## India Sees Tourism Surge in Andaman and Nicobar Islands Eco Luxury Resorts, Astro Tourism and Volcano Cruises Redefine Travel Experience

India is witnessing a strong surge in tourism to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, driven by changing travel patterns and the rapid evolution of experiences across the archipelago. Well-known destinations such as Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep continue to draw steady crowds, but the spotlight

is gradually expanding to lesser-explored parts of the archipelago. Long Island is also emerging as a major highlight, increasingly positioned as a peaceful alternative to the busier tourist hubs. At the same time, key infrastructure upgrades are redefining established properties. In Sri Vijaya Puram, the well-known Megapode Resort will undergo a complete redevelopment, transforming it into a

high-end heritage hotel. The upgraded property is expected to feature luxury amenities, including infinity pools overlooking the harbor, along with modern design elements that preserve its historical significance. This redevelopment signals a clear move toward upscale tourism and improved hospitality standards across the islands. Beyond accommodations, the Andamans are expanding

their range of unique travel experiences. One of the most notable additions is the introduction of organized astro-tourism programs. With virtually no light pollution, the islands provide ideal conditions for stargazing. Training initiatives are underway in places like Little Andaman and Mayabunder, where local guides are being equipped with skills in astronomy, telescope usage, and sustainable tourism practices. These efforts are aimed at creating enriching nighttime experiences that combine education with natural beauty. Adventure activities are also being enhanced and standardized. Night sea kayaking, especially popular for witnessing glowing bioluminescent waters, has been formalized with improved safety measures and clearer operational guidelines. This ensures that more travelers can

TB - led by Bharat, powered by Jan Bhagidari', emphasizing collective efforts and community participation in the fight against Tuberculosis.

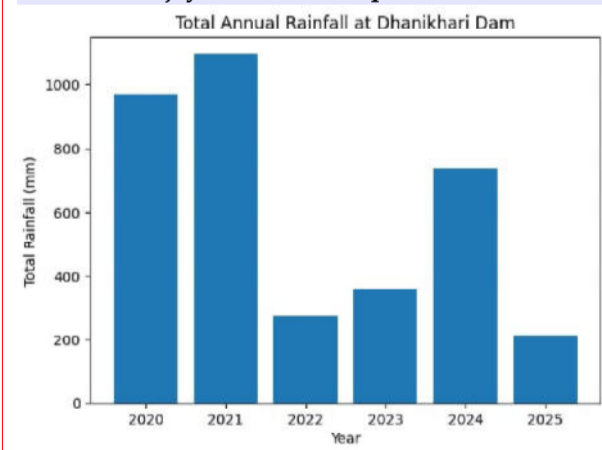

## Public advised to use water judiciously amid declining reservoir levels

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar 19 The Administration of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has issued an advisory urging residents of Sri Vijaya Puram to use water judiciously in view of the declining water levels in key supply sources, particularly the Dhanikhari Dam.

The current situation has arisen due to significantly lower rainfall during the North-East Monsoon season (November to February) this year. Rainfall recorded (Dhanikhari) during this period is the lowest in the past five years, leading to a corresponding drop in water availability across Sri Vijaya Puram headquarters area.



This has directly impacted the storage levels in the Dhanikhari Dam and other supplementary water sources. Given the reduced inflow and limited reserves, the Administration emphasizes the need for collective responsibility in conserving water. Residents are strongly encouraged to avoid wastage, adopt water-saving practices in daily

activities, and ensure that available resources are used efficiently and responsibly. During the last two years the department has taken up a number of projects including the Rutland Phase-II to augment the water in SVP headquarter area with an allocation of Rs 20.36 Crore. An amount of Rs 30.00 Crore is allocated for next year. In addition,

the public have been requested to remain vigilant and report any leakage or wastage observed in the water supply network. Prompt reporting will help authorities take swift corrective action and prevent unnecessary loss of this vital resource. Such issues may be reported to the Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) at 251185 or to the Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVP) at 231179.

The Administration reiterates that conserving water at this critical juncture is essential to ensure equitable distribution and sustained supply for all residents. Public cooperation is crucial in overcoming the present challenge and safeguarding water resources for the future, a press release from APWD said.

through integration of market networks, updation of aquaculture infrastructure private sector participation in the sector. The Department has been actively engaging with the stakeholders and periodic reviewing of the progress made in each of these clusters are being undertaken with the stakeholders for development of these clusters.

The Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, on 04<sup>th</sup> November, 2025, has notified the Sustainable Harnessing of Fisheries in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) Rules, 2025 under the Territorial Waters, Continental Shelf, Exclusive Economic Zone and Other Maritime Zones Act, 1976. The Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India in consultation with Department of Fisheries, Government of India, also notified the Guidelines for Sustainable Harnessing of Fisheries in the High Seas by Indian Flagged Fishing Vessels, 2025, on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025, in exercise of its powers under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Article 73, and Entry 10 of 57 of List I of the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India. These Rules and Guidelines provide that fish harvested in the EEZ or High Seas and landed at Indian ports will be treated as Indian Origin and will be exempted from import duty, ensuring that higher margins flow directly to fishers. Guidelines also facilitates mid sea transshipment through the mother-child vessel model. Guidelines and Rules also provide that fish landed at foreign ports will be treated as exports and online issuance of MPEDA Catch Certificates and EIC Health Certificates through integration with ReALCRaft portal will ensure full traceability, global compliance and higher market value for Indian seafood in foreign countries. Besides, as per the announcement in Union Budget 2026-27, the Fish catch by an Indian fishing vessel in Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) or on the High Seas shall be free of import duty and landing of such fish on foreign port will be treated as export of goods.

This information was given by Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Minister Shri Rajiv Ranjan Singh alias Lalan Singh in the Rajya Sabha in response to a question asked.

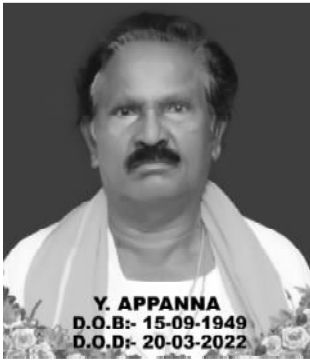
