-year-old left-handed wicketkeeper-batsman's 353 runs in the series, which included a century and three half-centuries, has helped him win the player of the series award and gain four slots in the rankings. New Zealand's Ross Taylor has maintained the number three spot. In the bowlers list, Bumrah is sitting at the top with 774 points. Among others, New Zealand fast bowler Trent Boult has moved up a place to second after finishing with six wickets against Bangladesh, pushing Afghanistan's Rashid Khan to No.3, while South Africa leg-spinner Imran Tahir has gained seven slots to reach fourth place after taking nine wickets against Sri Lanka.

ADVISORY

The festival of Holi (Dhulendi) will be celebrated on 21st March, 2019 (Thursday). Traffic Police has made elaborate traffic arrangements to ensure safety of motorists on roads and check the incidents of drunken driving, speeding, reckless driving, zig-zag driving, red light jumping, triple riding, minor driving, driving/riding without helmet, performing stunts on two wheelers and other traffic violations. Special checking teams with alcometers will be deployed at major intersections and vulnerable points to detect and prosecute traffic violators. Special traffic police teams alongwith PCR and Local Police teams will be stationed on various roads and strategic locations/intersections all over Port Blair city to check drunken driving, red light jumping and other traffic violations.

As per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety in cases of drunken driving, red light jumping, using mobile phone while driving, dangerous driving and over speeding, driving licence will be seized and liable for suspension for a period of minimum 3 Months. Action shall also be initiated against the registered owners of vehicles whose vehicles are found to be driven by minor/ unauthorized persons, performing stunts, driving without license etc. Therefore motorists are advised to obey traffic rules, specifically the following:

- 1) Not to drink & drive.
- 2) Observe prescribed speed limits.
- 3) Obey Traffic Rules.
- 4) Not to indulge in racing or competition with other vehicles.
- 5) Especially two wheeler drivers/ riders to wear helmets and avoid triple riding.
- 6) Not to indulge in reckless, dangerous or zig-zag driving.
- 7) Not to allow minor/ unauthorized persons to drive your vehicle.
- 8) Not to indulge in performing stunts on two wheelers.

Traffic Police appeals to all motorists to avoid traffic violations especially drunken driving. Parents should not allow minors to drive vehicle. All motorists are advised to obey traffic rules and regulations and follow the directions of the traffic policemen on duty for their safety and of other road users.

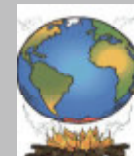
