

PM SVANidhi app launched to provide micro-credit facility for street vendors at their door steps

New Delhi, July 18

A mobile application of PM Street Vendor's Aatma Nirbhar Nidhi, PM SVANidhi was launched in New Delhi to bring micro-credit facility for street vendors at their door steps. Secretary of Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry, Shri Durga Shanker Mishra said, PM SVANidhi Mobile App aims to provide user-friendly digital interface for lending institutions and their field functionaries for sourcing and processing loan applications of street vendors under the



scheme. He said, the app is a step towards boosting the use of digital technology and will enable field functionaries to ensure maximum coverage of the scheme. The Ministry said, that the launch of Mobile App will give impetus to the implementation strategy of the scheme

besides promoting paper-less digital accessing of micro-credit facilities by the street vendors. The app can be downloaded from the Google Play Store for use by the lending institutions and their field functionaries. It said, since the commencement of PM SVANidhi was

UNDP report states that more than 27 crore people in India came out of poverty in last 10 yrs.

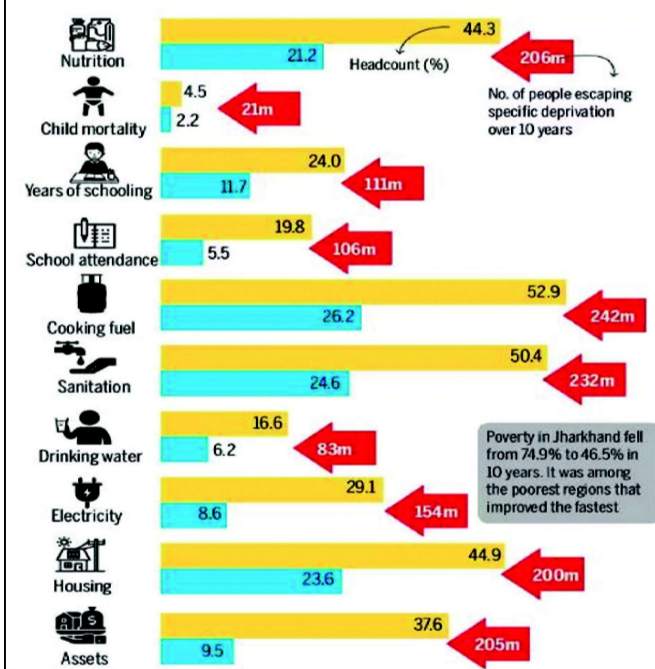
New Delhi, July 18

Union Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Prakash Javadekar shared the details of a United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) report which states that more than 27 crore people in the country have come out of poverty in the last 10 years.

Shri Javadekar termed the achievement as a big positive development. India recorded the world's largest reduction in multidimensional poverty between 2005-06 and 2015-16, according to the latest UN report. According to the data, released by the UNDP and the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative 65 out of 75 countries studied, reported significant decline in their multidimensional poverty levels. The report shows that India has improved quite significantly in the use of cooking fuel and sanitation. Other deprivations that also saw big improvements were housing, asset ownership and nutrition.



IITs decide to do away with 75% marks criteria for admission this year

New Delhi, July 18

Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) will do away with admission criterion of minimum 75 percent marks in class 12 this year. During a meeting, Joint Admission Board of the IITs decided that all qualified candidates who have passed class XII examination will now be eligible for admissions in IITs this year irrespective of marks obtained.



Human Resource Development Minister, Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank said the decision has been taken in view of partial cancellation of class 12 exams by several boards. For admissions to IITs, apart from qualifying the JEE (Advanced), the eligibility was to secure either minimum score of 75 percent marks in class 12 Board exams or rank among the top 20 percentile in their respective class 12 board examination. India's foreign exchange reserves have swelled by 3.108 billion dollars to reach a fresh all-time high of 516.362 billion dollars in the week ended 10th July, 2020. Foreign currency assets, a major part of the overall reserves, rose by 2.372 billion dollars to 475.635 billion dollars.

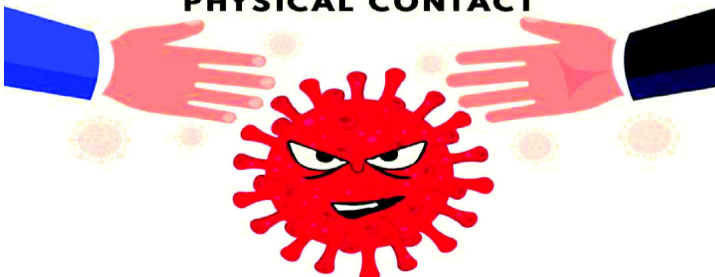

launched by the Government on 1st of June this year, for providing affordable working capital loan to street vendors to resume their livelihoods that have been adversely affected due to COVID-19 lockdown. This scheme targets to benefit over 50 lakh street vendors who had been vending on or before 24th of March, 2020, in urban areas. Under the scheme, the vendors can avail a working capital loan of up to ten thousand rupees, which is repayable in monthly installments in the tenure of one year. There will be no penalty on early repayment of loan. The scheme promotes digital transactions through cash back incentives up to an amount of 100 rupees per month. (Source:india.gov.in)

voluntary compliance, tax accountability and ease of e-filing of returns so that the same can be used by the taxpayer to file her or his income tax return (ITR) by calculating the correct tax liability in a feel-good environment. This would also bring in further transparency and accountability in the tax administration.

The earlier Form 26AS used to give information regarding tax deducted at source and tax collected at source relating to a PAN, besides certain additional information including details of other taxes paid, refunds and TDS defaults. But now, it will have SFTs to help the taxpayers recall all their major financial transactions so that they have a ready reckoner to enable them while filing the ITR.

It is further explained that the Department used to receive information like cash deposit/withdrawal from saving bank accounts, sale/purchase of immovable property, time deposits, credit card payments, purchase of shares, debentures, foreign currency, mutual funds, buy back of shares, cash payment for goods and services, etc. under Section 285BA of Income-tax Act, 1961 from "specified persons" like banks, mutual funds, institutions issuing bonds and registrars or sub-registrars etc., with regard to individuals having high-value financial transactions since the Financial Year 2016 onwards. Now, all such information under different SFTs will be shown in the new Form 26AS.
