New Delhi, Mar 20  
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said that his Government is focusing on to make India an international diamond trading hub. Addressing the International Diamond Conference through video conferencing last evening, which was held in Mumbai, Shri Modi said, the Centre has taken transformative initiatives like 'Make in India' and 'Skill India' and the gems and jewellery

sector is a prime example of the potential of these initiatives. Shri Modi said, the Special Notified Zone at the Bharat Diamond Bourse became operational in November 2015 and it has already shown good results. He said, earlier 80-90 merchants got access to global rough diamonds but now 3000 merchants have this privilege through Special Notified Zone. Shri Modi said, India cherishes exceptional

relations with Africa and they are natural partners. He said, India will be happy to support Africa in Gems and Jewellery sector. The Prime Minister said, the Gems and Jewellery industry should think of encouraging start-ups by entrepreneurs who can create a growing market for made to order Indian jewellery. On the occasion, the Gems and Jewellery Export Promotion Council gave 21 Crore rupees for Clean Ganga Fund.

## Cabinet clears 4 GST supplementary legislations for introduction to parliament

New Delhi, Mar 20  
The Cabinet today cleared four supporting Goods and Services Tax legislations, paving the way for their introduction in Parliament soon. The legislations were cleared at a Cabinet meeting in New Delhi. The supporting legislations -- the



Compensation Law, the Central-GST (C-GST), Integrated-GST (I-GST) and Union Territory-GST (UT-GST) -- would be introduced as Money Bill. Once approved by Parliament, the states would start taking their State-GST (S-GST) bill for discussion and passage in the respective State Assemblies.

The GST Council, in its previous two meetings, had given approval to the four legislations as also the State-GST bill. While the S-GST has to be passed by each of the State Legislative Assemblies, the four other laws have to be approved by Parliament. The CGST Bill makes

## IMFL stock seized by South Andaman Police; two arrested

Port Blair, Mar 20  
Observing zero tolerance towards illegal trade & sale of alcohol, frequent raids were conducted by Police near the bus/truck stand at Bathu Basti close to the parking ILOT where there were complaints of selling IMFL illegally. On suspicion of nexus between the illegal liquor selling shops and 'Kerala Bhavan' Bar at Bathu Basti, a surprise checking of the IMFL stock of the 'Kerala Bhavan' Bar was carried out by a team of local

police headed by SHO PS Pahargaon on March 17, which found excessive stock. Thus, the excessive stock of different quantity of IMFL and beer/wine were seized alongwith stock registers, bill books etc. The Manger of the bar Madhuveeran, 43, R/o Garacharama and the lease owner of the Bar Smti Jayalalitha, 48, R/o Bathu Basti were also arrested and a case under 32 Regulation III of 1876 has been registered at PS Pahargaon. Further investigation of the

case is continuing. Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to keep surveillance over the movements of newcomers/strangers in their respective locality and pass on information pertaining to such illegal activities by unscrupulous and anti-social elements on the following telephone numbers 233077, 232405, 232400, 250525, 232232 & 100. ## Journey to the highest peak of Nicobar 'Mission Mt Thuillier' accomplished

A journey to the highest peak of Nicobar 'Mission Mt Thuillier', the highest point in the Nicobar Islands was accomplished. The mount is located on the Island of Great Nicobar, measuring 642 m above mean sea level. Its geology features intrusive igneous rock formations. One of most challenging journey to climb Mountain Thuillier Nicobar began from Break water jetty, Campbell Bay at 7 am yesterday on board the ICGS C 414. The team reached Navy Dera from Campbell Bay covering 10.8 Nautical miles in an hour. They reached the Mt



Thuillier at 12 Noon today. After reaching the highest point of Mt Thuillier, they unfurled the National Flag. As of now, there is no human settlement there and this area comes under the jurisdiction of Forest Deptt.

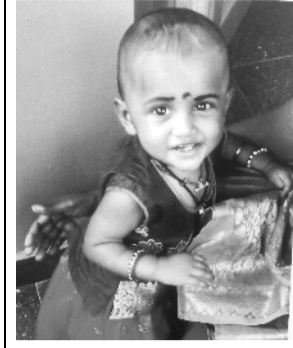

India-Australia 3rd Test ends in a draw

Ranchi, Mar 20  
Indian bowlers were thwarted by Australia's perseverance as Steve Smith's men survived a battle of nerves on Monday to force a draw in the third Test at JSCA stadium in Ranchi keeping the series alive. Starting day 4 at a nervy 23/2 in reply to India's 603/9 declared, Australia were 204/6 in 100 overs in their second innings when the two teams decided to end the proceedings. Handscomb (72 not out) and Marsh (53) combined to share a 124-run fifth-wicket partnership to steer Australia to safety after the cheap dismissal of skipper Steve Smith (21) and Matt Renshaw (15) had given the visitors' dressing room moments of anxiety. Marsh was eventually dismissed by India's bowling star Ravindra Jadeja, who continued his purple patch to finish with figures of 4/54. Handscomb, on the other hand, played the anchorman role to perfection and remained unbeaten after holding the fort for 200 deliveries.



The Indian bowlers, especially pacer Ishant Sharma (1/30), looked menacing in the pre-lunch session but the Aussies managed to hold their ground in the last two sessions. However, Handscomb and Marsh absorbed the pressure with their calculated knocks to deny the hosts, who apart from the sizeable crowd, were also cheered on by former captain and local favourite Mahendra Singh Dhoni. On the docile surface, Jadeja, however, followed up his five wickets in the first innings for a match haul of nine wickets. Earlier in the morning session, India looked good for a win by claiming Renshaw and first innings unbeaten centurion

Karthik, bowlers guide Tamil Nadu to Vijay Hazare title

New Delhi, Mar 20  
Senior pro Dinesh Karthik produced an innings of character before Tamil Nadu's disciplined bowling effort saw them beat Bengal by 37 runs in the Vijay Hazare Trophy final on Monday. This was the third time that Tamil Nadu prevailed over Bengal in the national one-day meet having beaten them in 2008-09 and 2009-10. Karthik (112) was the only significant scorer for Tamil Nadu en route to their meagre total of 217 in 47.2 overs as Mohammed Shami bowled with a lot of fire, scalping 4 for 26. Ashok Dinda (3/36) also rattled the top order. But Tamil Nadu bowlers showed unbelievable discipline restricting Bengal to 180 on a pitch that didn't have any demons. Off-spinner MS Washington Sundar (0/17) didn't get wickets but kept the Bengal batsmen on

tenterhooks in his eight overs spell. Rahul Shah, Aswin Crist and Mohammed Mohammed all did what was required to defend a small total. Trying to be extra cautious, Shreevats Goswami (23) consumed a lot of deliveries at the onset increasing the pressure. A poor call led to Abhimanyu Easwaran (1) run out. Manoj Tiwary (32) was bowled by opposite number Vijay Shankar while trying to play across the line. It was a delivery that needed to be played in front foot and he committed on backfoot. Sudeep Chatterjee (58) and Anushtup Majumdar (24) added 65 runs for the fifth wicket for Bengal but a dodgy leg

South Africa allrounder JP Duminy has pulled out of the upcoming season of the Indian Premier League. The Delhi Daredevils player has cited personal reasons for his decision. Duminy, who led the team in the 2015 edition, has been a vital cog in the Daredevils set up, having scored 1015 runs for the franchise at an impressive average of 44.13 since the 2014 edition, when he was snapped up. Duminy expressed his disappointment following his decision but hoped to play for the franchise again in the future. "It has been a very difficult decision for me to make, but it was for purely personal reasons," Duminy said on Monday (March 20).

Mumbai lose its permanent status in BCCI

Mumbai, Mar 20  
Mumbai lose its permanent status in the Board of Control for Cricket in India, BCCI. The new constitution of the Indian cricket board, finalised by the Committee of Administrators appointed by the Supreme Court of India also granted full membership with voting rights to all the North Eastern states, as recommended in Lodha Panel reforms. Uttarakhand, Telangana are also full members, while Bihar gets back its voting right. The new rules clearly states, there could be only one full member from a state. Ranji champions alongwith Baroda and Saurashtra are associate members and will take turns to rotate annually to vote. The new Memorandum of Association has also taken away the proxy system.

Indian Wells: Elena Vesnina beats fellow Russian Svetlana Kuznetsova to win title



California, Mar 20  
Elena Vesnina capped a stellar Indian Wells campaign with a hard-fought 6-7 (6/8), 7-5, 6-4 triumph over fellow Russian Svetlana Kuznetsova on Sunday. Playing in her first final at the elite Premier Mandatory level, world number 15 Vesnina battled through a tense three hours and one minute to subdue eighth-ranked Kuznetsova, a two-time Grand Slam champion. The triumph comes a year after Vesnina, 30, fell in the first round of qualifying at Indian Wells and capped a tournament that saw her down both Germany's soon-to-be number one

Angelique Kerber and seven-time Grand Slam champion Venus Williams. For Kuznetsova, it was a third disappointment in as many finals at Indian Wells, this one coming a decade after she fell in back to back finals in 2007 and 2008. A third set that, like the first two, featured multiple service breaks came down to marathon ninth game, in which Kuznetsova saved four break points before Vesnina converted her fifth with a stinging service winner to find herself serving for the match. After knocking a forehand wide on her first match point, she secured the victory when Kuznetsova's service return went long.

But the on-loan Manchester City defender was sent-off for pulling down Luis Suarez after the Uruguayan had levelled and Messi smashed home the resulting penalty.

Munir El Haddadi briefly levelled for the 10 men before half-time, but Messi and finally Andre Gomes with his first Barca goal sealed the three points. Madrid still also have a game in hand over their title rivals. "We created a huge number of chances and deserved to win by a bigger margin," Barca boss Luis Enrique told Spanish TV station Movistar. "Against an opponent with very good players we've picked up three valuable points." Enrique named the same side that beat Paris Saint-Germain 6-1 10 days ago to progress to the Champions League quarter-finals in stunning fashion.

provisions for levy and collection of tax on intra-state supply of goods or services for both by the Central Government. On the other hand, IGST Bill provides for levy and collection of tax on inter-state supply of goods or services or both by the Central Government. The UTGST Bill makes provisions for levy on collection of tax on intra-UT supply of goods and services in the Union Territories without legislature. Union Territory GST is akin to States Goods and Services Tax (SGST) which shall be levied and collected by the States and Union Territories on intra-state supply of goods or services or both. The Compensation Bill provides for compensation to the states for loss of revenue arising on account of implementation of the goods and services tax for a period of five years. Passage of all the legislations would pave the way for introduction of GST from 1st July this year. The Finance Minister in his Budget Speech had mentioned that country-wide outreach efforts will be made to explain the provisions of GST to Trade and Industry.
