



Demonetization to curb corruption, terror funding: HM



New Delhi, Nov 19 Home Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh has said, demonetization of high

value currency notes will curb corruption and funding to terrorism. In a statement, Shri Singh thanked people for supporting the move despite facing inconvenience. He said, the initiative will bring probity in political and administrative work and described the decision as historic, bold and in the national interest. Shri Singh said, Government is taking every step to ease hardships being faced by people and the situation will normalise

soon. The Minister added that the decision will bridge the gap between the rich and the poor. Union Minister of Law and Justice Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad said, demonetisation is showing results and more than 4 lakh crore rupees came to banks and all is clean money. He said, extremists are finding their financial backbone completely broken and the country's economy is surging and security getting strengthened.

New Delhi, Nov 19 Finance Minister, Shri Arun Jaitley said, to ensure increase in agriculture output and double farmers' income by 2022, the focus should be on higher agriculture productivity especially in view of the limitation on expanding crop area. He was speaking at the first pre-budget consultative meeting with the representatives of Agriculture Groups in New Delhi today. Shri Jaitley said, productivity can be raised



by leveraging technology especially for high yielding and resistant variety seeds, efficient utilization of water for irrigation, adapt increase resilience to nature by phasing sowing, watering and harvesting. He said, in order to increase the price benefits to the farmers, it is necessary that the farmers are provided timely market information. He also stressed on developing software applications, both
