## India elected as non-permanent member of UNSC PM, HM thank global community & member countries for overwhelming support

New York, June 18

India was elected as a non-permanent member of the UN Security Council for a two-year term after winning 184 votes in the 193-member General Assembly. Along with India, Ireland, Mexico and Norway also won the Security Council elections held last night.

India was a candidate for a non-permanent seat from the Asia-Pacific category for the 2021-22 term. Its victory was certain as it was the sole candidate vying for the lone seat from the grouping. New Delhi's candidature was unanimously endorsed by the 55-member Asia-Pacific grouping in June last year.

India's two-year term will begin on January 1, 2021. This is the eighth time that India will sit at the



UN high-table, which comprises five permanent members and 10 non-permanent members.

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has thanked the global community and member countries of the United Nations for their overwhelming support for India's membership in the UN Security Council. In a tweet, he affirmed that India will work with all member countries to promote global peace,

## Towards clean & green energy LNG based 50 MW Power Plant to be set up at Hope Town

Tender to be floated shortly

Port Blair, June 18

To help preserve the nature and pristine beauty of Andaman & Nicobar Islands while meeting the base load requirements of the Islands, the UT Administration with the support of Govt. of India has decided to setup a LNG based 50 MW Power Plant at Hope Town to meet the base power demand of South Andaman Island. Whilst setting up of this project will go a long way in mitigating the power requirement in the Islands, it will also help promote clean energy consumption.

It may be



recalled that the Hon'ble Minister of State (IC) for Power and New & Renewable Energy has entrusted the responsibility of setting up of this power plant to NTPC, a Mahanavratna Company under the aegis of the Ministry of Power. Accordingly, a Power Purchase Agreement was signed between A & N Administration and NTPC on 26.10.2018. The foundation stone was laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 30th December, 2018.

In this regard, the Ministry of Power has also exempted under Section 62 of Electricity Act, 2003 for selecting NTPC on nomination basis and a major hurdle was removed when the proposed site was declared as Port area by Ministry of Shipping based on the request of A&N Administration. The Central Electricity Authority has also given no objection to NTPC for single fuel engine for this LNG power plant.

## Court again vindicates the stand of UT Administration in COVID Management

Port Blair, June 18

In a major decision dated 18.06.2020 of the Double Bench of High Court at Calcutta comprising Chief Justice Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan and Justice Arijit Banerjee in a petition challenging the efforts of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration to manage the COVID-19 pandemic, the Hon'ble High Court vindicated the efforts of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration to manage and implement the COVID related measures in containing the spread of COVID-19.

While acknowledging that the Central Government guidelines regarding the quarantining of passengers arriving in the islands issued by the Home Ministry have been framed and the same are being scrupulously followed by UT Administration, the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta observed that "we see no reason to keep the interlocutory application pending. CAN 3149 of 2020 is accordingly disposed of."

The Hon'ble Court was apprised that the Administration is providing various interventions to prevent spread of virus, as per the risk assessment of the suspect cases and the guidelines of Govt. of India.

Accordingly, various protocols are implemented for testing and quarantining of the passengers coming to the islands by ship, by air, as well as for the persons traveling from one district to other districts within the islands.

Earlier in the above matter, the Hon'ble High Court on 1st April, 2020 and 8th April, 2020 had appreciated the efforts in containing the spread of COVID-19, as well as maintenance of supplies of essential commodities. Later on 15.05.2020, the Hon'ble Court has commended the multipronged efforts made by the Andaman and Nicobar Administration to control the crisis caused by the outbreak of the COVID-19 and was fully satisfied with series of action taken by the Administration.

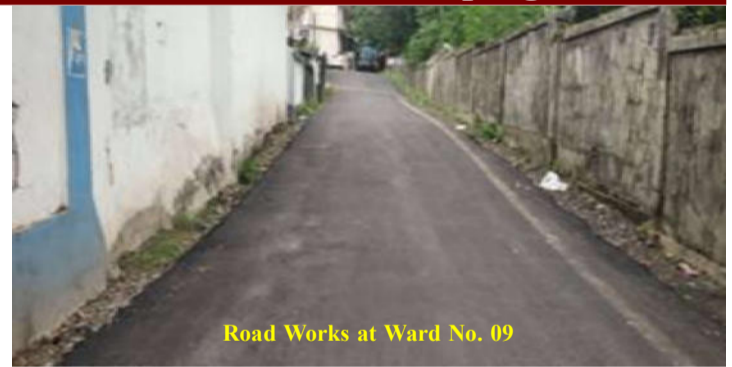
In an earlier judgement also, the Calcutta High Court in Writ Petition No. 5327(W) of 2020 on 21st April, 2020 had appreciated efforts of preventing contagion of COVID-19 in Children Protection Homes in the islands and directed that the procedure followed by the Child Care Institutions in Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall be replicated at all such Homes in West Bengal, an official press release from A&N Administration said here today.

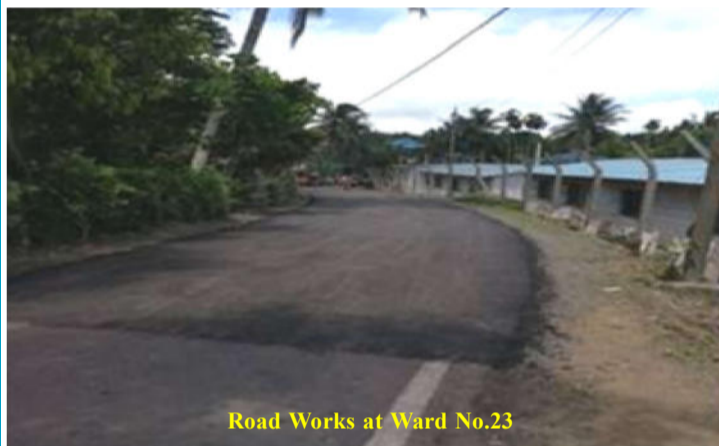
**LNG based 50 MW Power Plant to be set up at Hope Town...**

NTPC has annulled the tender for dual fuel engine (Diesel & LNG) and are under process for finalization of tender specifications for single fuel (LNG). The tender for the power plant shall be floated shortly.

The clean fuel sourced through the Floating Storage Regasification Unit (FSRU) will help generate 50 mega watt (MW) of electricity at Hope Town, South Andaman, enough to power the Islands for next 25 Years and replace the current diesel fueled costly power generation.

LNG being a clean source of energy will result in reduced carbon emissions and will be a way forward towards making this Island diesel free. It will not only reduce the carbon footprint by ending the practice of diesel-based power generation, but the improved infrastructure will also enable the UT Administration to implement the plans of Govt. of India to De-dieselization in these Islands. This plant will be commissioned within 24 months from the date of award of work to the successful bidder by NTPC, a press release from Secretary (Power), A&N Administration said here today.
