## PM addresses Convocation Ceremony of Visva-Bharati University

### There is no limit for Creativity and Knowledge : PM

New Delhi, Feb. 19 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the Convocation Ceremony of Visva-Bharati University today through a video conference. Governor of West Bengal and Rector of Visva-Bharati, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, Union Education Minister, Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank and Union MoS for Education, Shri Sanjay Dhotre were also present on the occasion.

The Prime Minister while addressing the convocation quoted the poem of Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore on Veer Shivaji which inspired him and called for unity of India. PM stressed that the students and the faculty were not just a part of a university, but also



bearers of a vibrant tradition. He said Gurudev named the University as Visva Bharati meaning Global University since he expected that anyone who comes to learn in Visva Bharati will see the whole world from the point of view of India and Indianness. So he made Visva Bharati such a place to learn, which can be seen in the rich heritage of India. He gave a call for assimilating and researching about the Indian heritage and working towards solving the problems of the poorest of the poor. He said Visva Bharati for Gurudev Tagore

was not just a knowledge imparting institution but an attempt to reach the topmost goal of Indian culture, which is to achieve oneself.

The Prime Minister said Gurudev believed that we have to discover ourselves among the varied Ideologies and differences. PM said that Tagore used to be proud of Bengal but at the same time, he was equally proud of India's diversity. And it was due to Gurudev's vision that humanity thrives under the open sky of Santiniketan. He praised Visva Bharati as an unending sea of knowledge in itself, the foundation of which was laid for experience-based education. He said there is no limit to creativity and

## ANPCC monitoring industrial discharge & sea water quality of beaches

### Conducts inspection at Swaraj Dweep; pH & dissolved oxygen parameter found within prescribed standards

Port Blair, Feb. 19

The Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) is taking various measures to keep tab of pollution in the Islands. In this regard, inspections were conducted earlier in the hotel industries and beaches in Shaheed Dweep during the month of Nov. 2020. In continuation with the inspections of industrial units and beaches, a team from ANPCC visited Swaraj Dweep last month to check the discharges quality of water from hotels and also to monitor

seawater quality of the beaches. As part of the inspection, pH (Potential of Hydrogen) and D.O (Dissolved Oxygen) of the industrial discharge from the hotels were tested. Additionally, D.O & Temperature of the sea water was collected from the beaches which are frequently

visited by the tourists. During the visit to Swaraj Dweep, the team visited 20 hotels and 5 Health Care facilities. Out of 20 hotels, 5 were found closed and 2 hotels were found under construction. In the remaining 13 hotels which were operational, the discharge quality of

water from the outlets of Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), the pH and Dissolved Oxygen (D.O) parameters were monitored and it was found that the discharge parameters of 7 hotels were within the prescribed standards. Action is being initiated in accordance with the

provision made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, against the defaulting hotels which are not meeting the prescribed standards.

Further, directions were given to the new hotels under construction to obtain

## Janani Suraksha Yojana- safe motherhood programme

### Reducing maternal & neo-natal mortality by promoting institutional delivery among poor pregnant women

#### 322 beneficiaries get incentives for institutional delivery; 6 for home delivery in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Feb. 19

Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) is a safe motherhood intervention under the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) being implemented with the objective of reducing maternal and neo-natal mortality by promoting institutional delivery among the poor pregnant women. The Yojana, launched on 12th April, 2005 is being implemented in all States and UTs. Janani Suraksha Yojana has contributed in increasing the institutional deliveries in the public health



post-delivery care. The Yojana has identified Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA) as an effective link between the Government and pregnant women. The eligibility criteria available only to BPL/SC/ST women regardless of age and number of children for delivery in Government/private accredited health facilities are as follows:

major challenge and the country needs to promote use of such kinds of vehicles which operate on alternative mode of fuels like electric batteries, CNG and bio-fuel. He said, India would become the number one manufacturer of electric vehicles in the next five years.

Power and New and Renewable Energy Minister, Shri R K Singh said that energy transition is imperative to reduce dependence on the imported fossil fuels. He urged the people to adopt electric products as it is more economical and environment friendly.

Highlighting the need of conversion of vehicles from fossil fuel to other alternative mode of fuels, CEO of NITI Aayog, Shri Amitabh Kant said, green hydrogen is the future and India can take the lead in the manufacturing of electric vehicles.

As part of incentives for institutional delivery in A&N Islands, altogether 322 beneficiaries (mothers) have been provided assistance @ Rs. 700/- from April 2019 to March 2020 while incentives @ Rs. 600 were provided to 189 ASHAs under this scheme.

Similarly, 6 beneficiaries were provided incentives @ Rs. 500/- for home delivery under this scheme from April 2019 to March 2020. This scheme will give benefits to street vendors too who are enrolled under PM SVANidhi Yojana, a press release from Directorate of Health Services said.

the 'Consent to Establish' under the relevant rules and to take all the measures to mitigate the pollution by installing required capacity of STPs for sewage treatment and ETP (Effluent Treatment Plant) for treatment of various discharges from the hotels.

The team also collected the water samples from two beaches namely Kalapathar beach and Radhanagar beach. The standards of DO were found well within the prescribed limits. The table below shows the sea water quality of beaches of Swaraj Dweep measured during the inspection:

knowledge. It was with this thought that Gurudev founded this great university. PM urged the students to always remember that knowledge, thought and skill are not static but a dynamic and continuous process. He said responsibility comes with knowledge and power. Just as one has to be restrained and sensitive while in power, every scholar also has to be responsible towards those who do not have knowledge.

The Prime Minister, while addressing the students said Your knowledge is not only yours but society's and is the heritage of the country. Your knowledge and skill can make a nation proud. He said many who are spreading terror and violence across the world are highly educated, highly skilled. On the other hand there are people who are risking their lives and stationed at hospitals and labs to save people from a pandemic like COVID. He said this is not about ideology but mindset, whether it is positive or negative. There is scope for both and paths are open for both. He urged the students to decide whether they want to be part of the problem or the solution. He added if they put the nation first then their every decision will move towards some solution. He advised the students not to be afraid of taking a decision. He said as long as the youth of the country have the passion to innovate, take risks and move forward, then there is no worry about the future of the country. He assured the Government's support for the youth in this endeavour.

Recalling the historical strength of the traditional Indian education system, the Prime Minister referred to Gandhian Shri Dharampal's book 'The Beautiful Tree- Indigenous Indian Education in the Eighteenth Century'. He said that the 1820 survey had said that there was more than one gurukul in every village which were linked with the local temples and literacy rate was estimated to be very high. This was recognized by the British scholars also. Shri Modi said, Gurudev Rabindranath developed systems in Visva Bharti which were the medium of modernising Indian education and freeing it from the shackles of slavery.

Value of additional scholarship is Rs. 1000/- per month which will be paid to the eligible students through NSP/PFMS. The additional scholarship shall be payable for ten months in an academic session. It shall be normally admissible to the pass-out students of previous academic session. Applicants are strictly advised to choose 'incentive scheme' under 'scheme type' drop down box at the time of registration and filling up of the application form.

And, whereas, under the Scheme, stipend and scholarships (hereinafter referred to as the benefits) are given to the trainees of the ITIs and the eligible hostellers/trainees respectively (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries) as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And, whereas, the Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby notifies the following, namely:-

1. (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar Number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(2) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar Number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment subject to the consent of his parents or local guardians (in case of children beneficiaries) provided that, he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act, and such individual shall visit any Aadhaar Enrolment Center [list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI)(website www.uidai.gov.in)] to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3) As per the regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agencies is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar Enrolment Center located in the respective Block or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agencies shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individuals, subject to the production of the following documents, namely :-

I. For children below 18 years old :-

(a) if the child has been enrolled after attaining the age of five years (with biometric collection), his Aadhaar enrollment identification slip or the biometric update identification slip; and

(b) any one of the following documents, namely :-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of Birth issued by the appropriate authority; or

(ii) School Identity Card, duly signed by the Principal of the School, containing parents names; and

(c) any one of the following documents as proof of relationship of the child with the parent or local guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely :-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of Birth issued by the appropriate authority; or

(ii) Ration Card; or

(iii) Ex - Serviceman Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) Card, or Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Card, or Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Card; or

(iv) Pension Card; or

(v) Army Canteen Card; or

(vi) Islander Identity Card issued by Andaman and Nicobar Administration;

(vii) Any Government Family Entitlement Card; or

(viii) Any other document as specified by the department.

II. For beneficiaries above 18 years old:-

(a) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification Slip; and

(b) Any one of the following documents, namely :-

(i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or

(ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or

(iii) Passport; or

(iv) Ration Card; or

(v) Voter Identity Card; or

(vi) Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or

(vii) Certificate of Identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or

(viii) Islander Identity Card issued by Andaman and Nicobar Administration;

(ix) Any other document as specified by the Department :

Provided further that, the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agencies shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the requirement of Aadhaar under the Scheme.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely :-

(a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agencies shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;

(b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-Based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;

(c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-Based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) Code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of QR Code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agencies.

4. 5. In order to ensure that, no bonafide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agencies shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum Number D-26011/04/2017-DBT dated 19th December, 2017 (available on <https://dbtbbharat.gov.in/>).
