## Finance Minister attends 3rd G20 Finance Ministers & Central Bank Governors Meeting



New Delhi, July 19 (PIB) Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman participated in the 3rd G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors (FMCBG) meeting under the Saudi Arabian Presidency through Video Conferencing here yesterday to discuss the

global economic outlook amid evolving COVID-19 pandemic crisis along with other G20 Finance Track priorities for the year 2020. The Finance Minister, in the first session of the meeting, talked about the G20 Action Plan in response to COVID-19 which was endorsed by the G20 Finance

Ministers and Central Bank Governors in their previous meeting on 15th April, 2020. This G20 Action Plan lays out a list of collective commitments under the pillars of Health Response, Economic Response, Strong and Sustainable Recovery and International (Contd. on last page)

## Govt. to come up with data protection law soon in the country: Minister

New Delhi, July 19

Union Law and Information Technology Minister, Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad has said that India will not tolerate Data Imperialism. He asserted that Citizens' Data belongs to the community and the country. The Minister exhorted that the Government will never compromise on the sovereignty of the data.

Shri Prasad informed that the Centre will soon bring in a data protection



law in the country and a select committee of Parliament is already examining the matter. Speaking at a virtual lecture organized in memory of his father, late Thakur Prasad, the

Minister said that Coronavirus pandemic has brought in changes in the work culture. He informed that since the virtual hearings have started in Indian Courts, High Courts

have so far handled nearly one lakh 75 thousand cases. Subordinate Courts have heard over 7 lakh 34 thousand cases and Supreme Court has handled 7 thousand 800 of such cases.

Shri Prasad also cautioned everyone regarding data privacy while lauding the digital delivery of services, which he said is empowering the country. (Source: india.gov.in)

The mobile application has been developed by the Indian Turtle Conservation Action Network (ITCAN) in collaboration with the Turtle Survival Alliance-India and Wildlife Conservation Society-India. ## Income Tax Deptt. to start e-Campaign on voluntary tax compliance from today

New Delhi, July 19

The Income Tax Department is all set to start an e-Campaign on voluntary compliance of Income Tax for the convenience of the taxpayers from Monday.

The Central Board of Direct Taxes, CBDT has said that the 11-day campaign will focus on the assesseees or taxpayers who are either non-filers or have discrepancies in their returns for the financial



year 2018-19. It said, the objective of the e-campaign is to facilitate taxpayers to online validate their tax and financial transaction information available with the I-T Department

and promote voluntary compliance, especially for the assesseees for 2018-19 so that they do not need to get into notice and scrutiny process. CBDT said that this

e-campaign is being run for the benefit of the taxpayers. Under this e-campaign, the Income Tax Department will send email and SMS to identified taxpayers to verify their financial transactions related information received by the I-T Department from various sources such as Statement of Financial Transactions, Tax Deduction at Source, Tax Collection at Source (Contd. on last page)

**Finance Minister attends 3rd G20 Finance ....**

Financial Coordination, aimed at co-ordinating G20 efforts to fight the pandemic. Smt. Sitharaman emphasized that it is crucial to ensure that this action plan remains relevant and effective.

Smt. Sitharaman shared her perspective on the way forward on the action plan and highlighted the need for international coordination required in addressing the spill-over effects of exit strategies. Emphasising that the Action Plan needs to reflect how the economies are balancing their supply side and demand side measures in response to COVID-19, Smt. Sitharaman shared with her counterparts on how India is working on ensuring this balance through credit schemes for greater liquidity, direct benefit transfers, and employment guarantee schemes. The Finance Minister specifically referred to India's comprehensive economic package to address recovery and growth amounting to over \$295 Billion, about 10 per cent of India's GDP. Adding to this, Smt. Sitharaman also spoke about the procyclicality of credit rating downgrades by the rating agencies and its deterrent impact on policy options, particularly for EMEs.

In the second session of the meeting, the G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors discussed the developments on G20 Finance Track deliverables under the Saudi Arabian Presidency.

In her intervention, the Finance Minister discussed two such deliverables. First, enhancing access to opportunities for Women, Youth and SMEs is a priority agenda under Saudi Presidency and a Menu of Policy Options on Access to Opportunities has been developed by G20 under this agenda. The Menu presents country experiences of G20 members related to policies aimed at: Youth, Women, Informal Economy, Technology & Adult Skills, and Financial Inclusion. The Finance Minister noted that this agenda has assumed even greater importance now as the pandemic has most impacted the vulnerable sections.

Second, referring to the International Taxation agenda and the intended deliverable of formulating a solution for addressing challenges related to digital taxation, Smt. Sitharaman noted the progress on the agenda and said that it is imperative that this consensus based solution should be simple, inclusive and based on a robust economic impact assessment.

During this session, the Finance Minister also shared some of the policy measures taken by the Government of India to fight the pandemic, including direct benefit transfers, special support to agriculture and MSME sectors, rural employment guarantee measures etc. Smt. Sitharaman particularly highlighted how India has successfully employed technology-based financial inclusion by harnessing the nationwide digital payment infrastructure that India has built in last five years, to make contactless cash transfers of over \$10 billion into the bank accounts of 420 million people. She also referred to the swift measures to provide free food grain to over 800 million people for eight months till November 2020.

farmers get remunerative prices due to additional competition.

The second ordinance is the Farmers (Empowerment and Protection) Agreement on Price Assurance and Farm Services Ordinance, 2020 or the FAPAFS Ordinance. It aims at empowering farmers for engaging with processors, aggregators, wholesalers, large retailers and exporters on a level playing field without any fear of exploitation. It will transfer the risk of market unpredictability from the farmer to the sponsor and also enable the farmer to access modern technology and better inputs. It will reduce cost of marketing and improve income of farmers.

The third ordinance is related to the amendment to Essential Commodities Act, removing commodities like cereals, pulses, oilseeds, edible oils, onion and potatoes from list of essential commodities. The Member, Agriculture, NITI Aayog Shri Ramesh Chand said, these ordinances in Agriculture sector will ensure that farmers get remunerative price and their income grow at a faster rate.

These three landmark decisions will bring reforms in agriculture marketing and commodities trade. The FPTC Ordinance aims at ending the monopoly of the APMC and allow anyone to purchase and sell agricultural produce. The Ordinance related to farm services has been brought with a view to legalise contract farming, so that vast area swathes of land can be cultivated on contract.

The amendment to the Essential Commodities Act is a visionary step towards transformation of agriculture and raising farmers' income. It will help drive up investment in cold storages and modernization of food supply chain. The amendment to the Essential Commodities Act will help both farmers and consumers while bringing in price stability. (Source: india.gov.in)
