

## Hon'ble Prime Minister disburses incentives worth around Rs. 2,400 crore under Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana

### PM Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana is about empowering first-time employees and building a bridge between youth and industry: Hon'ble Prime Minister

New Delhi, June 19 (PIB)

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today addressed beneficiaries, industry representatives, and stakeholders associated with the Prime Minister Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana, reaffirming the Government's commitment to empowering India's youth and accelerating employment generation across the country. Shri Modi disbursed incentives worth around Rs. 2,400 crore under the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY), marking a significant milestone in the implementation of PM-VBRY, the Government of India's flagship employment-linked incentive scheme, and expanding social security coverage across sectors. This incentive has supported the creation of 15 lakh employment opportunities across the country.

Addressing the gathering shortly after returning from his visit to France and Slovakia, where he participated in the G-7 Summit and engaged with world leaders, the Hon'ble Prime

Minister noted that India's youth are receiving unprecedented recognition globally for their talent, skills, and potential. He remarked that the world is increasingly acknowledging the capabilities of young Indians and emphasized that the Government is committed to ensuring that every young person has the opportunity to transform their potential into success.

"Prime Minister Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana is much more than an employment scheme. It is an initiative designed to strengthen the aspirations of young people entering their first jobs while creating a robust bridge between industry and the workforce", Shri Modi remarked. He observed that while many schemes are typically focused either on employees or employers, this programme simultaneously supports both. The Government stands with young people beginning their professional journeys and encourages institutions that create new employment opportunities.



Sharing the achievements of the scheme, Shri Modi said that nearly 70 lakh new jobs have been created so far and an equal number of first-time employees have been brought under the ambit of social security. He further noted

that close to 20 lakh young people have completed six months in their first jobs, while around 10 lakh beneficiaries have already received incentives under the scheme upon completing this milestone. More than Rs.

2,000 crore has been directly transferred to beneficiaries' bank accounts. Describing this support as more than financial assistance, Shri Modi said it reflects the nation's recognition of the hard work of its youth and its

confidence in their future.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister also expressed satisfaction over the participation of institutions and enterprises that have generated employment opportunities under the scheme. "Employment generation gains momentum when the Government, industry, and youth work together. The initiative is a reflection of a new India where young people receive opportunities, industries receive encouragement, and employment generation becomes a national mission", Shri Modi noted.

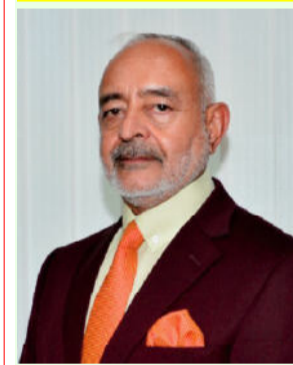
present on the occasion.

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## Great Nicobar Project to be game-changer for India's maritime trade: Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jun 19 (PTI) The ambitious Great Nicobar Island project is set to be a game-changer for India's maritime trade, positioning the Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a

major logistics hub in the Indo-Pacific region, said Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency.

Hon'ble Lt. Governor said the project will now move into the implementation phase, with its flagship component - the International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT) - likely to contribute significantly to the country's maritime trade.

"In the first phase, the terminal is expected to handle around 6 million TEUs at an estimated cost of Rs 20,000 crore, with

completion targeted within three years of commencement. In the final phase, capacity could scale up to 21 million TEUs, making it one of the largest container ports not only in India, but potentially across the Indo-Pacific," Hon'ble Lt. Governor told PTI.

TEU is the standardised unit of measurement for cargo capacity of container ships and the throughput of ports.

Highlighting the strategic location of Great Nicobar near the Malacca Strait, Hon'ble Lt. Governor said the port could emerge as a dominant transshipment hub in global shipping routes.

## District Administration establishes dedicated Helpline for Re-NEET (UG) Examination 2026 candidates

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## A Boost for India's Economic Sovereignty, says Admiral Karambir Singh (Retd.)

Former Chief of the Indian Navy Admiral Karambir Singh (Retd.), who has also served as the Chief of Staff of the Andaman and Nicobar Command, talks about the strategic importance of the Great Nicobar Project. He says the project should be viewed not only through the prism of environmental concerns but also in the context of India's economic security, maritime interests, Indo-Pacific strategy and the evolving geopolitical landscape of the Indian Ocean Region. Edited excerpts from an exclusive interview with Saurabh Sharma, Correspondent, Outlook Business.

Q: Why is the Great Nicobar Project strategically important for India from a national security perspective?

A: Firstly, it is a part of the Andaman and Nicobar [A&N] group of islands which, in their entirety, are of strategic significance for India. Lying almost 1,200 km from India's east coast, these islands sit astride the Bay of Bengal and the Andaman Sea. The location of these islands offers India a maritime connection not only with the littoral states

in the Bay of Bengal but also with countries in Southeast Asia. Any threat to India's interests emanating at, or from, the sea would obviously manifest in this area. Therefore, it is from the A&N islands-which could veritably be called the 'eastern sentinel' of India-that the first response to such a threat must be made.

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nearly forty countries. These agreements are creating new markets, expanding access to global consumers, and generating fresh opportunities for brands built under the Make in India initiative", Shri Modi remarked.

Shri Modi observed that the world today places great expectations on India. Second, a large port in the Great Nicobar island would enable the Indian Navy and the Indian Coast Guard to deploy ships for surveillance and maritime security missions more frequently and for longer durations. These deployments not only enhance India's maritime security but also contribute to regional security.

Third, the Great Nicobar island is situated a mere 70 km from the Six Degree Channel, which is part of one of the most important international shipping lane [ISL] that passes through the Strait of Malacca and Singapore. This favourably positions India to more effectively monitor international shipping traffic transiting the Indian Ocean and respond to any contingencies that might develop therein.

The most important component of this project is the International Container Transshipment Terminal [ICTT] that is proposed to be built. This facility, if commercially viable, would reduce the dependency of India's maritime trade on foreign transshipment ports, save a substantial amount of foreign exchange and promote foreign trade. From a national security angle, which encompasses economic security, it would be the most important advantage that would accrue to India.

**Q: Great Nicobar sits close to the Strait of Malacca, one of the world's busiest maritime chokepoints. How does the proposed port strengthen India's ability to monitor and secure this vital sea lane?**

**A:** Ships passing through the Strait of Malacca via the Six Degree Channel would be well within shore-based surveillance capability of the Great Nicobar island, including coastal radar and automatic identification system (AIS) stations. The ICTT could also provide operational turnaround facilities such as berthing, fuel and other logistics for the Navy and the Coast Guard. Similarly, the greenfield international airport could also facilitate operations by maritime-surveillance aircraft.

The project would bolster our existing maritime domain awareness in the area, which would ensure safety and security of this critical ISL. Since the Great Nicobar island is the southernmost location in India, it would also significantly enhance the range of operation of our ships and aircraft to the South. At the same time, these facilities would also reduce our response time for contingencies such as maritime search and rescue, ships in distress due to fire, flooding or other accidents, piracy and armed robbery, among others.

**Q: China has expanded its presence in the Indian Ocean. To what extent is the Great Nicobar Project a response to China's growing footprint in the region?**

**A:** The project takes advantage of the island's location with respect to the major ISL passing through the Malacca Strait, as also natural depth around the island which favours a deep-water port. These two factors, among others, make for an ideal transshipment port location, which could be economically beneficial for both mega-shipping operators as well as our country. Although China has been building up its presence in the Indian Ocean, the Great Nicobar Project is driven purely by India's own maritime interests.

**Q: Do you believe the strategic and military dimensions of the project are equally, if not more, important than its commercial objectives?**

**A:** I would say that the primary driver is commerce. There is also a secondary military component. Whilst India already has military facilities on the island, this project would make military operations more effective by enabling operation of more capable military assets. Although the commercial infrastructure-the airport and the ICTT-could also support military operations, the objective of the project remains mainly commercial. Currently, 75 per cent of India's transshipment cargo moves through Colombo and Singapore. The government forecasts that the ICTT could bring in as much as Rs 30,000 crore in annual revenue by 2040 and create about 50,000 jobs. As a regional transshipment hub, the project's commercial value far outweighs all other incidental advantages that might accrue from it.

**Q: The government plans to develop a new township at Great Nicobar. Why does India need a significant civilian population on a sparsely populated island?**

**A:** The scale of the Great Nicobar Project is such that it would need a substantial skilled human resource base-technical as well as administrative-for its operationalisation. Currently, this human resource is not available on the island. The 2011 census data recorded a population of 8,367, which is currently estimated to be around 11,000. Further, the local population is not trained and skilled for port and airport operations as well as for running the ancillary services such as the power plants, transportation and medical facilities.

**Q: Can the Great Nicobar island evolve into a major logistics, maintenance and support hub for the Indian Navy, Coast Guard and friendly foreign navies?**

**A:** The Great Nicobar island is not planned to have a major logistics and maintenance hub for the armed forces. The South Andaman island is more suited for this because it is much larger in area and population and already accommodates the headquarters of the Andaman and Nicobar Command. As far as the use of Indian ports by friendly foreign navies is concerned, this is already being done on a case-to-case basis.

**Q: In the event of a future crisis involving China, what role could Great Nicobar play in surveillance, sea denial, intelligence gathering and force projection?**

**A:** The infrastructure proposed to be developed in the Great Nicobar island could provide the armed forces with facilities to operate from the island. The missions that the armed forces would undertake in a crisis would depend upon its nature and could include surveillance, trade protection, monitoring of ISLs, air defence, sea denial, etc to name a few. The facilities at the Great Nicobar island would be in addition to those that already exist in the A&N Islands, including those that have been created exclusively for defence purposes.

**Q: How important is the project in the context of India's Indo-Pacific strategy and its growing partnerships with countries like the US, Japan, Australia, France and Asean nations?**

**A:** This project would provide greater impetus to India's ongoing initiatives in the Indo-Pacific. On the one hand, it would enhance maritime connectivity in the Indian Ocean, which is essentially the western segment of the Indo-Pacific, and on the other, it would burnish India's role as a preferred security partner in the Indian Ocean. It would strengthen people-to-people connectivity, especially with ASEAN countries, and provide a fillip to 'Neighbourhood First' and 'Act East' policy. (Source: <https://www.outlookindia.com/>)

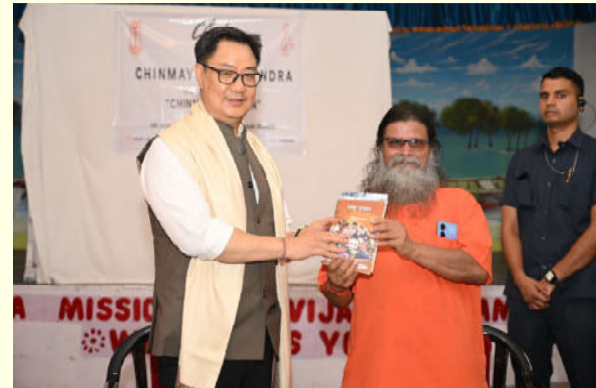

Hon'ble Lt. Governor said these initiatives would significantly contribute to India's broader vision of a 'Viksit Bharat' by enhancing the Andaman and Nicobar Islands' economic and strategic importance. He also outlined parallel initiatives across the island chain, including agreements with Cochin Shipyard Ltd for skill development and infrastructure upgradation to boost ship repair capabilities.

Further, projects such as the ship-to-ship transshipment terminal at Port Meadows (off Swaraj Dweep), and a proposed deep-water multipurpose port at Atlanta Bay near Diglipur, are expected to complement the Great Nicobar project, Hon'ble Lt. Governor said.

"With these developments, shipping activity in the Andaman seas is expected to rise significantly over the next five years, enabling the region to evolve initially as a ship repair hub and eventually as a shipbuilding centre," Hon'ble Lt. Governor asserted. (Source: <https://theprint.in/>)

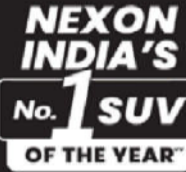
