New Delhi, Jun 15
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said Digital India initiative is creating a group of village level entrepreneurs. He said it is important for citizens to be digitally literate. Shri Modi said in last 4 years, NDA government has worked on all aspects of Digital India. He said government launched this programme with a very simple focus to ensure that more people can benefit from the joys of technology, especially in rural areas.

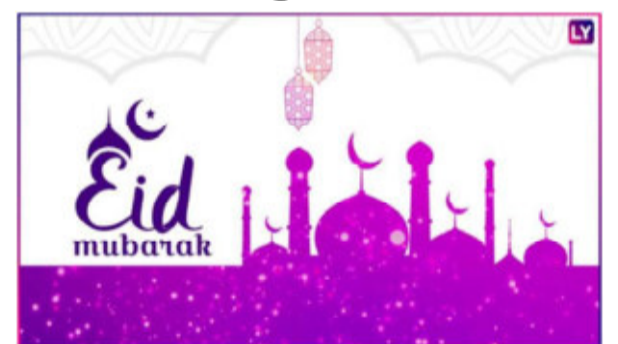

India Vs Afghanistan

India crush visitors by innings and 262 runs

Bengaluru, June 15
Afghanistan's dreams of scripting a fairytale turned into a virtual nightmare as a ruthlessly professional India demolished them by an innings and 262 runs inside two days to win the historic one-off Test match here. Afghanistan came across painfully short of experience for the longest format and was bowled out for 109 and 103 in pursuit of India's first innings total of 474 all out on Friday. This was the first time that India won a Test match in two days while it has now happened for the 21st time in the 141-year-history of the traditional format. India, however, did become the first team to claim 20 wickets in a day. Afghans, who have some impressive accomplishments in the shortest format lasted a total of 66.3 overs (27.5 overs and 38.4 overs), posing serious questions over their readiness to cope up with demands of five-day cricket. The gulf in class was a reality but the Test match exposed their inability to understand the needs of the longest format. Their performance lends support to the demands for a two-tier Test format, which could



get them battle-ready for future series. With an average first-class experience of fewer than 15 matches, Test cricket wouldn't have been easy for Afghans but if a robust first-class structure isn't put in place, ICC's novel idea may just backfire. The giants of world cricket were supposed to be infinitely superior but what lacked in the visitors was will to fight it out.

Yuki surprised at TOPS exclusion, AITA backs top singles player

New Delhi, June 15
Yuki Bhambhani is aghast at being excluded from the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS) after preferring the US Open over Asian Games even as a red-faced All India Tennis Association (AITA) said it is trying to convince the Sports Ministry to reconsider its decision. AITA had exempted the country's top singles player considering that playing at the Grand Slams is crucial to

secure ranking points, which would earn the Delhi player a direct entry into the Tokyo Olympics. "We have asked the government to reconsider the decision and include both Yuki and Leander Paes in TOPS. We told them that Yuki needs to be in top-64 to earn direct qualification for Tokyo Olympics and that's why playing at the US Open is important," AITA secretary Hironmoy Chatterjee said.

Smriti Mandhana set to become first Indian to play in Kia Super League

New Delhi, June 15
Indian women's cricket team opener, Smriti Mandhana, will become the first player from her country to appear in England's Kia Super T20 League beginning July 22. Smriti was signed by Western Storm ahead of the upcoming edition that features six teams. The 21-year-old has scored over 826 runs with a highest score of 76 in the 40 T20 Internationals she has played so far. Mandhana has also played for Brisbane Heat in the Women's Big Bash League in Australia. Last month, she captained the IPL Trailblazers in the one-off exhibition game organised by



the BCCI. "We are really excited that Smriti will be joining us. She is one of the brightest young talents in the game at the moment. Although she is still young, she has a great deal of experience of the game at the highest level and we believe that she will prove to be an excellent signing," said Western Storm coach Trevor Griffin. Looking forward to the new challenge, Mandhana said, "To be the first Indian player to appear in the tournament is a real honour and I hope that I can help Western Storm to more success."

Top-ranked Dustin Johnson grabs share of US Open golf lead, Shubhankar Sharma tied 37th

Washington, June 15
World number one Dustin Johnson seized a share of the lead with nine holes remaining in his opening round at the US Open golf championship. On a day when strong winds blowing off Long Island Sound made Shinnecock Hills a test of survival, Johnson was two-under through nine holes, tied with fellow American Russell Henley, who was two-under through 12. India's Shubhankar Sharma carded a 4-over 74 and was tied 37th. England's Ian Poulter and American Scott Piercy were in the clubhouse on one-under 69 on a day that saw a bevy of stars struggle



and few players drop below par even briefly. Four-time major winner Rory McIlroy matched his highest major round score with a 10-over 80. Three-time major winner Jordan Spieth signed for a 78 and five-time major winner Phil Mickelson posted a 77. Tiger Woods, playing the US Open for the first time since 2015, got off to a disastrous start with a triple-bogey at the par-four first. Woods's approach from the fairway rolled through the green and down into a collection area. His chip was short and rolled back down, his next attempt also failing to stay on the putting surface.

Javagal Srinath, Sundaram Ravi retained in ICC elite panel of match officials

Dubai, June 15
Javagal Srinath was the lone Indian to feature in the match referees' list, while Sundaram Ravi continued to be the country's representative among the top umpires as the ICC on Thursday announced an unchanged list of elite match officials in Dubai. The retention of the panel, for the period July 1 to June 30, 2019, was done following the annual review and selection process, the ICC said in a statement. The ICC Umpires Selection Panel consisted of Chairman and ICC General Manager - Cricket, Geoff Allardice, ICC Chief Match Referee Ranjan Madugalle,

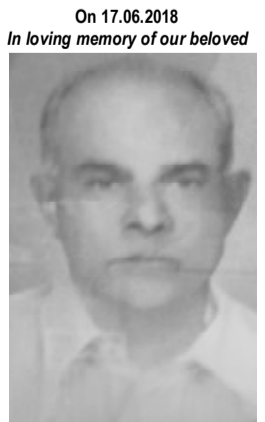
