PM-RAHAT strengthens emergency healthcare access for road accident victims; cashless treatment up to Rs.1.5 Lakh

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 19

The Prime Minister - Road Accident Victims' Hospitalisation and Assured Treatment (PM-RAHAT) Scheme, launched on 13th February, 2026, aims to ensure timely and uninterrupted medical care for road accident victims during the critical period following an accident. Under the scheme, eligible victims can avail themselves of cashless medical treatment of up to Rs.1.5 lakh per victim for a maximum period of seven days from the date of the accident, irrespective of the category of road on which the accident occurred.

All victims involved in road accidents caused by motor vehicles are eligible for treatment under PM-RAHAT. The scheme covers medical treatment up to Rs. 1.5 lakh per victim for a maximum of seven days, ensuring that financial constraints do not prevent victims from accessing essential healthcare during the critical Golden Hour.

A key feature of PM-RAHAT is the provision of stabilization treatment at designated hospitals. Stabilization treatment can be provided for up to 24 hours in non-life-threatening cases and up to 48 hours in life-threatening cases, subject to police response. This provision is aimed at facilitating immediate medical intervention and preventing delays caused by a lack of financial resources.

PM-RAHAT also establishes an integrated emergency response mechanism through the 112 Emergency Response Support System (ERSS). Road accident victims and Good Samaritans (RAH-VEER) can use the system to obtain information about the nearest designated hospital and request an ambulance,

where required. Following admission, treatment is initiated at the hospital in accordance with the Health Benefit Packages developed by the National Health Authority (NHA).

Under the scheme, designated hospitals include those empanelled under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PM-JAY) and compliant with the National Health Authority (NHA) guidelines for PM-RAHAT. In the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, nearly seven hospitals have been empanelled under AB-PM-JAY, including GB Pant Hospital, BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar; RP Hospital, Mayabunder; CHC Diglipur; CHC Rangat; CHC Nancowry; and CHC Bambooflat. These empanelled facilities help strengthen access to timely and cashless healthcare for road accident victims across the Islands.

PM-RAHAT is designed to provide road accident victims with timely, cashless and assured medical treatment without financial barriers, particularly during the critical Golden Hour. By integrating emergency response, police reporting, hospital treatment, authentication and digital claim settlement, the scheme seeks to strengthen India's emergency healthcare system and improve treatment outcomes for road accident victims, a press release from DHS said.

India defeat Sri Lanka in first Test by 165 runs; Manav Suthar takes 6 wickets

Galle, Aug. 19

In Men's Cricket, India beat host Sri Lanka by 165 runs in the first Test of the two-match series in Galle today. India now leads 1-nil in the series. Chasing a target of 372, Sri Lanka were bowled out for 206 in 77.4 overs during the post-lunch session, handing India a comfortable victory.

For India, Manav Suthar took six wickets, Prasidh Krishna took 2 while Ravindra Jadeja and Mohammed Siraj took one each. For Sri Lanka, Captain Dhananjaya de Silva fought hard with a 151-



ball 59, while Sonal Dinusha followed up his first-innings century with an 84.

Earlier, India were bowled out for 193 in their second innings, setting a target of 372 runs for Sri Lanka. Rishabh Pant led the

scoring with a quickfire 66 off 69 balls, hitting eight fours and two sixes. His innings also saw him become the first Indian batter to reach 100 sixes in Test cricket. Devdutt Padikkal scored 44, while KL Rahul contributed 35.

Empowering students for a secure digital future: A&N Police conducts Cyber Crime and Drugs & Narcotics Awareness Prog. at DBRAIT

As part of its ongoing public awareness initiatives, the Andaman & Nicobar Police conducted a comprehensive awareness programme on "Cyber Crime & Its Trends, Cyber Crime Awareness, and Drugs & Narcotics Awareness" at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Institute of Technology (DBRAIT), Dollygunj, Sri Vijaya Puram, on Aug. 17.

During the Cyber Crime Awareness session, participants were sensitised about emerging cyber threats, digital arrest scams, online financial frauds, social media-related crimes, identity theft, phishing, fraudulent links, digital payment scams and other cyber-enabled offences. Real-life cybercrime case studies were shared to explain the modus operandi of cybercriminals. Emphasis was laid on cyber hygiene,

safeguarding personal and financial information, using strong passwords and exercising caution while using social media, online banking and digital payment platforms. Participants were advised not to share OTP, PIN, passwords, CVV, banking credentials or other sensitive information and to report suspected cyber financial fraud immediately through Cyber Crime Helpline No. 1930 or the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP).

During the Drugs & Narcotics Awareness session, students and staff were sensitized about the harmful effects of drug abuse and addiction and the serious legal consequences of illegal possession, consumption, transportation, sale and trafficking of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances under the NDPS Act. Adverse impact of drugs on health,

education, career, family and society were highlighted and students were encouraged to resist peer pressure, make informed choices and maintain a healthy and responsible lifestyle. They were also encouraged to share credible information regarding drug peddling and other narcotics-related activities with the Police. The programme provided an opportunity for students to interact with Police Officers and understand the emerging challenges in the digital environment and the importance of staying away from drugs and narcotic substances.

To state whether you contest or do not contest the claim either in whole or in part and if you contest to receive directions of the Court as to the date on which your written statement is to be filed the witness or witnesses upon whose evidence you intend to rely in support of your defense are to be produced, the documents upon which you intend to rely are to be filed also the date of trial and other matters. Take Notice that in the event of your admitting the claim either in whole or part the Court with forthwith Pass Judgment in accordance with such admissions, or in the event of the claim not being contested the suit shall be decided at once.

3. To answer the claim and you are directed to produce on that day, all the documents upon which you intend to rely in support of your defence.

Take Notice that in default of your appearance on the day before mentioned the suit will be heard and determined in your absence.
