## India, Myanmar agree for close security coordination in border areas

New Delhi, Oct 19  
India and Myanmar have agreed for close security coordination in border areas keeping in view the sensitivity of each other's strategic interests.

In a press statement after holding delegation level talks with visiting State Counsellor of Myanmar Ms Aung San Suu Kyi in New Delhi, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi said, as a reliable partner and friend, India stands shoulder to shoulder with Myanmar.

The Prime Minister said, the two countries also agreed to enhance engagement in several areas including agriculture, power, and renewable energy. Shri Modi said, the two sides will also work to develop a mutually beneficial arrangement for



trade in pulses. India has also offered to enhance power supply from Moreh in Manipur to Tamu in Myanmar. Shri Modi said, Archaeological Survey of India will soon begin work on restoring two old temples and inscriptions of King Mindon and King Baygyidaw in Bodh Gaya.

In her press statement, Ms Aung San Suu Kyi said, her country has always admired India for being the greatest democracy in the world. She hoped that both

the countries can overcome challenges. She said India with its experiences can help Myanmar's endeavours in all key areas.

## Railway stations to be redeveloped for passenger amenities

New Delhi, Oct. 19  
In a major initiative, railway stations and adjoining areas will be redeveloped for enhancing passenger amenities and easy access to stations as a part of Smart City development.

A Memorandum of Understanding was signed in this regard today in the presence of Railway Minister Shri Suresh Prabhu and Urban Development Minister Shri Venkaiah Naidu. Both the Ministers lauded the joint initiative as a historic landmark that brings synergy in development of

smart cities saying there cannot be a smart city without a smart railway station. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Naidu said that this convergence based city development will result in qualitative improvement in city life. He suggested involvement of local people in redevelopment plans. The Railway Minister said that railway stations have been the core of city development and have become congested over time and their redevelopment offers immense opportunities for changing city landscape.

Chairing the consultation meeting on the 'Persons in Destitution Model Bill' in New Delhi, Shri Gehlot said the Bill will provide

protection, care, support, shelter, training and other services to all persons in destitution. He said the approach of the government towards addressing the problem is rehabilitating such persons. He called upon all concerned stakeholders to share their views for addressing the problem.

vacant land will be utilized for community development activities viz. shopping complex etc, a communication from the Additional District Magistrate said here today.

## Efforts to beat tuberculosis fall far short, WHO warns

New York, Oct 19  
The World Health Organization has warned that health authorities worldwide need to move much faster to prevent, detect and treat a deadly epidemic of tuberculosis if they are to reduce TB infections and deaths by 2030. In its annual report on tackling TB, a highly contagious lung disease which kills more people each year than HIV and malaria combined, the WHO said, progress had been dismal and called for bold political commitment and increased funding. The report found that there were an estimated 10.4 million new TB cases worldwide in 2015, with six countries accounting for 60 per cent of those India, Indonesia, China, Nigeria, Pakistan and South Africa.

## INS Tahiyu commissioned into Indian Navy



Vishakhapatnam, Oct 19  
The 315-tonne INS Tahiyu is the sixth Water Jet Fast Attack Craft (WJFAC) Car Nicobar Class vessel was commissioned and allotted to the Eastern Fleet of the Navy today at Vishakhapatnam. The vessel was commissioned into the Indian Navy by

the Flag-Officer-Commanding-in-Chief of the Eastern Naval Command Vice-Admiral H.C.S. Bisht. Built by Kolkata-based shipyard Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), INS Tahiyu is the 20th vessel in this class to be built by the shipyard.

## Wildlife offenders caught with meat of wild pig & spotted deer

Port Blair, Oct. 19  
On getting credible information about poaching of wild animals, a team of Forest Officials was constituted and dispatched to Beachdera forest area under Tushnabad Forest Range on Oct 12, 2016. The team intercepted a gang of six people carrying cut meat of Andaman Wild Pig and Spotted Deer. The offenders on sighting the Forest officials started

running and after chasing, one of the offenders Sikender Singh, aged 45 years, S/o. Jagan Singh, R/o. Tushnabad was caught red-handed along with the meat. The other offenders ran away taking advantage of the terrain and thick forest. Approximately, 15 kgs cut meat each of Andaman Wild Pig and Spotted Deer were seized from his possession.

## India, Algeria reiterate their resolve to fight against terrorism

Algiers, Oct 19  
India and Algeria have reiterated their resolve to fight against the menace of terrorism which has become a serious threat to global peace and security.

During the separate meetings with President of the National People's Assembly, Mr Mohamed Larbi Ould Khalifa and President of Council of Nation Mr Abdelkader Bensalah in Algiers yesterday, Vice President Shri Mohammed Hamid Ansari raised the issue prominently saying that terrorism is a crime against religion.

Briefing media persons last night, Secretary West Ms Sujata Mehta said that both sides emphasized the urgent need to stand up unitedly against the terrorism and



its sponsors. The leaders echoed the emotion that development is not possible without ensuring peace and security.

Ms Mehta said, during the meetings, the two countries discussed wide ranging issues to promote cooperation in several

sectors including Hydro-carbon, Phosphates, automobile parts, agricultural and industrial machinery, pharmaceuticals and others.

India and Algeria have maintained close relations since the era of Algeria's struggle for independence.

India sees Algeria as one of the leading economies of Africa and the developing world. India's major companies have been partnering with Algerian entities for more than three decades and have executed some of the important projects in Algeria.

## District Administration raids godowns of CCWS; FIR lodged for storage of excess crackers



Port Blair, Oct. 19  
On receiving a complaint regarding unauthorized/excess storage of crackers, the godowns of Central Co-operative Welfare Society at Sippighat, Prothrapur and Dollygunj were raided by a team of District Administration led by SDM, South Andaman which found storage of

6698 kg crackers against the license of 2000kg thus violating section 9B (1)(b) of Explosive Act 1884.

Since this action on part of CCWS is not only hazardous but also likely to endanger public security and safety, an FIR has been lodged with Police Station Pahargaon



under relevant provisions of IPC, Explosive Act & Rules framed thereunder. Further Joint Chief Controller of Explosive, Kolkata has been asked to cancel the Explosive license granted to CCWS.

All the license holders of crackers/explosives are hereby

directed to follow licensing conditions scrupulously and desist from hazardous practices which may endanger public safety. Strict action will be taken against the defaulters, a communication from the Assistant Commissioner (HQ) said here today.

## PBMC to remove all hoardings for non-payment of outstanding dues

Port Blair, Oct. 19  
The Port Blair Municipal Council will soon start a drive to remove all those hoardings for which either the outstanding dues have not been paid or the necessary details have not displayed on them. The decision has been taken in view of the fact that lot of hoardings/boards erected by the firm/individuals / agencies / companies within Municipal area have not yet renewed quoting the reason of enhanced fees. All such boards are still continuing with commercial display/usage unauthorisedly. At the behest of ACCI and series of meeting of the Committee

constituted to resolve the issue of hoarding fees, the Council decided to collect Rs.45,000/- instead of Rs.63,000/ board / annum for the lapsed period till 31st March 2016. The current dues w.e.f.1.4.2016 will be as per byelaws i.e. Rs.63,000/-. Individual letters are also being issued to all defaulting agencies/firms to get the permission renewed by remitting the renewal fees.

The PBMC has asked all concerned to remit the outstanding dues of hoarding fees by Oct. 26, 2016 failing which the boards will be removed by PBMC at the risk and cost of the agencies concerned.

Further, as per PBMC Advertisement Bye-laws, all boards should display/write the Licence number, validity, telephone number in the hoardings as instructed in the permission letter. Therefore, firm/individuals/agencies / companies have been directed to fix/write/display/Licence number, validity, telephone number in a legible manner of size 8"x16" on the right side corner of the respective Hoarding/ board as required under PBMC Advertisement Byelaws failing which the Hoarding/Board may be

Port Blair Municipal Council has decided to auction the food kiosks situated near Post Office, Aberdeen Bazar on 09.11.2016 at 3.30 PM in the Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Auditorium hall, Port Blair Municipal Complex. The reserved price for auction is fixed at Rs.10,000/- as monthly rent of each Kiosk. 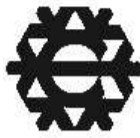

Ahmedabad, Oct 19  
In the Kabaddi World Cup, India has entered semi-finals thrashing England 69-18 in their last Group B in Ahmedabad. Star raider Pardeep Narwal scored 13 points while Ajay Thakur scored 11 points. After suffering a shocking defeat in their opening match against South Korea, India bounced back in style and finished the group matches with a whopping score difference of 174. Kenya kept their hopes alive of a semi-final berth after registering a thumping 74-19



win over the US in their last league tie of the Kabaddi World Cup. Desperately in need of a win, Kenya finally pressed the acceleration button to push Thailand out and occupy the

second spot in Group B. Top-placed Iran are already in the semi-finals while Kenya will have to wait for the Japan (fourth) vs Thailand (third) match today to know their fate.

**India look good to extend lead at the Feroz Shah Kotla**

New Delhi, Oct 19  
After a dominant performance, more importantly with the ball on a Dharamsala track that was perceived to be better suited for New Zealand pace battery, India look good to extend their lead to 2-0 in the 2nd ODI of the five-match series against New Zealand when the two teams lock horns at the Feroz Shah Kotla, Delhi on Sunday, for what would be India's 901st ODI game. At the Kotla India have won 12 ODI and lost only five while New Zealand have lost their

Luke Ronchi scored a breezy hundred during a warm-up game here and the slowness of the track is likely to assist NZ's slow bowlers. These factors and playing to their potential is what Williamson can hope for from his team to be able to compete with India. The hosts, on the other hand, will be content to continue their experiment with the fringe players.

**CBI registers case in Narsingh Yadav doping case**

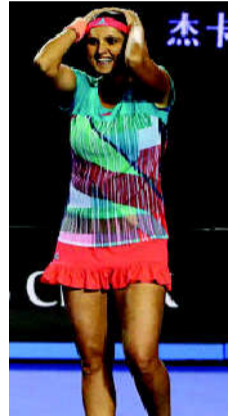


New Delhi, Oct 19

**Sania Mirza completes 80 consecutive weeks as World No.1**

New Delhi, Oct 19  
This week Indian tennis star Sania Mirza's 'numero uno' status in women's double ranking hit a marvellous 80 consecutive week and she let the world know about the achievement via twitter. To put this achievement in to perspective, only three other women's doubles players have held on to the top spot at one go more than Mirza, and they are Martina Navratilova (181 weeks), Cara Black (145) and Liezel Huber (134). The 29-year-old Hyderabad, who became the first Indian woman to hold the No. 1 ranking after winning the Volvo Car Open in Charleston with 8885 points while her former partner Hingis is at 8560 points. After holding the women's doubles top slot for jointly with Hingis,



Mirza finally pipped her to take the sole possession of the WTA doubles number one ranking in August this year when she teamed up with Barbora Strycova to beat and Coco Vandeweghe in Cincinnati Open final.
