CBI seals PNB's Brady House branch

The agency posted an official notice outside the branch, which is the bank's second largest national outlet.

CBI files case against Rotomac pens owner

New Delhi, Feb 19
CBI has filed a case against Rotomac pens owner Vikram Kothari and others following allegations of default on repayment of loans worth over 800 crore rupees borrowed from different banks. The Kanpur-based company's owner had taken loans from Allahabad Bank, Bank of Baroda, Indian Overseas Bank and Union Bank of India which have been reportedly put under Non-Performing Asset by these banks.

India is hot-spot of digital innovation across all sectors: PM

Mysuru, Feb 19
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said, India is the hot-spot of digital innovation across all sectors. Inaugurating the World Congress on Information Technology at Hyderabad through video-conferencing from Mysuru, Shri Modi said, India not only possesses a growing number of innovative entrepreneurs, but it also has a growing market for tech innovation.

He said, Digital India has not remained merely a government initiative but has become a way of life. The Prime Minister asserted that while most of the initiatives depend on a government push, Digital India is succeeding because of the people's pull.

He said Digital India is a journey bringing about digital inclusion for digital



empowerment aided by the digital infrastructure for digital delivery of services. Shri Modi said, leveraging technology in such a holistic manner was unthinkable some years ago and now the government has successfully completed this life-cycle in the last 3 and a half years. Over 2,000 delegates including heads of IT majors, visionaries, Government leaders and academia from 30 countries are taking part in the

Congress being held in India for the first time. The event is being organised by the World Information Technology and Services Alliance, while the National Alliance of Software and Services Companies and the Telangana State are jointly hosting the event.

Shri Modi also said, the concept of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' - the world is one family, is deeply imbibed in Indian philosophy which reflects the country's inclusive traditions. He said, in the 21st century, technology is becoming an enabler for this concept.

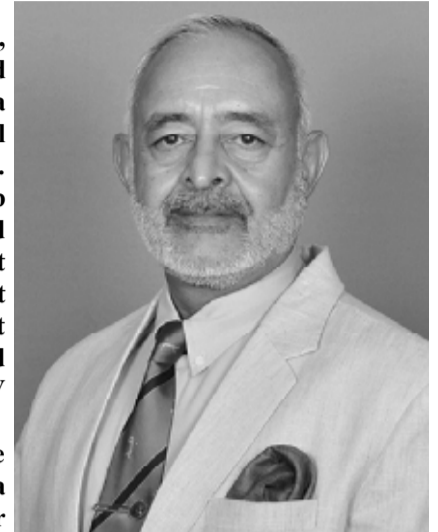
Lt. Governor to visit Neil & Havelock Islands

India to play around 30 ODIs in 2018-19 season

New Delhi, Feb 19
With an eye on next year's ICC World Cup, the Indian cricket team will play around 30 ODIs in an estimated 63 international games across formats, scheduled for the 2018-19 season. India will also play 12 Tests during the upcoming season along with 21 T20s. India's ongoing season (2017-18) will come to an end with the Nidahas Tri-Nation T20 tournament in Sri Lanka (Bangladesh, being the third team). While the cricket calendar starts in April with the Indian Premier League, the national team will start its campaign in June with a short two-match T20 series against Ireland. In the same month, India will host Afghanistan at Bengaluru for the historic one-off Test. The tour of England will start in July and end early-September where India will

play five Tests, three ODIs and three T20s. There is a window for the Asia Cup (50 overs) but the date and the venue is yet to be finalised. The tournament will have around nine ODIs. India's home season will be a short one with the West Indies coming in for two Tests, five ODIs and three T20s during October and November. India will then fly to Australia to play four Tests, three T20s and three ODIs in November and December. The BCCI has taken a policy decision of not playing Tests in New Zealand as a 3.30 a.m. IST start is not commercially viable for the Board. The New Zealand tour, from mid-January to mid-February, will have five ODIs and five T20s. In the second half of February, Australia will arrive in India for a limited-overs series — five ODIs and two T20.

The curtains will be drawn on the 2018-19 season with Zimbabwe visiting to play a three-match T20 series. India's 2018-19 season itinerary (estimated international matches: 63): June 2018: vs Ireland (Two T20s, away); June 2018: vs Afghanistan (one Test, home); July-Sept. 2018: vs England (five Tests, three ODIs, three T20s, away); Sept. 2018: Asia Cup (approx nine ODIs, date and venue yet to be finalised); Oct.-Nov. 2018: vs West Indies (two Tests, five ODIs, three T20s, home); Nov.-Dec. 2018: vs Australia (four Tests, three ODIs, three T20s, away). Jan.-Feb. 2019: vs New Zealand (five ODIs, five T20s, away); Feb.-March 2019: vs Australia (five ODIs, two T20s, home); March 2019: vs Zimbabwe (3 T20s, home).

Bhuvneshwar Kumar first Indian pacer to take five-fors in all formats

New Delhi, Feb 19
By bagging his maiden five-wicket haul in T20s during the first match of the series against South Africa on Sunday, Bhuvneshwar Kumar became the first Indian fast bowler to bag a five-wicket haul in each format of the game.



India scored 203/5 batting first and then restricted the hosts to 175/9, thanks to Bhuvneshwar's 5/24, for a 28-run win to take 1-0 lead in the three-match series.

His best bowling figures in Tests read 6/82 and in ODIs 5/42.

The last over of Bhuvneshwar's spell, which was the 18th of SA innings, saw him take three of his five wickets; however, he missed out on a hat-trick. In all, India claimed four wickets in those six balls, including the run-out of Dane Paterson (1) off the last.

Hendricks became Bhuvneshwar's first wicket in the over, after which he removed Heinrich Klaasen (16) and Chris Morris (0) as well to put an end to SA hopes. In his opening spell, Bhuvneshwar claimed the wickets of opener JJ Smuts (14) and captain JP

Duminy (3). Asked about his five-wicket haul, he said: "Taking wickets means a lot to me when you play for your country. It doesn't matter if you take five wickets or how many as long as you're winning matches for your country. That's what matters and taking fivers (five-wicket hauls) in every format feels good. I want to do it as long as possible." Bhuvni said batting first on the Wanderers pitch gave them ample idea about the nature of the wicket and it helped when they returned to defend their total. "After we batted, we had a certain idea of the kind of wicket we would be bowling on after

what we saw. But the whole picture begins to emerge only after you've bowled because it depends on the bowlers," he said. "What I was trying to do is bring about change of pace in my bowling. I just wanted to take the pace off the ball because I knew it won't be easy to hit the ball and that's what I did. The important thing is how you mix your deliveries according to the wicket."

Indonesia's Mount Sinabung spews massive smoke-and-ash column

Jakarta, Feb 19
An Indonesian volcano erupted today, sending a massive column of ash and smoke some 16,400 feet into the air, leaving local villages coated in debris and officials scrambling to hand out face masks to residents. Mount Sinabung on Sumatra island, which has been rumbling since 2010 and saw a deadly eruption in 2016, spewed the thick plume after activity picked up recent days.

Volcanology agency chief Kasbani said this was the biggest eruption for Sinabung this year. There were no reports of injuries or deaths. No one lives inside a previously announced no-go zone around the volcano. But hundreds of houses outside the seven-kilometre danger zone were covered in volcanic ash. Officials have distributed face masks and urged local residents to stay indoors to avoid respiratory problems.

best rank of 88 in November 2015.
