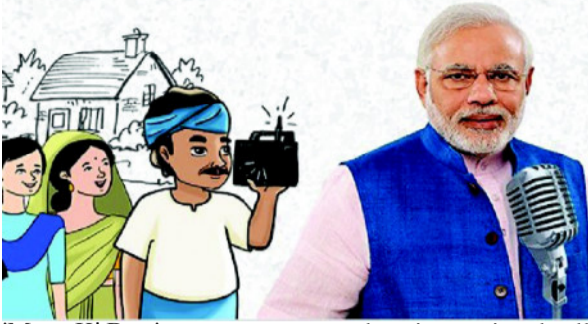


PM to share thoughts in 'Mann Ki Baat' on March 26

Centre initiates steps to implement the project of interlinking rivers in country

Faridabad, Mar 19
The Centre has initiated steps to implement the project of interlinking rivers in the country to make irrigation facilities available for unirrigated areas. Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh said this while inaugurating the 3-day Agri-Leadership Summit at Surajkund near Faridabad yesterday. He said, a 20,000 crore rupees fund has been created under NABARD to improve irrigation facilities and the Centre has set a target of bringing more than 76 lakh hectares of land under irrigation by 2019. Shri Singh also said, the Central Government has decided to connect all 585 wholesale mandis in the country with e-NAM project so that farmers could sell their produce at highest competitive prices in different mandis. The mandis will be connected with e-NAM by March next year.

DGCA asks airlines to disallow oversized hand baggages on flights



New Delhi, Mar 19
India's aviation regulator DGCA has asked airlines to disallow oversized hand baggages on flights operating to performance limited airports. Airports having runway length limitation and other aspects such as higher elevation and reduced air density are considered as "performance limited" aerodromes. DGCA has asked airlines to ensure that the size of hand baggage for overhead bins is restricted to approved dimensions. Carriers have also been asked to make sure that the number of passengers onboard do not exceed the certified passenger carrying capacity of the aircraft.

Deptt of AH&VS establishes poultry hatchery at Havelock

Port Blair, Mar 19
The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services had established a poultry hatchery at Havelock to cater to the requirement of day-old chicks of the poultry farmers of the Islands. The hatchery had a capacity of setting 2500 eggs with a Hatcher capacity of 840. The hatchery produced about 600 chicks including Backyard poultry, Turkey poultry, Guinea fowl and ducklings at weekly intervals. However, with the growing popularity of poultry farms in Havelock Island, the demand for availability of day-old chicks also increased and the issue was raised by PRI members. To meet the demand of day-old-chicks of poultry and alternate birds at Havelock Islands, the Department has established an additional incubator-cum-hatchery of 2500 capacity. With this the capacity of the Hatchery at Havelock has increased to 5000 which can produce 1200 to 1500 chicks per week. The unit has been made operational from the 8th March, 2017. This will address the long pending demand of the poultry farmers and encourage them to take up poultry farming as a sustainable venture in the Island.

5th Indo-Myanmar coordinated patrol concludes

Port Blair, Mar 19
Myanmar Navy Ship UMS King Kyan Sit Thar commanded by Cdr Moe Myint called at Port Blair on March 18 for the closing ceremony of the 5th Indo-Myanmar coordinated patrol, IMCOR, at the Andaman and Nicobar Command. The Myanmar delegation was led by Commodore Kyaw Shwe Tun, Commander of Panmawaddy Naval Region Command, who called on the CINCAN yesterday. Bilateral issues were also discussed during the meeting. The UMS King Kyan Sit Thar and UMS 563 of Myanmar Navy undertook a coordinated patrol with INS Karmuk and INS Bangaram commanded by Cdr Vikas Sood and Cdr Bikas Singh Nayal, respectively, from March 12-18. The ships patrolled the International



Maritime Boundary Line (IMBL) between the two countries and covered a distance of approximately 725 kms. They also carried out manoeuvres and various drills during the patrol. The initiative between the two navies is meant to address issues of terrorism, illegal fishing, drug trafficking, human trafficking, poaching and other illegal activities inimical to interest of both nations. Started in March 2013, the event has witnessed a close professional interaction between the two navies and serves to enhance the understanding between two navies.

Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has said that all devices using Aadhaar authentication will have to adhere to its new encryption standards from June 1. The move is aimed at adding another security layer to the hardware at a

time when such devices are all set to take the centre stage in biometric-based digital payments. "We have recently come out with new specifications and asked manufacturers and vendors to go for STQC certification as per the new standards. We have advised that from June 1, they should get devices on the new specifications and that the existing devices should be upgraded to the new norms," Shri Ajay Bhushan Pandey, CEO of UIDAI said. Ranchi Test: Jadeja puts India on top after Pujara-Saha record stand

Ranchi, Mar 19
India's marathon man Cheteshwar Pujara extended his extraordinary form this home season by striking a third career Test double century during the fourth day of the Ranchi Test. Pujara was involved in a marvellous rescuing act with another centurion, Wriddhiman Saha as the two put on 199 runs for the seventh wicket to virtually shut the door on Australia's chances of winning the Test. Pujara and Saha's outstanding effort ensured that India comfortably ascended into a 152-run before the innings was declared on 603/9. The final thrust was provided by none other than Ravindra Jadeja, who first scored an unbeaten 54 off 55 balls and then quickly snuffed out two wickets. India gave themselves eight overs to have a crack at the Australian batsmen in which the tourists scored 23 runs for the loss of David Warner and night watchman Nathan Lyon's wickets. During the knock, Pujara consumed the most number of balls by an Indian batsman in an innings, overtaking Rahul



Dravid's 495 deliveries during his 270 against Pakistan at Rawalpindi in 2004. Pujara also went past 1000 runs against Australia. Saha offered him wonderful support and scored a third and perhaps his most cherished Test hundred. For two consecutive sessions, Australia had nothing to show in the wickets column as both batsmen blunted their attack on a surface that was no threat for the batsmen, despite run scoring not being easy. This was the first time since 1994 that Australia were kept on the field for 200 overs or beyond (against South Africa). Four of the five bowlers conceded over 100 runs. Pujara was clinical in his approach. His footwork against Lyon and Steve O'Keefe was exemplary. His only moment of

nervousness came when he was given out leg-before off Lyon in the 155th over. With just five overs remaining before India got back their allotted reviews, Pujara went upstairs, and the ball once again turned just about enough to miss leg. Pat Cummins continued to impress and bowled his heart out. He bowled three overs full of bouncers for just five runs, enough to trouble the batsmen but just not enough to draw either into a false stroke. He then bowled well with the second new ball as well but remained devoid of a fifth wicket. O'Keefe was given a marathon spell, during which he mostly operated over the wicket and the batsmen were courteous enough to pad all those landing outside leg.

Bangladesh secure first win against Sri Lanka in 100th Test

Colombo, Mar 19
Bangladesh clinched a historic four-wicket win in their 100th Test match, also their first ever Test victory against Sri Lanka, to secure a series draw on Sunday. Needing 191 to win, the tourists reached their target losing six wickets in the final session. Tamim Iqbal top scored with 82, his 22nd Test half-century and shared 109 runs for the second wicket with Shabbir Rahman (41). Sri Lanka spinners hit back with four late wickets but it wasn't enough to prevent an upset win for Bangladesh. Sri Lanka batted first having won the toss and made 338 in its first innings. Bangladesh were bowled out for 467, a 129-run first innings lead. Sri Lanka then made 319 in its second innings.



Iqbal and Rahman stalled a potential collapse of Bangladesh's chase with a 109-run partnership for the third wicket after Sri Lanka captain Rangan Herath took two wickets in successive deliveries to leave the tourists struggling on 22 for two. Iqbal faced 124 deliveries for his 82 runs that included seven boundaries and a six. He was brilliantly caught by Dinesh Chandimal in the outfield off offspinner Dilruwan Perera. Rahman made 42 before being trapped lbw by Perera. Shakib Al Hasan was bowled by Perera on 15 and Mosaddek Hossain (13) was caught by wicketkeeper Nirishan Dickwella off Herath. Captain Mushfiqur Rahim remained unbeaten on 22 and fittingly scored the winning runs for Bangladesh.

FIFA events chief Jaime Yarza promises to deliver 'magnificent' U-17 World Cup in India

New Delhi, Mar 19
India's vast size and diversity posed as obstacles in the initial preparatory stage, but having crossed the hurdles, FIFA's head of events Jaime Yarza has promised to deliver a "magnificent" U-17 World Cup football.



India is bracing up to host its biggest-ever football tournament, and the world's third biggest, from October 6 to 28 in six cities. "India is massive and has so many diverse regions that coordination with the various authorities can be challenging. In addition to this the distances to cover when we do inspections can be quite big. The infrastructure needed huge improvements but in general I am confident that it will be a magnificent FIFA World Cup," Yarza said. Better football education, stadia and training facilities could be some of the lasting legacies of India hosting the tournament, he said. "In the years to come I really hope to see India's footballers

rise to the top in Asia and this would be the true legacy of the FIFA U17 World Cup," he said. "From an organisational point of view, we want to leave the right legacy in the football structures of the country - better sport managers, better stadia and better training sites. All of this should and will benefit football in India in the years to come." Yarza lauded the government support ahead of his final inspection of the six venues this week. Yarza and his team will land here on Tuesday for the inspection visit and will be in the country till March 27. "The whole of India and its government are supporting the tournament, which really shows the strong and increasing level of interest in football. I am convinced that the FIFA U-17 World Cup, together with the project Mission XI Million, will leave a strong and lasting legacy in India and we will see an increasing interest in football and many more boys and girls playing the beautiful game." Post the U-17 tournament, Yarza hoped to see stronger Indian national and club teams in the future. "If the AIFF maintains the level of activity we expect, supported by FIFA's Forward Development Programme, we will see great achievements in the various national and club teams from India."

7 year old World Champion Tajamul Islam's academy in J&K gets Rs.10 lakh funding

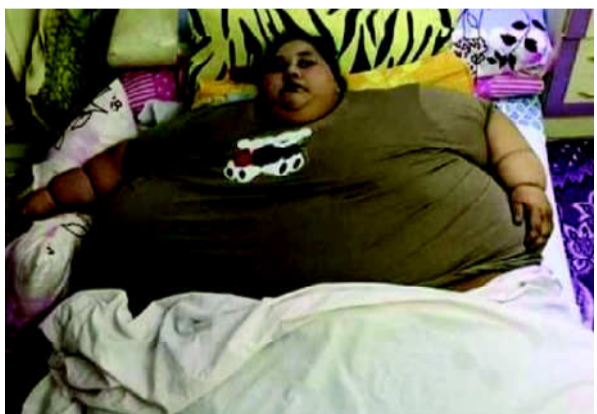
Bandipora, Mar 19

World's heaviest woman loses 140 kg since arrival in India

Mumbai, Mar 19
Eman Ahmed, the Egyptian national who is believed to be the world's heaviest woman, has lost over 140 kg since her arrival in India for weight reduction treatment, doctors said on Saturday. She is being treated by a team led by Dr Mufazzal Lakdawala at Saifee Hospital in Mumbai where she underwent a weight loss surgery earlier this month. "Eman's current weight is 358 kg," the hospital said in a statement. When she arrived in Mumbai on February 11



by a specially modified aircraft, she weighed 500 kg. She is currently on "two hourly liquid feeding regime" where she is given low-sodium protein powder mixed with soy milk. Daily, she receives about 1,800 calories, the statement said. "Her levels of uric acid remain a challenge," it added. Eman still receives her feed through a tube because of the difficulty in swallowing fluids due to a stroke she had suffered earlier, doctors said.

number that identifies residents based on their biometrics. While more than 112 crore Aadhaar have been generated in the country, the Aadhaar authentications have crossed 500 crore, and 100 crore e-KYC have been done on the platform. Pandey, however, emphasised that only those devices that wish to use Aadhaar authentication, would have to meet the new standards. Only such 'registered devices' that incorporate the new specifications would be allowed to perform Aadhaar authentication. "We are continuously trying to tighten the security. We felt that while the system is secure, we want to further improve the security by building one more layer. So, if the device itself can be encrypted it will be harder to break into the system," he said.
