## Yuzvendra Chahal, Sundar climb in ICC T20 rankings

Dubai, Mar 20  
Yuzvendra Chahal jumped 12 spots to number two while Washington Sundar moved up a phenomenal 151 places to 31st in the ICC T20 Player Rankings for bowlers on the back of their impressive show in the just-concluded Nidahas Trophy Tri-Series in Sri Lanka. Leg-spinner Chahal now has a career-high 706 rating points while off-spinner Sundar, who was named Man of the Series, has 496 points. Both the spinners were part of the five games India played, and picked up eight wickets apiece. Sundar, who bowled mainly in the Powerplay, had an incredible economy rate of 5.70, while Chahal finished with 6.45. Also making significant gains in the bowling charts were some of the other performers from the Nidahas Trophy: Akila Dananjaya of Sri Lanka, Rubel Hossain of



Bangladesh and India's Jaydev Unadkat and Shardul Thakur. All of them achieved their career-best rating points at the end of the tournament. Unadkat (joint 52nd) and Thakur (joint 76th), India's premier pacemen in the tournament, went up 26 and 85 spots respectively with their best points ever -- 435 and 358. Among the batsmen, Shikhar Dhawan, Kusal Perera, Manish Pandey, Mushfiqur Rahim, Kusal Mendis and Dinesh Karthik, the star of India's win in the final

over Bangladesh, made significant gains. Karthik, who had an outstanding tournament batting in the lower middle-order, jumped from No. 126 to No.95, with his best-ever 246 points. The two Kusals -- Perera and Mendis -- moved up 20 spots to 20th and 27 spots to the 48th position respectively after strong performances with the bat for Sri Lanka. Perera topped the batting charts for the tournament with 204 runs, including three half-centuries, while Mendis aggregated 134 runs with two half-centuries.

## Sheoran wins gold

Kulal Lumpur, Mar 20  
Gauri Sheoran emerged the lone individual gold medallist for India, which finished third in the medals table with three gold, two silver and three bronze, in the World University shooting championship that concluded here on Sunday. Italy topped the tally from among 24 teams, while Korea was second. After just about qualifying into the final of the 25m sports pistol with a modest score of 371, Sheoran was brilliant in the climax winding up with a perfect five, as she beat Wang Xiaoyu of China 37-33 for the gold. Shreya Gawande finished fifth.

## Rabada cleared to play against Australia as ICC overturns ban

Cape Town, Mar 20  
South African fast bowler Kagiso Rabada has been cleared to play remainder of the Test series against Australia having won his appeal against a Level Two breach of the International Cricket Council's (ICC) code of conduct. Rabada had his punishment for brushing against the shoulder of Australia captain Steven Smith in the second test in Port Elizabeth reduced from a fine of 50 percent of his match fee and three demerit points, to 25

percent and one demerit point. He, however, was found guilty of a lesser charge of "conduct that is contrary to the spirit of the game" on appeal by Judicial Commissioner Michael Heron, according to a statement from the ICC on Tuesday. That leaves Rabada's total of demerit points over the last 24 months on seven, one fewer than the threshold that would trigger an automatic two-match suspension. He received a demerit point for a send-off to

Australian opener David Warner in the same game. Currently the top ranked Test bowler in the world, Rabada is free to play the third Test that starts in Cape Town on Thursday, with the tempestuous four-match series square at 1-1. The 22-year-old admitted he needed to tone down his wicket celebrations in the wake of the Smith incident but maintained that the contact with Smith was accidental and he had not intended to brush against the batsman.

## New Delhi World Cup to offer 16 Olympic quotas in shooting

New Delhi, Mar 20  
The International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup in the Capital early next year will offer 16 quota places for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. The qualification route to the Olympic Games in Tokyo will start from this year's ISSF World Championship in Changwon, Korea in August-September. A total of 360 quotas will be distributed in the 15 Olympic shooting events. The tournament in New Delhi,

which will be held at the Dr Kami Singh Shooting Ranges, will offer two quotas each in both individual men and women's sections for 10 air rifle, 10m air pistol, rifle 3 position and rapid fire pistol. The tournament will not involve quotas for mixed team events, which are marked only for the World Championships. The 52nd World Championships will be held from August 31 to September 15. There are 48 individual Olympic quotas and 12 mixed team Olympic quotas set to be assigned there. India recently produced its best-ever showing in an ISSF World Cup when its shooters grabbed nine medals, including four gold, in the tournament in Guadalajara, Mexico. This was a welcome change within two years of the country's disastrous outing at the Rio Olympics. From where the shooting team returned empty-handed after winning medals in three successive Olympics.
