In a move that is going to bring huge relief to cardiac patients across A&N Islands, the Administration in a way forward to provide better health care facilities in the Islands will be establishing a Cardiac Catherisation Lab at G.B. Pant Hospital/ANIIMS to carry out the procedures of coronary angiogram, angioplasty, permanent pacemaker, congenital heart defect correction etc. Presently, for availing this facility, the needy patients are being referred to mainland for treatment incurring loss of time and money.

As part of this, ANIIMS has been 2020, State of the Art tender for supply, finalized and Letter of Award has been issued to the lowest bidder. The approved Cath Lab machine is the latest generation launched in the year

The cost of the project including main equipment price with 5 years warranty, other required equipments/accessories, turnkey cost and CAMC release from Directorate of Health Services said. Safer traffic & hassle free pedestrian movement to be initiated on pilot basis for 30 days

Port Blair, Jan. 19

The District Road Safety Committee, South Andaman has convened a meeting under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman wherein the Transport Department and Traffic Police proposed to improve the traffic congestion at Chatham Jetty Area. The Chatham Jetty area has been witnessing heavy vehicular congestion especially during the arrival and departure of boats, due to the



unorganized movement of vehicles, heavy congestion is created in the area making unsafe for the movement of pedestrians. As such it has been decided to implement a traffic movement plan initially for period of 30 days on a pilot basis which is as follows:-

- Space near the canteen has been earmarked for parking of two wheelers in two rows.
- Maximum of five stage carriage buses will be allowed to stop and alight passengers at the earmarked area by the side of ticket counter.

After the area identified for buses, area has been earmarked for parking of 10 autorickshaw and five taxi/ CC permit vehicles on the left side of the road towards jetty. Personal vehicles (Two wheelers and cars) are permitted to park at the area after the area earmarked for autorickshaw on the left side of the road. 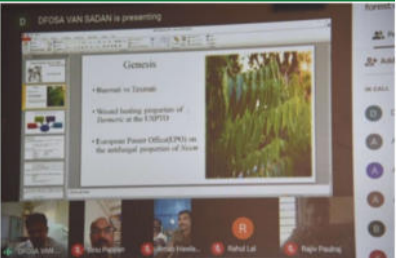

India conquer the Gabba Fortress
Team India creates history; clinches test series against Australia 2-1



Brisbane, Jan. 19
India today created history by defeating Australia by three wickets in the fourth and final Test at the Gabba in Brisbane and retained Border-Gavaskar Trophy. India chased down the target of 328 runs and claimed the series 2-1. This was the first defeat for Australia at their fortress Gabba in 32 years as Rishabh Pant's brilliant unbeaten 89, Shubman Gill's 91, and Cheteshwar Pujara played incredible half century knock in the second innings to guide India to a memorable Test series win. Earlier, the visitors resumed their second innings this morning with all wickets intact. Chasing 328 runs for victory, India had scored four for no loss after bowling Australia out for 294 after tea on day four yesterday.

will break at the ticket counter and restart after the area earmarked for buses.
➤ No bus or auto/ taxi will be allowed to go beyond their parking space towards jetty. However vehicles intending to board the vehicle ferry will be allowed to go up to the ferry.
➤ Personal Vehicles going to jetty for dropping the persons shall immediately leave the jetty area after dropping the persons.
➤ Entire stretch on the right side of the road towards jetty from Fire station gate will be "No Parking and No Stopping" for vehicles. This side will be exclusively used for pedestrian movement.
➤ Personal vehicle users are discouraged from parking their vehicles on the roadside.
➤ The vehicles intending to go inside the cargo jetty are allowed to use the road but should not stop on this stretch.

This plan is being implemented on a pilot basis to ensure a safer traffic movement and hassle free pedestrian movement, a press release from DC (SA) said.
