PM holds All Party Meeting to discuss situation in India-China border areas

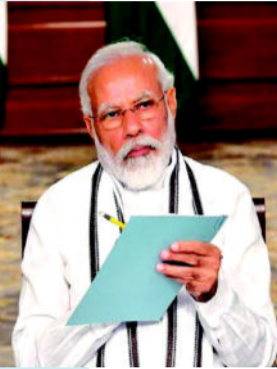
Neither is anyone inside our territory nor is any of our post captured: PM

New Delhi, June 19 (PIB)

Revival of Economy Post COVID and key initiatives in Shipping & Ports towards Atmanirbhar Bharat- Part 1

First Ship-To-Ship Transshipment Hub at Port Meadows, ANI likely to commence operations by October- November 2020

Port Blair, June 19

In view of the COVID-19 pandemic situation slowly coming under control and the focus of the Govt. of India now shifting towards revival of economy in the country, considerable efforts are being made in the Shipping and Port sector of the A&N Islands towards revival/enhancement of the economy of the Islands through various new projects and infrastructural development across the Islands. In the coming few days, the Department of Shipping and Ports will make the Islanders aware of the progress of these projects.

It may be recalled that the first Ship-to-Ship (STS) Transshipment hub in India at Port Meadows, A & N Islands was notified by the Ministry of Shipping, Govt. of India on 20th October, 2016 and subsequently after obtaining all necessary clearances, trial STS transshipment of 25000 MT thermal coal was successfully conducted at Port Meadows on 26th January, 2018. Subsequently, Port Meadows was also notified as Custom Port on 07.12.2018, clearing the way for full-fledged transshipment operations to both Indian and International Customers.

In the meantime, a detailed feasibility study on utilization of the STS Transshipment hub at Port Meadows was also conducted through Indian Ports Association (IPA), New Delhi wherein it was established that there is a potential of around 9 Million Ton of STS Transshipment during the first 5 years. This potential would increase considerably in the future once the operations are fully established.

This much-awaited project (Port Meadows) is likely to commence operations from October-November 2020. In this regard, the Port Management Board with MATSYA Shipping and Ports Private Limited, Kolkata (an Indo-German Joint venture company)

have already concluded an agreement. Despite the outbreak of COVID-19 and consequent

Up-gradation of Andaman Trunk Road (333 km)

127 km road construction work completed; improves travelling condition & reduces travel time

Entire stretch of ATR expected to be completed by middle of next year

Port Blair, June 19

National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) was entrusted the work of rehabilitation and up-gradation of the Andaman Trunk Road (ATR) NH-4 in the year 2017. The road length from Chidiyatapu to Diglipur is of 333 km long. For ease of construction and management, the road has been divided into 8 packages and the work was awarded to various firms after e-bidding.

It is to mention that the CBR value of the available earth in Andaman is very low at places being 2 to 3 and hence there was a need to replace the subgrade with good earth of CBR value of 8 or above before constructing the sub base and base course layers. Availability of aggregate to the tune of 10 lakh cubic meters was required to accomplish the work. As the availability of stone aggregates was at a premium and the massive logistics involved in transporting the same from mainland, the configuration of the carriageway design was modified and decision to use new technology was taken at the highest level in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.

Now with the use of chemicals and wrigen machines of German origin, the chemical stabilization work has been undertaken to reduce the dependency on the aggregates. This has reduced the requirement of aggregates by almost eight times and the durability of the road so constructed has also enhanced. Now, with majority of the issues been resolved, new design and technologies in place, the construction of road is being carried out in full swing. 127 km road has already been constructed thus improving the travelling condition for the road users and reducing the travel time. The entire ATR is planned to be completed by the middle of next year.

This has been possible due to the unstinted support of the Andaman Administration, being instrumental in resolving all issues of land, forest and the availability of

the government has given primacy to development of border area infrastructure to make our borders more secure. Provision has also been made for fighter planes, modern helicopters, missile defence systems and other such needs of our forces. Through the recently developed infrastructure, patrolling capacity at LAC has also increased, he said, adding that through this, we are better informed about the developments at LAC and consequently are able to monitor and respond better. The movement of those which used to take place without any disruption earlier is now checked by our jawans, which at times leads to build up of tension. He noted that through better infrastructure, supply of material and essentials to jawans in the difficult terrain has become comparatively easier. Prime Minister emphasized the commitment of the government to welfare of the nation and its citizens and said that be it in trade, connectivity or counter-terrorism, the government has always stood up to outside pressure. He assured that all steps necessary for national security and construction of necessary infrastructure, will continue to be taken at a fast pace. restrictions on movement globally during the Pandemic, PMB is pursuing vigorously for commencement of STS Transshipment operations from October 2020.

The STS Transshipment Operations are initially expected to generate an assured business of 3.5 to 4 million MT of cargo to be transhipped every year for an initial duration of 5 years to Bangladesh, thereby generating revenue of nearly 8 to 10 crores annually.
Since, Port Meadows provide an all weather ideal location for off shore STS operations and as geographically it lies at an advantageous location to attract cargo emanating from Australia, New Zealand & South East Asia and bound for Ports of East Coast of India, West coast of Myanmar and Bangladesh, the revenue generation through STS operations at Port Meadows, A&N Islands is expected to further increase to 20-40 crores per annum in times to come.
The STS operations would bring in business to the local community (ship chandlers, agents, workshops and freight handling agents) apart from increase in high value tourism through business visits and direct/indirect employment for the Islanders in the form of business opportunities.
The Port Meadows is also being promoted by the UT Administration for transshipment of outbound cargo originating from other Major Ports of India and destined for Australia, New Zealand and other South East Asian Countries, a press release from Chief Port Administrator, Port Management Board said here.

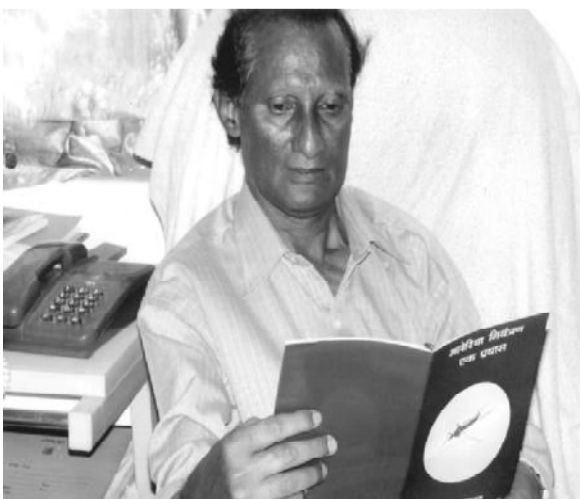
