

PM Modi calls for widespread debate on holding simultaneous elections

New Delhi, Jun 18 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has called for widespread debate and consultations on simultaneous elections for Parliament and State Assemblies. Addressing the fourth meeting of NITI Aayog's Governing Council in New Delhi yesterday, Shri Modi flagged the issue of simultaneous elections at the central and the state



level, citing its multiple benefits. Briefing reporters after the meeting, NITI

Aayog Vice-Chairman Shri Rajiv Kumar said, Prime Minister noted that the

country remains in perpetual election mode and suggested that there could be one uniform voter list for all elections. NITI Aayog had last year suggested synchronised, two-phase Lok Sabha and assembly polls from 2024 so as to ensure minimum 'campaign-mode' disruption to governance. Elections Commission and Law Commission are examining the issue.

Lt. Governor attends meeting of Governing Council of NITI Aayog

Port Blair, Jun 18 The fourth meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog was held under the chairmanship of the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi at Rashtrapati Bhavan yesterday. It was attended by 23 Chief Ministers and the Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, apart from Union Ministers, who are ex-officio members and special invitees. While speaking during this meeting, the Lt. Governor of A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), thanked NITI Aayog for supporting



A&N Islands across wide range of activities and providing constant support for the capacity building of the A&N Islands. Progress of several ongoing works as well as other issues related to development of the Islands were also discussed during this meeting.

Funds collected under GST anti-profiteering rules to be split between Centre, State

New Delhi, Jun 18 The Centre and the 'concerned state' will equally share the amount deposited by erring businesses in the consumer welfare fund set up as part of the GST anti-profiteering rules, as per a Finance Ministry notification. The Government set up a national anti-profiteering authority to penalise businesses for failure to pass on tax benefits to consumers. In case the customer is not identifiable, the penal

amount has to be deposited in the consumer welfare fund. The Finance Ministry has amended the Central GST rules stating that 50 per cent of the penal amount is to be deposited in the consumer welfare fund constituted by the Centre and the remaining to the fund set up by the 'concerned state'. The 'concerned state' would mean the state where the anti-profiteering authority has passed its order against the business.

Port Blair, June 18 The Ministry of Micro, small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has notified public procurement policy of MSEs order, 2012 which mandates 20% of the total annual procurement from MSEs including 4% from SC/ST entrepreneurs by all the Central Ministries/ Department and CPSEs. The policy has come into force w.e.f from April 1st, 2012 and has become mandatory w.e.f April 1, 2015. Public procurement policy has been circulated to all Ministries/ Departments and CPSEs for compliance. The State Government has also been requested to consider adopting the policy or frame



similar policy for procurement of goods and service to provide market access support to the MSEs. The Ministry of MSME has signed a MoU with the Government (GeM) and common service Centre (CSC) to provide hand holding support to the MSEs in registering with the Gem portal and benefitting through it. GeM is the one stop e-marketplace for the

procurement of all common goods and services for Government Ministries, Departments, PSUs and other organizations at Central and State level. North, South Korea agree to joint sports events

Seoul, June 18
The two Koreas agreed on Monday to march together under a unified peninsula flag and form combined teams to compete in the next Asian Games, they said in a joint statement, in the latest sign of a thaw between the old rivals. Both sides also agreed at a round of talks on their heavily fortified border to hold a basketball match in the North Korean capital of Pyongyang on July 4, marking the anniversary of an inter-Korean agreement on unification, they said. The agreement comes amid a

range of talks as part of efforts to promote reconciliation, including opening military hotlines and arranging reunions for families of Koreans divided by the 1950-53 Korean War. The athletes from the two sides will march together under a unified peninsula flag and the country name "Korea" during the opening and closing ceremony of the Asian Games, as they did in the Winter Olympics in South Korea in February. The next Asian Games will be held in Indonesia from mid-August to early September. They agreed to create

combined teams for the upcoming games and for other international competitions, and will hold more discussions to work out details. The basketball friendly will take place in Pyongyang next month and another match will be held in Seoul later in the year, they said in the statement. "We agreed to promote sports cooperation and exchanges including joint training and matches," they said. North Korean leader Kim Jong Un met U.S. President Donald Trump for the first ever summit between the two countries, in Singapore last week.

Sports Minister sanctions financial assistance to former International Archer Limba Ram

New Delhi, Jun 18
Minister of State for Youth Affairs and Sports, Colonel Rajyavardhan Rathore today sanctioned a special financial assistance of 5 lakh rupees to former International Archer and Arjuna Awardee Limba Ram. Limba Ram, who is suffering from neurological illness is

undergoing a treatment at Jaipur. He is working for the State Government of Rajasthan and is in receipt of salary beyond the ceiling of 4 lakh rupees fixed under the scheme of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay National Welfare Fund for Sports persons. Col Rathore has relaxed the condition and by

invoking the discretionary clause sanctioned 5 Lakhs rupees considering that his whole family is dependent on him. Earlier, the Minister had deputed a team of officers to visit and enquire on Limba Ram's admission in a hospital. The sanctioned amount is based on the report of this team.

Australia slump to lowest ODI ranking in 34 years

Dubai, June 18
A year before the ICC 2019 World Cup begins, defending champions Australia have slumped to their lowest ODI ranking in 34 years. The last time Australia were placed at the sixth position was in 1984. Pakistan have replaced them in the fifth spot. England, India, South Africa and New Zealand form the top four spots. Australia are currently playing against England in a five-match ODI series wherein they have already suffered two successive defeats in the first two encounters. As a result, Australia have now 102 rating points. Since the summer of 2016-17, the Kangaroos have

lost 13 out of their 15 ODIs. In their last 10 matches, they have managed to win just two. In the second ODI at Cardiff, the Aussies were chasing a daunting target of 343. Shaun Marsh's performed brilliantly with the bats scoring a magnificent 131 but it wasn't enough to prevent a defeat. Latest ICC one-day international rankings: England- 124 points, India- 122 , South Africa- 113 , New Zealand- 112, Pakistan- 102, Australia- 102, Bangladesh- 93, Sri Lanka- 77, West Indies- 69, Afghanistan- 63, Zimbabwe- 55, Ireland- 38, Scotland- 33, United Arab Emirates-18.

India A begin UK tour with big win over ECB XI

New Delhi, June 18
India A began their UK tour on a promising note, thrashing England Cricket Board XI by 125 runs following half-centuries from captain Shreyas Iyer, Prithvi Shaw and Ishan Kishan. The trio of Shaw (70 off 61), Iyer (54 off 45) and Kishan (50 off 46) helped India A amass 328 for eight before the bowlers dismissed ECB XI for 203 in 36.5 overs. Pacer Deepak Chahar (3/48) was the pick of the bowlers. This was the visitors' first game of the tour ahead of the 50-over tri-series, involving England Lions and West Indies, from

June 22.
India A will also play two unofficial Tests against West Indies A and one against England Lions in July. In the game played Sunday, India A batsmen spent substantial time in the middle after ECB XI opted to bowl. Mayank Agarwal (4) departed cheaply but his opening partner Shaw was in good touch, collecting seven fours and three sixes. Iyer and Kishan then shared a 99-run stand before medium pacer Ryan Higgins removed them off successive balls in the 39th over. Kishan, who was a last-minute

replacement to Sanju Samson, pounced on the opportunity with a fine innings comprising four fours and two sixes. Samson was forced out of the squad after he failed the fitness test. Krunal Pandya (34 off 28) and Axar Patel (28*) came up with the big hits in the death overs, pushing India A beyond 300. ECB XI's challenged fizzled out after Ben Slater (37 off 38) and Will Jacks (28 off 28) departed in quick succession, leaving the home team at 107 for four in 17 overs. Brief scores: Ind A 328/ in 50 overs (Shaw 70, Iyer 54, Kishan 50; Chahar 3/48, Axar Patel 2/21).

Sanjay Takale finishes 2nd in Thailand Rally

New Delhi, June 18
Sanjay Takale overcame a wrong selection of tyres to finish a creditable second in the 4x4 Open class in round 1 of the Thailand Pre-Rally Championship in Nakhon Ratchasima Province, bordering Cambodia. Takale had come with hard-knobbed tyres, suited for muddy terrains, but had soft gravel roads to contend with. However, he managed to keep his Isuzu DMax utility vehicle under control despite struggling for grip. The Pune rally driver drove for Delo Sport with



experienced Thanayaphat Meenil as his navigator. "Choice of tyre made us pay early. Even though I struggled to find grip with hard and knobbed tyres, sometimes no grip on soft gravel terrain, we managed to put up a great show to finish second overall," said Takale.




